#### FOREWORD

The study on the Manpower Resources of Ceylon, 1956-81 is the second of the series undertaken by the Demographic Training and Research Centre, Bombay for the Planning Secretariat. It forms part of the original request by the Planning Secretariat for a study of future population and manpower trends in Ceylon. The first study "POPULATION PROJECTIONS FOR CEYLON 1956-81" has been published separately.

Projections of the work force are usually beset with many difficulties, particularly those relating to a definition, valid for the projection period, of the economically active population. Assumptions have to be made about several factors closely affected by social and economic changes which are themselves difficult to visualise. Nevertheless estimates of the probable size and composition of the persons who take part in a nation's economic life are important for effective programming. The present study is the first of its kind pertaining to Ceylon and has already proved of considerable use in the preparation of the 10 year Plan.

The Planning Secretariat is much indebted to the Demographic Training and Research Centre, Bombay and to the authors—Dr. Sundram of the Centre's Staff and Messrs. Rao and Selvaratnam—for undertaking this study.
