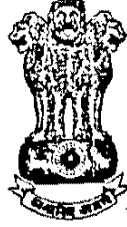

PREFACE

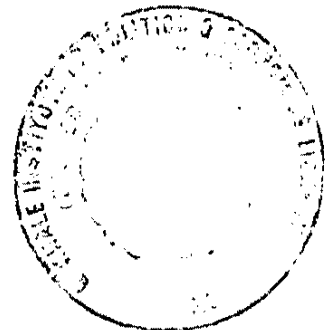
A nationwide survey on "Particulars of Slums" was carried-out by the National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO) during the period January-June, 1993 in its 49th round to ascertain the extent of civic facilities available in the slums. Earlier, in the 31st round of NSS, a nationwide survey on "Condition of slum areas in cities" was conducted covering a period of one year from July, 1976-June, 1977.

The present report contains the results based on the central sample data collected in the 49th round on selected characteristics like ownership, area type, type of structure, living facilities of slums and their proximity to the nearest motorable road, primary school and hospital/health centre and change in the condition of slums during the last five years. This report consists of three Chapters and one Appendix. Chapter-1 of the report introduces the subject matter. Chapter-2 deals with the coverage, sample design and estimation procedure. Chapter-3 presents the summary findings of the survey results. Detailed tables are given in the Appendix.

The field work of the survey was conducted by the Field Operations Division. Data processing and tabulation were handled by the Data Processing Division and Computer Centre respectively. The Survey Design and Research Division was responsible for designing of the survey and preparing the report. I am grateful to the members of the Governing Council, Heads of the various divisions of NSSO, Executive Director, Computer Centre and their colleagues for their sincere efforts in bringing-out the report in its final shape. It is hoped that this report would serve as a reference document to the users of NSS data.
