The information on account of standards taught, management, hostel facilities, media of instruction, etc., is also given in this list as before.

It is hoped that this list will satisfy the needs of those concerned with Secondary Education.

Comments or suggestions, if any, may be sent to this Directorate, which will take due notice of them, in the preparation of future lists.

INTRODUCTION

The following complete list of Secondary Schools in the State of Maharashtra recognised by the Education Department as it stood on 31st March 1964, is published for general information.

The list consists of 6 parts (A, B, C, D, E and F) which comprise the following categories :—

- (1) List A contains names of Higher Secondary Multipurpose Schools.
- (2) List B contains names of Higher Secondary Ordinary Schools.
- (3) List C contains names of Vocational High Schools.
- (4) List D contains names of Multipurpose High Schools.
- (5) List E contains names of Ordinary Schools.
- (6) List F contains names of Middle Schools.

The list of schools is arranged categorywise and in the following order of their managements :—

- (1) Central Government.
- (2) State Government.
- (3) Zilla Parishad.
- (4) Municipal.
- (5) Private.

The abbreviations used stand for :—

- (1) (In)—Where the course is provided in the school itself.
- (2) (Ex)—Where the course is not provided in the same school.
- (3) Hum—Humanities.
- (4) Sc.—Science.
- (5) H. Sc.—Home Science.
- (6) Tech.—Technical.
- (7) Com.—Commerce.
- (8) Agri.—Agriculture.
- (9) S. R. Act.—Societies Registration Act.
- (10) B. P. T.—Bombay Public Trust Act.
