(b) A further £72 was also disbursed during the year for Grants-in-Aid, but was charged to a different head in the Accounts in accordance with letter No. 558, dated 9th May 1922, from Government of India, Education Department.

(c) This includes a special estimate of £500 for the triennial external decoration of the house, required under the terms of the lease.

(d) The actual amount paid during the financial year 1922-23 was £898 4s. 3d., but this includes £134 18s. 10d. paid in respect of March 1922, and does not include £128 1s. 3d. paid in respect of March 1923, in the financial year 1923-24. Thus it will be seen that the actual amount paid in respect of the financial year 1922-23 is £892 6s. 9d., which coincides with the grant shown in the House Accounts of 21, Cromwell Road in Appendix II.

(e) Details as to how this grant was calculated will be seen from Appendix III. This grant was originally estimated at £1,160, and included as such in the Budget 1923-24, but was since reduced to £1,010 by the House Committee. Details of £150 will be adjusted in the November Revision.
