

REPORT ON THE WORKING OF THE INDIAN COMPANIES ACT, 1913, THE PROVIDENT INSURANCE SOCIETIES ACT, 1912, AND THE INDIAN LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANIES ACT, 1912, FOR THE YEAR 1924-25.

I. The Indian Companies Act, 1913.

The Registrars of Assurances in the mufassal districts continued to exercise within their jurisdiction the functions of Assistant Registrars of Joint Stock Companies and I held the office of the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies throughout the year, with the exception of the period of my leave from 5th August 1924 to 4th September 1924 when my Personal Assistant M. Muhammad Hussain Sahib Bahadur acted both as Registrar of Joint Stock Companies and as Inspector-General of Registration.

2. The duty allowance of my Special Assistant which was stopped in 1922 was restored during the year [G.O. No. 87, Finance, dated 29th January 1924 and G.O. No. 2546, Law (General), dated 8th September 1924] but it has been treated as *compensatory* allowance although, having regard to the particularly onerous nature of the duties, the allowance deserves to be classed as 'special pay' as in the case of the Personal Assistant to the Inspector-General of Registration and the Inspector of Registration Offices.

COMPANIES AT WORK (STATEMENT I AND APPENDICES A & C).

3. There were working at the commencement of the year 755 companies, 683 with and 72 without share capital. Seventy-six companies were registered, 69 with and 7 without share capital and there ceased to work 61 companies, 60 with and one without share capital; thus leaving at the close of the year 770 companies, 692 with and 78 without share capital. These are classifiable as shown hereunder:—

The above classification shows that banking and loan companies, which comprise mostly midhis and chit associations, still predominate, while trading and industrial concerns occupy but a secondary position.

NEW REGISTRATIONS (STATEMENTS II AND III AND APPENDIX A).

4. The year proved unfavourable to Joint Stock enterprise as is evident from the fact that not only new registrations fell from 96 in 1923-24 to 76 in 1924-25 but the number of companies that ceased to exist showed a concomitant increase, viz., from 47 in 1923-24 to 61 in 1924-25. This result was not altogether unexpected as, with the scarcity of money, even deserving companies were languishing and new companies started at such a juncture had but remote chances of success. It is, however, noteworthy that of the 69 companies registered with an aggregate authorized capital of 1.8 crores, although only 9—all Trading and Industrial concerns—are either European or European-managed, yet their aggregate authorized capital cover over one crore.

5. In the number of new registrations, Madras heads the list as usual, accounting for 24 out of the 76 new companies. Coimbatore which used to come next is however gradually falling to the background, only 7 companies having been registered there in the year under review against 17 in 1923-24 and 27 in 1922-23.

6. The biggest flotations during the year were:

(i) *The Associated Publishers (Madras), Limited*, with a capital of 24 lakhs. This company has entered into agreements for purchasing *inter alia* the goodwill of the businesses now conducted by *The Madras Mail, Limited* and *Higginbothams, Limited*, and certain of the assets of *The Associated Printers, Limited*, and almost the whole of its capital has therefore been treated as fully paid up.

(ii) *The Trichinopoly Electric Power Company, Limited*—authorized capital 20 lakhs;

(iii) *The Nonsuch Tea Estates, Limited*—authorized capital, 17½ lakhs;

(iv) *The Somasundaram Mills, Limited*—authorized capital Rs. 14,40,000.

7. Turning to the objects of the new companies, banking and loan companies formed as usual the bulk of the new registrations. The craze for companies of the type known as auction chits which promise attractive returns for investors has spread from Madras to the neighbouring districts of North Arcot and Chittoor and 7 out of the 11 chit companies were registered in those districts.

Amongst Trading and Industrial concerns, special mention may be made of (i) *The Southern India Steam Navigation Company, Limited*—authorized capital 12 lakhs—registered with the object of working steamships and other vessels for the conveyance of passengers and goods especially along the coasts of India and Burma and (ii) five public utility concerns, *viz.*, *Rajahmundry Electric Supply Corporation, Limited*; *Sri Meenakshi Sundareswaral Electric Power Corporation, Limited*; *Sri Raja Rajeswari Electric Supply Corporation, Limited*; *Trichinopoly Electric Power Company, Limited*, and *Trichinopoly-Srirangam Electric Supply Corporation, Limited*, registered in the districts of Gōdāvāri, Ramnad and Trichinopoly—all with the object of supplying electric power for lighting and other purposes. In Madras City the old and well-established concerns of *Gordon Woodroffe and Company* (General merchants), *Simpson and Company* (Motor engineers) and *John W. Roberts* (Billards furniture manufacturers), registered themselves as limited liability companies. The effect of the passing of the State Aid to Industries Act is yet to be seen and it is hoped that the Act will, in the coming years, help the flotation and working of a number of concerns of this class.

PRIVATE COMPANIES (STATEMENT XI AND APPENDIX D).

8. Twenty-four companies were registered and 16 ceased to work with the result that the total number of private companies rose from 148 to 156.

The number of companies that converted themselves from public to private and *vice versa* was 2.

ASSOCIATIONS NOT FOR PROFIT.

9. During the year the Government granted licences under section 26 to *three* associations to enable them to register themselves as limited liability concerns with the privilege of omitting the word 'Limited' from their names.

The number of registered associations under section 26 rose from 63 to 68 consequent on the registration of six associations and the removal of one defunct association.

CAPITAL OF COMPANIES (STATEMENTS IV, V AND VIII).

10. The aggregate authorized and paid-up capitals rose from 28.25 crores and 11.13 crores to 29.14 crores and 12.34 crores, respectively. The subjoined statement shows the number and the

paid-up capital of the several classes of joint-stock concerns on the 31st March 1925 as compared with their position a decade ago :--

The aggregate net increase during 1924-25 in the authorized, subscribed and paid-up capitals of the working companies were 35.22, 62.07 and 62.91 lakhs, respectively.

Only one company reduced its authorized capital.

COMPANIES THAT CEASED TO EXIST (STATEMENTS VI AND VII).

11. The number of companies that ceased to exist was 61—all but one Indian—60 limited by shares and one by guarantee. *Twenty-four* companies were wound up voluntarily; 3 were wound up compulsorily by the High Court while 34 which were not carrying on business were struck off the register under section 247.

VOLUNTARY LIQUIDATION.

12. The twenty-four companies under this head include 7 Banking and Loan companies and 17 Trading and Industrial concerns.

(i) Banking and Loan companies (7).

Commercial Association, Limited, and Walujabad Banking Company, Limited, suffered owing to indifferent management which culminated in their winding up.

Kuthuparamba Bank, Limited, Palghat Bank, Limited, Pollachi Ganesar Nishi, Limited, Fulapatta Bank, Limited, and Kamanathapuram Rajakula Nishi, Limited, came to grief owing to want of sufficient funds.

(ii) *Trading and Industrial concerns (17).*

Cochin Fibre Company, Limited, Sri Vilasam Company, Limited, Tanjore National Co-operative Emporium, Limited, and Tanjore Oil Mills Company, Limited, wound up on account of their liabilities.

Arya Kerala Company, Limited, Building Materials and Industrials, Limited, Jayankondashclapuram Cotton and Piece Goods Mart, Limited, Kandasamipalayam Shanmuka Vilasa Cotton Trading Company, Limited, and Krishna Cement Company, Limited, had to close their business owing to the insufficiency of the working capital.

Coromandel Baling Company, Limited, could not work owing to competition in its neighbourhood.

Coimbatore Indian Silver Gold Thread Manufacturing Company, Limited, Islamia Printing Press, Limited, Kayalpatnom Muhammadia Varthaka Company, Limited, Shoranur Industries and Trading Company, Limited and Thiruvannamalur National Mercantile and Industrial Company, Limited, collapsed owing to mismanagement.

Briggs & Co., Limited, worked at a loss and the death of its founder accelerated its closure.

Eastern Carpets, Limited, could not be worked owing to the difficulties experienced in running the branch offices of the Company which were in remote places like Peshawar, Mirzapur and London.

COMPULSORY LIQUIDATION.

13. *Malabar Bank, Limited, Ripon Press and Sugar Mill Company, Limited, and Universal Tobacco Company, Limited,* were wound up by the High Court as their affairs were found to be mismanaged.

STRUCK OFF THE REGISTER.

14. The 34 companies under this head comprise 12 banking and loan companies, 21 trading and industrial concerns and 1 miscellaneous company.

Andhra Sahitya Sammelanam, Limited, Kerala Industrial Bank, Limited, Ratna Industrial and Entertainment Company, Limited, and Wednesday Review Press, Limited, languished as they could not attract capital.

Anuparpalaiyam Shanmugha Vilasa Banking and Trading Company, Limited, Coimbatore Trading Company, Limited, Madras Samayabagara Benefit Company, Limited, Mannargudi Emporium, Limited, Seetharam & Co., Limited, South Indian Piece Goods Supply Company, Limited, Suler Sri Krishna Vilasa Ginning

Factory, Limited, Sawmy & Co., Limited, Trichinopoly Kottai Hindu Jananukula Ela Nidhi, Limited, and Vadasithoor Muthukumaraswami Kaithari Nesavu Company, Limited, ceased to function in consequence of loss or inadequacy of capital.

Ananda Mutual Benefit Fund, Limited, and Madras Benefit Company, Limited—both chit funds failed on the organizers absconding after working the chits for some time.

Andhra Trading Company, Limited, Arni R.M.S.V. Chit Fund Office, Chamber of Commerce, Vizianagaram, General Motors Corporation, Limited, Indian Engineer Printing and Publishing Company, Limited, Nalathinpuhur Spinning and Weaving Mills, Limited, Paropakara Draviya Sahaya Benefit Company, Limited, Periamet General Permanent Fund, Limited, Raj, Limited, Sourashtra Bank, Limited, and Tirupati Chiratanur Tramway Company, Limited, vanished having become moribund soon after registration.

Bharata Bhandar, Limited, and St. Joseph's Benefit Fund, Limited, languished owing to loss resulting from mismanagement.

Melappalaiyam Muslim Industrial Association, Limited, collapsed on account of misappropriation of its funds by the managing director.

Mutual Investment Fund, Limited, was not doing any business since 1922 and ceased operation on the death of the principal director.

Niyama Deepika Company, Limited, disappeared on the managing director taking up Government service.

Shevaroy's Coffee and Produce Company, Limited, ceased to do business apparently owing to a deadlock in the company's domestic forum.

Sree Padmalaya Rice and Oil Mills Company, Limited, became defunct as it preferred to work as an unregistered concern.

The above analysis brings into bold relief only *some* of the reasons which ordinarily lead to the closure of joint stock companies in this Presidency. More than 70 per cent of the companies wound up have had but a short span of life of five years and under. The sudden collapse of companies which in their original prospectuses present, in glowing terms, a bright and hopeful future has greatly undermined public faith and this accounts for the shyness of banks in lending a helping hand to industrial concerns and also for the poor response which new companies get from the investing public.

MORTGAGES AND CHARGES (SECTIONS 109 AND 110).

15. From the undermentioned particulars of mortgages and charges registered it will be seen that there were subsisting 80 mortgages or charges to the extent of Rs. 2,95,27,668 :—

CHANGE OF NAME (SECTION 11).

17. The Government accorded sanction under section 11 (4), in the case of one company which desired to change its name. Two companies which were registered by names identical with those of existing companies were also permitted by the Registrar under section 11 (2) to change their registered names.

BRITISH REGISTER IN THE UNITED KINGDOM
(SECTION 41).

18. No company opened in the United Kingdom a Branch register of its members.

COMPANIES ESTABLISHED OUTSIDE BRITISH INDIA (SECTION 277
AND APPENDIX E).

19. The number of these companies increased from 162 to 167 owing to 9 companies having newly established a place of business in this Presidency and to 4 having ceased to have such a place.

The Wesleyan Methodist Missionary Trust Association was exempted by the Government of India, pursuant to section 277 (3), from filing a copy of the annual balance sheet with the Registrar [G.O. Mis. No. 1508, Law (General), dated 5th May 1924].

APPOINTMENT OF INSPECTORS BY THE GOVERNMENT
(SECTION 138).

20. An application under section 138 was made by certain shareholders of the *Mudalipalayam Sivananda Nidhi, Limited*, for the appointment of an Inspector to investigate its affairs. The application was, however, rejected as the petitioners failed to furnish further information called for [G.O. Mis. No. 3300, Law (General), dated 22nd November 1924].

APPOINTMENT OF AUDITORS BY THE GOVERNMENT.

21. Under section 144 (4) the Government appointed auditors in respect of eight companies which failed to do so at their annual general meeting.

AUDITORS (APPENDIX F).

22. During the year, seven Government Diplomates in Accountancy applied to and received from the Government permanent unrestricted certificates. One restricted certificate holder was awarded an unrestricted certificate and one restricted certificated auditor died and there were at the end of the year 44 certificated auditors, 25 auditors possessing unrestricted certificates and 19 holding restricted certificates. Of these 18 auditors have authority to take and train apprentices.

The firm of *M. S. Krishnaswami and Jagannathan*, the partners whereof are both holders of unrestricted certificates, was recognized by the Government as a firm qualified to act as auditors [G.O. No. 3052, Law (General), dated 31st October 1924].

VISITS TO REGISTERED OFFICES.

23. The registered offices of all the working companies were duly visited, in Madras by the members of my staff and in the mufassal by the registering officers and the magistracy. In the Coimbatore district, however, 47 companies requiring inspection by the magistracy *twice* were inspected only *once*.

The conveyance allowance of Rs. 5 per mensem paid to the visiting clerk in Madras was abolished in March 1924 and the Government sanctioned in lieu thereof jatka hire actually incurred by the clerk up to a maximum of Rs. 5 per mensem [G.O. No. 1066, Law (General), 27th March 1924]. As Madras is a city of distances and as companies are scattered in all parts of the city, the sum of Rs. 5 sanctioned has been found quite inadequate.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ACT.

24. In the case which was pending in Ramnad (paragraph 21 of the last report) the Managing Director was fined Rs. 50 for his failure to file the Annual List of Members (section 32). In Madras the Managing Director of a company was fined Rs. 100 by the Presidency Magistrate for failure to file the contract constituting the title of the allottee to the allotment or the particulars thereof (section 104). The party has filed in the High Court a Criminal Revision petition and the same is pending disposal.

FINANCIAL RESULTS.

25. With the fall in the number as well as in the amount of authorized capital of the new companies the receipts declined from Rs. 29,026 to Rs. 25,749. The realization from the sale of forms also fell from Rs. 397 to Rs. 347. The expenditure rose from Rs. 29,937 to Rs. 38,509. This increase was due to the fact that the Central Government's share of the cost of joint establishment employed in the administration of the Act was raised from Rs. 12,000 to Rs. 15,000 per annum and that a sum of Rs. 12,000 representing the additional charges for the four years ending 1924-25 was on that account debited to the year 1924-25. If this further charge of Rs. 12,000 is excluded, the expenditure during the year was but Rs. 26,509 and this fall as compared with the expenditure of the previous year was due to the fact that a junior District Registrar held the post of the Special Assistant Registrar during the latter half of the year.

DEPARTMENTAL.

26. (i) The question of granting suitable relief to the Assistant Registrar of Joint Stock Companies at Coimbatore, where the work connected with companies is rapidly on the increase (paragraph 23 of my last report), is still under my consideration.

(ii) The Government sanctioned the grant of a special pay of Rs. 10 per mensem to the typist of my office who has passed the advanced test in typewriting (G.O. No. 377, Law (General), 7th February 1925.)

(iii) In paragraph 24 of my last report the *cul de sac* nature of my establishment was brought to the notice of the Government and I am glad to record that an outlet was found by the Government approving my proposal to appoint my Head Clerk as the Special Assistant Registrar.

(iv) In June last M. Muhammad Hussain Sahib Bahadur whose services were required as Personal Assistant to the Inspector-General of Registration relinquished the post of Special Assistant Registrar and Registrar of Provident Insurance Societies and Life Assurance Companies and I take this opportunity to place on record my appreciation of his diligent and good work and his high sense of duty.

GENERAL.

27. The records of the Assistant Registrars of Joint Stock Companies were examined either by myself or, under my orders, by my Special Assistant.

28. The service registers of the establishment have been verified and the inventory of valuable stock is duly maintained.

II. Provident Insurance Societies Act, 1912, and Indian Life Assurance Companies Act, 1912, (Appendices G and H).

29. The office of the Registrar under the above Acts was held by M. Muhammad Hussain Sahib Bahadur until 16th June 1924 and by M.R.Ry. V. S. Chengalvaraya Pillai from the 19th August 1924 to the end of the year. There was no Registrar during the interregnum as the post of Special Assistant Registrar remained unfilled.

30. *The Anglo-Indian Family Benefit Fund, Madras*, went into voluntary liquidation as the number of policy holders dwindled owing to the paucity of new entrants.

The number of Provident Insurance Societies in the Presidency accordingly fell from 12 to 11.

31. There was no new registration and the receipts therefore showed no marked change, being Rs. 40 against Rs. 42 in 1923-24.

32. Two societies :—*The Suvisesha Lutheran Thiruchabai Marana Sahaya Nadhi* and *The Basal Mission Vaidikas Sahayatha Sangam*—changed their names into *The Lutheran Church Provident Fund* and *The Kanara Clergymen's Benefit Society*, respectively.

33. All the societies with the exception of *The Non-Gazetted Government Judicial Officers' Association (Madras) Mutual Benefit Fund* were inspected during the year. The excepted fund was not inspected as it was reported that it was not working. The question of mending or ending it, is under the consideration of the Registrar.

34. The number of Life Assurance Companies at work was *seven* as in the previous year. It is remarkable that not a single Life Assurance Company was registered since 1912, when the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act, 1912, came into force. Evidently, the Statutory requirement of an initial deposit of Rs. 25,000 with the Controller of Currency before a Life Assurance Company could be floated has served as an effective safeguard in preventing the growth of mushroom concerns.
