

Subject: -Annual Report on the working of the Indian Companies Act, 1913, for the year 1928-29.

SIR,

I have the honour to submit the Annual Report on the administration of the Indian Companies Act, VII of 1913, the Societies Registration Act, XXI of 1860, the Provident Insurance Societies Act, V of 1912, and the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act, VI of 1912, for the year ending 31st March 1929, together with the ten statistical statements prescribed by the Government of India. A list of private Companies has been annexed to this Report and marked "A".

2. Mr. H. C. B. Mitchell held charge of the office of the Registrar of Companies from 1st April 1928 to 13th March 1929. As he went on leave, I took over charge from him on 14th March 1929 and held charge of the office tor the rest of the year under report.

# The Indian Companies Act VII of 1913.

3. During the year under report, 95 new companies were registered as against 74 in the previous year. Of these 88 were limited by shares and seven limited by Guarantee, having no share capital. Of the seven Companies of the latter class, one obtained a license from the Local Government under Section 26 of the Act to dispense with the word "Limited", being an Association not for profit. Out of the said 88 share capital Companies, 35 were Public and 53 Private.

Though there has been some rise in the registration of new Companies as compared with the last year's figures, this cannot be taken as a sign of trade revival. Since out of the excess of the number of the Companies registered this year over those of last year, 13 are private Companies; and the new public Companies are, from their nature, not likely to exert any appreciable influence on the growth of trade. The mill strikes and the riots in Bombay have greatly disorganised the mill industry and probably on this account, the number of new Cotton Mill Companies is only 6 for the year as compared with 11 in 1927-28.

- 5. The Statement No. I annexed hereto gives an abstract of the registrations and removals from the register during the year.
- 6. The total number of existing Companies at the close of the year was 857 being an increase of 50 over the number in the previous year.
- 7. It is interesting to note that the paid up capital of existing Companies has once again gone over Rs. 100 crores.

## Branch Registers.

8. No notices were filed during the year under Section 41 of the opening by any Company of a branch register in the United Kingdom.

### Auditors.

9. The total number of persons holding certificates under Section 144 of the Act was 94 at the beginning of the year. One person holding a restricted certificate died and thirteen others were granted unrestricted certificates during the year, thus carrying the number to 106 at the close of the year. Three persons holding temporary restricted certificates applied for renewal of their certificates during the year and Government extended the period of their certificates for five years in each case.

# Compliance with the provisions of Section 136.

10. The reports of the Assistant Registrars of Companies who were requested to make inquiries in the matter showed that the provisions of Section 136 of the Act were complied with during the year by the Companies in their districts to which the provisions of the Section applied with the exception of one Company which was warned to be more careful in future.

# Foreign Companies.

- 11. Twenty-five Companies incorporated outside British India established places of business in this Presidency during the year as against twenty-two in the year preceding. A list of these Companies is annexed hereto and marked "B".
- 12. The under-mentioned Companies closed their offices in this Presidency and were removed from the list:—
  - (1) Port of Manchester Marine Insurance Company, Limited.
  - (2) Ozuburin and Company, Limited.
  - (3) Lyon Lord and Company, Limited.
  - (4) International Banking Corporation.

## Change of Name.

13. Only one Company, viz., "The Premier Insurance Company, Limited" changed its name. The new name assumed with the sanction of the Registrar, under Section 11 (2), was "The Prabhat Insurance Company, Limited".

## Societies Registration Act, XXI of 1860.

14. During the year under report, 53 Societies were registered under this Act as against 47 in the preceding year. A list of these Societies is annexed hereto and marked "C". Two Societies, viz., "The Bombay Sailors' Home Society" and "The Prince of Wales Seamen's Institute and Bombay Harbour Mission" ceased to exist independently as they were amalgamated with the "Bombay Seamen's Society". "The Female Education Society, Malwan" altered its name to "Women's Education Society, Malwan".

## Provident Insurance Societies Act, 1912.

15. There was no change in the number of Societies registered under this Act during the year.

## Indian Life Assurance Companies Act, 1912.

- 16. During the year under report, the undermentioned Companies complied with the provisions of the Act:—
  - (1) The Jupiter General Insurance Company, Limited.
  - (2) The Prabhat Insurance Company, Limited.
  - (3) General Assurance Trust (India), Limited.
  - (4) The Commonwealth Assurance Company, Limited.
  - (5) The Central Mutual Life Assurance Society, Limited (a Guarantee Company).

A list of papers received from the Government of India under Section 27 is given in Appendix "D".

#### Prosecutions.

17. One Company was prosecuted during the year for contravening the provisions of Section 32 and was fined. A liquidator having failed to comply with the provisions of Section 244 of the Act was prosecuted and was fined. One provident insurance company and its directors were prosecuted for infringing the provisions of Sections 76, 32, 131 and 134 of the Act. The case is pending. Many defaults by Private Companies under Section 32 of the Act were noticed but as the non-compliance with the law was due to ignorance or inartention, the Companies concerned were cautioned and no prosecutions against them instituted.

The increase under items 1, 8 and 14 is due to a larger number of registrations of new Companies with the consequent filing of the usual documents. The increases and decreases under several heads can only be attributed to fluctuations.

## Financial Results.

19. The revenue realised in fees under the various Acts and by sale of forms as detailed in Statement X amounted to Rs. 43,229.5.0 as against Rs. 35,186-10-9 in the year preceding. Contrast of the realisations of the two years classified under different heads is made in the subjoined Table:—

The increase in revenue under items 1, 2, 9, 11 and 16 is due to the fees levied on the registration of new. Companies and Charitable Societies. The increase under item 17 is attributable to the grant of a larger number of Auditor's certificates. The decrease under item 20 is probably due to the

fact that some Companies printed their own forms. The other items of increase or decrease are ordinary fluctuations and call for no comment.

20. The office expenditure amounted to Rs. \*38,084-14-0 as against Rs. 35,965-13-0 in the preceding year. A comparative table showing the details is given below:—

The increase under item 3 I(d) and 3 II(d) are of a non-recurring nature. The decrease under item 3 I(a) is due to the smaller number of Meetings of the Auditors' Council held during the year.

21. The allowances drawn by the Registrar as Administrator General have not been included in this report.
