NOTE.—It may be explained for the information of Hon'ble Members that, in view of the revised financial arrangements with the provinces which come into effect from the 1st April 1921 and of the revised classification of account heads which is being introduced from that date, the Budget Statements have been prepared in two parts. Part I shows the revenue and expenditure of the Imperial and Provincial Governments together, under the existing financial arrangements and classification, according to the accounts for 1919-20 and the Budget and Revised estimates for 1920-21. Since the 1st April 1920 the accounts have been kept on the basis of £1=R10, while the actuals for 1919-20 and the Budget estimates for 1920-21 were prepared on the basis of £1=R15. For facility of comparison the latter have accordingly in Part I been recast on the basis of £1=R10.

Part II shows the Budget estimates of the Central Government's revenue and expenditure for 1921-22 under the new financial arrangements and classification, and to these figures have been added, for purposes of comparison, the approximate figures of the accounts for 1919-20 and the Revised estimates for 1920-21, as they would have stood if the new division of revenue and expenditure between the Central and Provincial Governments and the new classification had been in force in these years. Thus, the deficit of R18,76,66,000 shown in Statement I in Part II under the Revised estimate for 1920-21 represents the net deficit (after allowing for contributions from the provinces) which would have accrued in the Central Government's revenue account, if the new division of revenue and expenditure had been in force during the year.

A similar separate exhibition of debt, remittance and similar transactions is not necessary, and they are accordingly shown in Part II for all the three years, the accounts for 1919-20 being converted at £1=R15 as in the actual accounts for that year, and the Revised and Budget estimates at £1=R10.
