FOREWORD

ACCORDING to the scheme approved by the Census Commissioner for India, the Uttar Pradesh Census Reports will form Volume II of the India series. The Volume will consist of the following parts :

Part I-A—Report

Part I-B—Subsidiary Tables

Part II-A—General Population Tables

Part II-B—Economic Tables

Part II-C—Age and Social Tables

Besides the above State-parts there will be two series of district-wise publications as follows :

(1) *District Population Statistics* containing

(a) Mohalla-/Ward-wise population of urban areas and

(b) Village-wise population of rural areas.

(2) *District Census Handbooks* containing for smaller units of the district the data presented district-wise in the main tables, and some additional statistics.

A few brochures on specific subjects may also be published.

2. The Report and Tables of 1931 Census were published in two parts simultaneously in 1933. The 1951 Census tabulation has been much more elaborate than that of 1931 and the Report and Tables are being presented in five parts. It has been decided to publish the parts as they are printed. Part II-A containing General Population Tables was published in August, 1952, and Part I-B containing Subsidiary Tables, in October, 1952. It is hoped that the remaining two parts will be published at short intervals within a few months. The District Population Statistics have been partly printed and will be completed shortly. The original publishing programme has been slightly delayed on account of unforeseen difficulties.

3. Table B-IV relating to unemployment included in this volume does not form part of the All India Series of Tables. It is based on tabulation of answers to Question 13 which was framed at the suggestion of the State Government.
