PREFACE.

The 1951 Census Report of Bihar which forms Volume V of the Census Report of India, 1951 is divided into two parts : Part I containing the narrative report and Subsidiary Tables ; and Part II containing the Main Tables. To avoid bulkiness, Part II is being presented in two separate volumes. This volume which is the first has been numbered as Part IIA, and contains A—General Population Tables, C—Household and Age Sample Tables, D—Social and Cultural Tables, and E—Summary Figures for Districts, Subdivisions, Revenue Thanas and Police Stations. The second volume—Part IIB contains the B—Economic Tables.

2. Tables A-I to A-IV are similar to Imperial Tables I to IV of earlier census reports. Table A-V corresponds to Imperial Table V, but the distribution of the population has been shown by Livelihood Classes and not by Religion as previously.

3. All the five Tables in the C-Series (Household and Age) are based on samples. The age figures have not been smoothed and are shown as actually returned. Tables C-III and C-IV are similar to Tables VII and XIII of 1931. Tables C-I—Household Size and Composition, C-II—Livelihood Classes by Age Groups and C-V—Single Year Age Returns have been prepared for the first time at this census.

4. Of the Social and Cultural Tables, D-I—Language, D-II—Religion and D-IV—Migrants correspond more or less to Tables XV, XVI and VI of 1931 ; Tables D-III—Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, D-V—Displaced Persons, D-VI—Non-Indian Nationals and D-VII—Livelihood Classes by Educational Standards are new.

5. Table E—Summary Figures by Districts, Subdivisions, Revenue Thanas and Police Stations, replaces Provincial Tables I and II of earlier census reports.
