

#### A COMMISSION.

I, Edward Northey, Major-General of His Majesty's Forces, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor of the Colony of Kenya, do by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Commissions of Inquiry Ordinance, 1912, by this my Commission under my hand appoint:—

to be Commissioners to inquire into and report upon the execution of Public Works in the Colony, and to make recommendations as to the scope of the activities of the Public Works Department and as to improvement in its methods and efficiency.

And I do hereby appoint the said Col. John Kerr Robertson, R.E., to be Chairman of such Commission and in case the said Col. Robertson should be unable to act as Chairman I do hereby direct that the Commissioners shall elect one of their number to act as Chairman during such time as the said Col. Robertson is unable so to act.

And I do hereby appoint Alfred Ernest Hoer to be Secretary of the said Commission.

And I do hereby direct that three of the aforesaid Commissioners shall form a quorum.

And I do hereby direct that the aforesaid inquiry be held at such places in the Colony and Protectorate as the Chairman may think fit.

And I do hereby command all persons whom it may concern to take lue notice hereof and to give their obedience accordingly.

#### A COMMISSION.
