I forward herewith the Annual Report on Industrial Co-operative Societies and Village Industries in the State for the year ended 30th June 1949, submitted by the Joint Registrar, Industrial Co-operatives and Village Industries.

- 2. I am in general agreement with the conclusions arrived at by him and endorse his view that there has been a systematic planning and development of various types of cottage and village industries.
- 3. With regard to Industrial Co-operatives, the progress recorded during the year has been satisfactory. The Organisation and registration of one Regional and two District Industrial Co-operative Banks is expected to pave the way for providing adequate finance required by Primary Industrial Societies. The increase in the number of societies and their membership as well as working capital, have been satisfactory. It is expected that the appointment of Industrial Supervisors to supervise over the working of these societies will ensure systematic working of these Societies.
- 4. The working of technical training institutions of the Department, the interest taken by social workers, the financial and other assistance given by Government and increased awakening amongst artizans, have also contributed to the development of the "Induscos".


