#### SRI GANAPATHI

#### Koodumale, Near Mulbagal, Kolar Dist.

"At the foot of the hill (Koodumale) are the ruins of several large temples, with sculpture attributed to Jakanachari, but apparently restored by Ilavanji Raya in the Fourteenth Century."—B. L. Rice.

"The Mahaganapathi image is seated on an oval seat, one and a half feet high, which is raised on an oblong pedestal, two feet high. The oval seat and the image are all of the same green stone and form one piece. The image is a beautiful, well-proportioned one, about eight and a half feet high excluding the seat. The girth of the belly is about 12—13 feet."—Archaeological Survey of Mysore, 1930.
