PREFACE

This edition of the Constitution is for meeting the demand of the general public for a handy volume without footnotes. It reproduces the text of the Constitution of India as amended by Parliament from time to time. All amendments unde by Parliament up to and including the Constitution (Forty-second Amendment) Act, 1976 (except those which have not yet been brought into force) have been incorporated in this edition.

This Constitution applies to the State of Jammu and Kashmir with certain exceptions and modifications as provided in article 370 and the Constitution (Application to Jammu and Kashmir) Order, 1954. By virtue of the modification to clause (2) of article 368, no amendment to the Constitution can have effect in relation to the State of Jammu and Kashmir unless the same is applied to that State. The exceptions and modifications provided in the Order have been indicated in the appropriate places by means of a dagger and an asterisk respectively and the Order, as amended up-to-date, has been reproduced in Appendix II. The amendments which have not been applied to the State have been indicated by a dagger and a number, the number being the number of the relevant Constitution Amendment Act. In the case of such amendments by way of substitution or insertion, clause, proviso, explanation, sub-heading or entry, the dagger and the relevant number have been indicated at the beginning of the article, clause, proviso, explanation, sub-heading or entry In the case of such amendments of only a portion of a clause,

proviso, explanation or entry, the dagger and the relevant number of the Constitution Amendment Act have been indicated at the end of the clause, proviso, explanation or entry.
