#### **PREFACE**

This revised edition reproduces the text of the Constitution of India, as amended by Parliament from time to time. All amendments made by Parliament up to and including the Constitution (Forty-fourth Amendment) Act, 1978 (except those which have not been brought into force) are incorporated in this edition. The foot notes below the text indicate the particular Constitution Amendment Acts by which such amendments have been made.

2. The Constitution applies to the State of Jammu and Kashmir with certain exceptions and modifications as provided in article 370 and the Constitution (Application to Jammu and Kashmir) Order, 1954. This Order has been included in Appendix I. The exceptions and modifications specified in this Order are with reference to the text of the Constitution on the 20th day of June, 1964 as amended by the subsequent amendments to the Constitution which have been made applicable to the State (vide clause 2 of the Order). As some of the amendments made in the Constitution during the period from the 20th day of June, 1964 to the 10th day of August, 1975 [the date of assent of the Constitution (Thirty-ninth Amendment) Act, 1975] and all the amendments made thereafter have not yet been applied to the State of Jammu and Kashmir, a re-statement of the exceptions and modifications has been included in Appendix II.
