Introductory Note

This is Volume II of the List of Publications on the East European socialist economies, in the Library of the Servants of India Society. The earlier List published in Sept. 1982, under the same title, should be treated as Volume I, though it has not been mentioned as such on its title page.

Section 1 of the present List includes documents of the United Nations and its various agencies, which are relevant for the study of the East European socialist economies. Since our Library is one of the depository centres in India for the publications of the United Nations, it was thought that a classified list of the relevant publications would be useful to the researchers. The United Nations material consists of books, bulletins, periodicals, reports and reviews, serials, surveys and yearbooks. The nature of the publications is mostly descriptive and informative or purely statistical in form except in a very few cases where it is analytical.

The UN publications in this List are arranged under different subject-headings. The List is divided region-wise beginning with the region covering More than one country, and followed by Bulgaria to Yugoslavia in the alphabetical order. Each entry under the subject-heading begins with the title followed by author or editor, year of publication (if it is not added in the sales number), sales number and accession number. If sales number is not available then document number is indicated. Titles in the entries are arranged alphabetically. Incidentally the United Nations

documents in the Library are not arranged according to the Colon classification system on the shelves of the Library, but according to the various publishing organizations: for example, all FAO publications are kept together.

A few publications by the Government of Canada and by the European Economic Community on the region are also included in Section I in separate lists.

Section II of this List includes all other publications on the concerned region (including material on Microfiche cards) which were received in the Library during the period Sept. 1982 to Jan. 1984. The earlier volume (Volume I) contained all publications in the Library upto Sept. 1982.

It should be noted here that the present list is a part of the continuing documentation work undertaken at the Centre for Study of the East European Socialist Economies, in the Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics. The earlier works are :

1) A Bibliography of English language articles on East European Socialist Economies, 1977-1981 (Partially Annotated), published in 1981.

2) A List of Publications on East European Socialist Economies, in the Servants of India Society's Library, published in Sept. 1982, and which is considered as Volume I of the present List (Volume II).
