The 'Indian Forest Statistics' is a continuation of the old publication "Annual Returns of Statistics relating to Forest Administration in India". The Annual Returns covered only the former Provinces and some of the Chief Commissioners Administrations. Consequent on integration of the former Indian States since Independence, it has now become possible to include data in respect of some of the Part B States also. Opportunity has also been taken of presenting the data in an improved form.

The information contained in this publication, however, relates to Government forests only, since detailed statistics in respect of private forests are not available.
