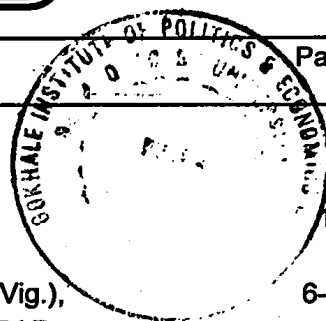

ADMINISTRATION REPORT 1992-93

INTRODUCTION

Under the Section 124 of the M. M. C. Act, I place the 'ADMINISTRATION REPORT' for the year 1992-93 before the Corporation. The report brings out salient features of the activities carried out and the services rendered by various departments of the Municipal Corporation during the year 1992-93, which are briefly narrated below :-

2. The Public Health Department collected vital statistics on various communicable and other diseases including births and deaths and has been maintaining Public Health Laboratory for examination of water and food samples. The Department implements National Programmes like T. B. Control, Malaria Eradication etc. along with combating the dreaded disease like Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS). AIDS Surveillance Centres with blood sample testing facilities have been started with assistance from ICMR at various Hospitals through Government of Maharashtra.

During the year 1992, in all 2, 11, 127 births and 80,074 deaths were registered. Birth and Death rates for 1992 were 20.8 and 8.00 respectively. The infant mortality rate for 1000 live births was 47.2 and the maternal mortality rate was 0.3. There is decline in infant and maternal mortality rate as compared to that of the preceding year.

As part of preventive work, emphasis is given on the Medical Examination of the school children. Further, the public Health Department is rendering Medical Service to the citizens through 14 General Hospitals, 5 specialized hospitals one each for E. N. T., Eye, T. B., Infectitious diseases and leprosy, 25 maternity Homes, 154 Allopathic dispensaries, 3 Aurvedic dispensaries, 2 Unani dispensaries, one S. T. D. clinic and one drug de-addiction centre.

Indian Population Project V launched in the year 1988 with the World Bank Assistance provided preventive and promotive health care services through various health posts in different localities at the door step of the needy people.

3. City Engineer's Department carried out construction of Bridges, Municipal Markets, Schools. Similarly, the Environment Sanitation and Project Department carried out air quality monitoring in different parts of Mumbai. Similarly, Slum Improvement Cell provided basic civic amenities under Environmental Improvement Scheme for construction of Primary Schools, dispensaries, reconstruction of dilapidated sanitary blocks in the slum areas.

4. Development Plan Department finally had the Development Control Regulations approved by the State Government effective from 25-3-1991. The State Government had accepted the concept of Transfer of Development Rights, to be given to the owners of the land which are under reservations and if handed over free cost and free of encumbrances to the Municipal Corporation. Accommodation reservation had also been accepted by State Government.

5. The Road Department is mainly responsible for construction, resurfacing and maintenance of asphalt roads admeasuring about 1500 kms. and mastication of the junctions.

6. The cement Concrete Roads Department has taken up the works of construction of Cement concrete Roads. Uptill now 110 kms. of major roads were concretised at the cost of Rs. 135 crores. Hence, the problem of pot holes on the roads is now reduced.

7. Mechanical & Electrical Department carried out the work of Planning, Procurement, erection, supervision, service maintenance and repairs of the Mechanical & Electrical works of the various departments such as --

- 1) Municipal Power Laundry.
- 2) Municipal Workshop.
- 3) Medico Electronic Cell.
- 4) Air Conditioning Plants.
- 5) Municipal Foundry.
- 6) EPABX System.
