#### INTRODUCTION

The Season and Crop Report is an important publication brought out by Department of Agriculture of Maharashtra State which presents facts and figures pertaining to Agriculture.

The present report gives districtwise data on area, production of agricultural crops and also rainfall data, farm harvest prices, agricultural wages and summary tables on these topics.

The rainfall data presented in the report is based on the daily rainfall figures received from revenue offices and from Indian Meteorological Department for few selected centres.

Data on land utilisation, sources of irrigation, areas under crops is received from the District Revenue Offices. The results of production estimates are based on the crop estimation surveys conducted on certain principal food and non-food crops. Particulars relating to agricultural wages are based on the data supplied by Revenue Offices, while the data pertaining to Farm Harvest Prices are based on the information collected from Agricultural Development Officers.

The report contains districtwise figures and also some summary tables which may prove helpful to the users of agricultural data.
