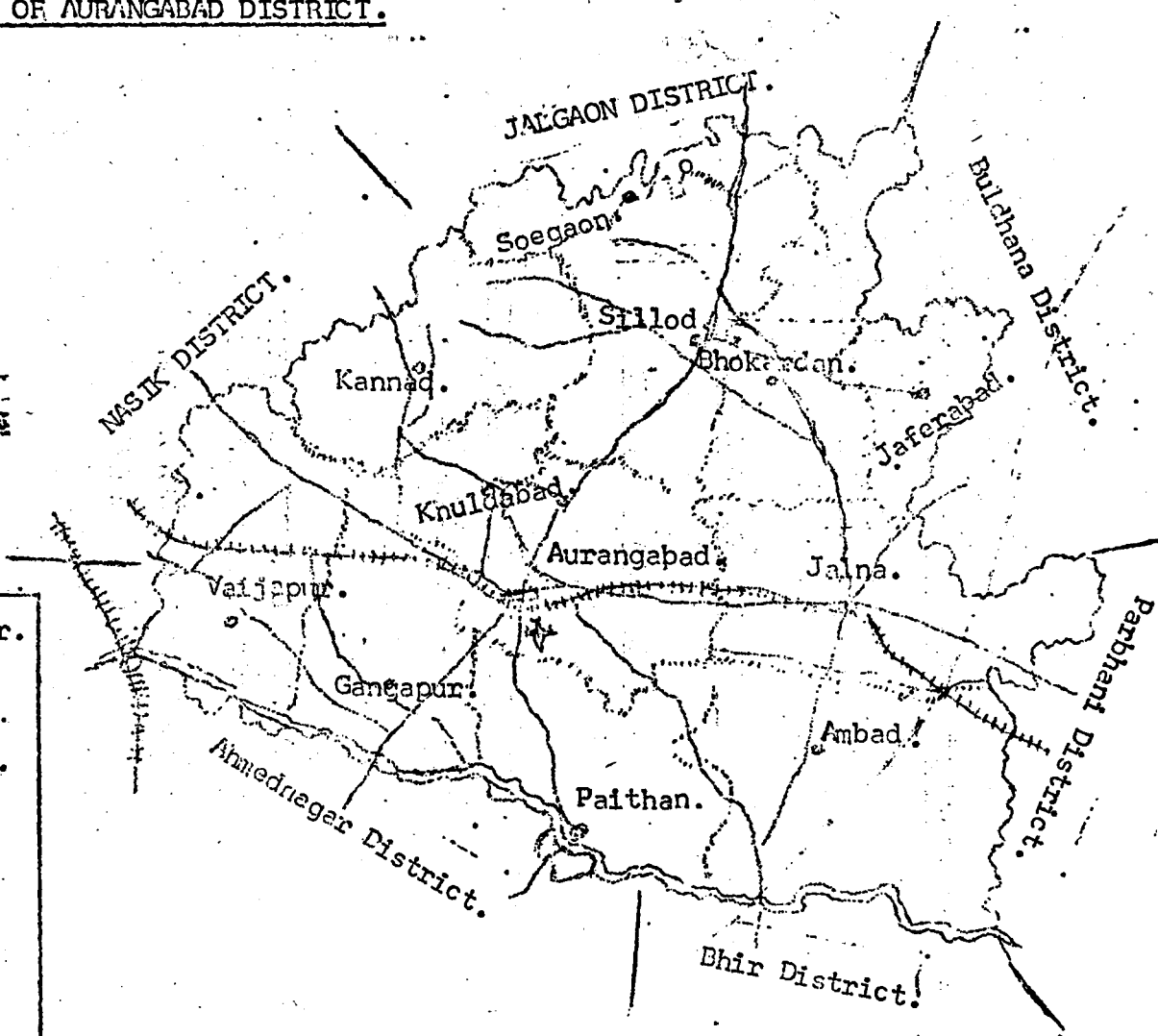
MAP OF AURANGABAD DISTRICT.
