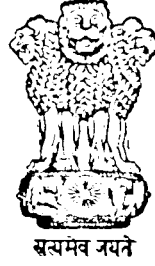

It is hoped that this publication will serve as an important reference book for those interested in the socio-economic studies of the State and its Districts.


We thank the various departments and offices of State Government, Government of India and Local Organisations which extended their full co-operation in supplying the requisite material for inclusion in this Abstract.
