1. Increase in Labour Rates.

 3. Adoption of Plan Protection Measures on Scientific Lines.
 4. Adoption of Improved methods of crops production.

- (b) Agricultural Extension Schemes:- This branch of Agriculture has now become the most popular and gaining importance as the activities of this sector are concerned with and affect the daily life and work of Agriculturist in general. Before 1950-51 or even upto that period there were very limited extension activities and their limitation were very narrow. There was no forceful drive for the better results achieved after long period of research etc. The machinery meant for extension activity was also meagre. But the condition slowly changed and thanks to the Planning Commission of India which launched effectively the 1st & 2nd plan period and now the 3rd plan. The brief review of the below mentioned activities and their achievements in 1st & 2nd Plan period will give some idea regarding the revolution in Agricultural Extension.

- (c) Experiments in double and triple cropping:- It is fact that there is maximum land utilization in India under agriculture and there limited scope for bringing new land under plough. It is therefore necessary to utilize the present cultivating land to its maximum and it is possible through two ways. First by double cropping and secondly by making available perennial irrigation sources. Thus, if atleast whole the land is double cropped the agricultural production will be doubled. Efforts are being made to make a head way. In this direction by facing the difficulties there are no experiments conducted in this district. But the progressive cultivation experience is convincing.
