Evaluation Report of Comprehensive District Agriculture Plan- Parbhani District

The Comprehensive District Agriculture Plan of Parbhani District was received by us from Director, Agricultural Processing and Marketing Division, Commissionerate of Agriculture, Government of Maharashtra, Pune, on May 20th, 2009.

After going through the report, we visited Parbhani district in the fourth week of September 2009. We first visited and discussed the plan with the experts of Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada Institute of Socio-Economic Research and National Integration, (SRTMRI) Aurangabad which was appointed by Government of Maharashtra as a Consultant (TSI) to prepare Comprehensive District Agriculture Plan of Parbhani district. The report was discussed thoroughly with the officials of SRTMRI and necessary suggestions and recommendations were made. Further, meeting with District Superintending Agriculture Officer, Officials of Agriculture and Allied departments, Taluka Agriculture Officers, NABARD Officials and representatives of Women Economic Development Boards, branch office, Parbhani was held. The potential and constraints of each department /sector was discussed and identified. The concerned officials explained to us that Parbhani district is gradually switching over to soybean cultivation, which is suited to the agro-climatic condition of the district. Consecutively last three years, low rainfall has adversely affected the agriculture sector in the district. Though the cropping intensity of the district (178.5 percent) is higher than most of districts in the state as well as state average (129.7 per cent) in the year 2007-08, cultivation of low value crops (coarse cereals and pulses) and unremunerative prices for agricultural commodities resulted in uneconomical agriculture. With respect to horticulture, Sweet Orange (Mosambi) and Kesar Mango were important fruit crops. In order to reach the grassroot level, a visit to villages, farms and field visit to farm ponds constructed under RKVY fund, and discussion with farmers was also carried out by us. Discussions were held with a number of farmers cultivating crops such as soybean, cotton, tur, Sweet Orange (Mosambi) and Mango (under Employment Guarantee Scheme linked to Horticulture and National Horticulture Mission schemes) in order to understand their constraints as well as their awareness regarding various schemes implemented by the government through which they could receive subsidy.

2. Has participatory bottom-up approach been followed or not?

Was information collected from 'Gram Sabhas'?

- We were informed that several informal meetings were held at village level with the members of *Krishi Vigyan Mandals* (a group of eleven progressive farmers per one thousand farmers) to understand and cater to the needs of the farming community. The suggestions and views were collected through *Krishi Dindi* and such kind of gathering in the villages.

- a) What other consultative process (es) were followed in the plan preparation? What is the extent to which inputs from sub-district level have contributed to the planning exercise? Here the factual position may be described.
- Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathawada Institute of Socio-Economic Research and National Integration, Aurangabad (SRTMRI) was appointed by Government of Maharashtra as a Consultant (TSI) to prepare Comprehensive District Agriculture Plan of Parbhani district. The SRTMRI engaged a team of experts, research consultants and research associates who were involved in preparation of CDAP.
 - The duly filled in Tables 1-78 were supplied to SRTMRI by District Superintendent Agriculture Officer (DSAO), Parbhani.

- The Officials of various departments, such as Agriculture, Horticulture, Dairy, Animal Husbandry, and Sericulture submitted proposals with the help of experts and research consultants and associates for innovative schemes.
 - Department of Social Forestry and Department of Fisheries of Government of Maharashtra, Parbhani district had not submitted any proposal for innovative schemes earlier. However, both the department submitted their proposals to the DSAO, Parbhani in our meeting with them.
- b) Whether agriculture planning units (APUs) at village, block/taluka and district level viz. VAPU, BAPU and DAPU actually exist. If not, what other mechanism was used for preparation of C-DAP.
- Meetings were held at district level, taluka level (e.g. Gangakhed taluka) and several informal meetings were held at village level. VAPU are not formally formed. However, we were informed that several informal meetings were held at village level with the members of *Krishi Vigyan Mandals* (a group of eleven progressive farmers per one thousand farmers) to understand and take into consideration the needs of the farming community. The DAPU was formed and few meetings were held (copies of meeting circular enclosed)
 - The members of the team involved in preparation of CDAP visited Parbhani district several times and reviewed the on-going schemes. Discussions were also held with progressive farmers.
 - Similarly the team had numerous rounds of discussions, with district officers and representatives of local institutions like the KVK. The Collector of the district was also consulted. This helped the TSI in gaining insights on the issues involved in preparation of CDAP.

v) Were efforts made to address a) Emerging challenges from global trade and climate changes? b) Innovative approaches which can improve the livelihood and economic condition of the people in the area c) Priority areas as per agro-ecological situation.

a) The major crops cultivated in the district are Kharif Jowar, Moog, Cotton, Tur, Soybean, Rabi Jowar, Gram, Wheat, which occupied around 9, 8, 23, 7, 9, 19, 6 and 6 percent of the gross cropped area during 2007-08, respectively. During the discussion with the SRTMRI (TSI), government officials and farmers, it was observed that farmers are switching over to Soybean crop from Cotton crop.

A field visit and discussion with farmers was made with the farmers in Rahata village, Seed Production farms in Asola Village of Parbhani Taluka, and Gangakhed taluka. We also visited the farm pond (Size-30*30*3) constructed under RKVY and diesel pump engine (5 HP) purchased with 50 per cent subsidy for lifting the water from the pond. Farmers reported that subsidy for farm pond is less (70:30), which needs to be increased. Till date, total 1837 farm ponds were constructed in Parbhani district. Because of farm pond, the farmers could give one/two protective irrigation to the Cotton crops. We could notice the difference between the rainfed cotton crop and irrigated cotton crop. Though the district has Marathawada Agriculture University, located in Parbhani, the dissemination of technology from lab to farm is very slow. Also the attitude of the farmers towards farming is complacent and they are not eager to adopt new and scientific agricultural practises. Overall it was observed that farmers are not progressive minded and satisfied with basic requirements. We were informed that the present staff of the agricultural department is heavily engaged in non-agricultural activities and hence the work of the agricultural department receives a setback.

Due to huge gap between two rainfalls in the same season, productivity of cotton and soybean is likely to decrease in 2009-10 season. The farmers complained that the main constraint facing them was with the availability of fertiliser in the market. They explained that they could get fertilisers only after paying higher rates compared to actual rates and only after waiting in queue for more than six hours at the fertiliser shop.

Cotton and Soybean are important cash crop grown in Rahata village. Since last three years, farmers have been cultivating Bt Cotton varieties, which gave higher yields as compared to non Bt Cotton varieties. The field visit to a farm which had a farm pond constructed with subsidy under RKVY scheme indicated that with irrigation facilities, the farmer earned net returns of Rs 50,000/- per hectare from cultivation of Bt Cotton. Without irrigation facilities, farmers earned barely Rs 15,000/- to Rs 20,000/- per hectare from Bt. cotton

cultivation. Farmers were fully satisfied with Bt Cotton productivity especially when irrigation facilities were available. However, they reported that Bt cotton varieties are susceptible to sucking pests and while spraying towards control of bollworm was now not necessary, it was required for controlling the sucking pest. In view of less availability of water and uncertain rains, drip irrigation technology should be used in cotton.

It was also observed that area under soybean crop increased over the years. The production of soybean crop is likely to be affected in 2009-10 due to long dry spell between two rainfalls in the same season. We were informed that ICT centre located at Parbhani was ready to purchase the soybean crop last year at higher rate than market rates (Rs. 100/- more as compared to market rate), but was not permitted by the District Marketing Committee. Farmers also complained that there was a drastic fall in price in the post harvest season.

Seed production of important crops is one of the major activity/programmes undertaken in the district, supported by the Agriculture Department and Maharashtra State Seed Corporation Limited (MAHABEEJ). We visited the seed production field of soybean crop in Asola village. The foundation seed of Soybean crops developed by the Marathawada Agriculture University, Parbhani (variety- MAUS 71) was made available to the farmers. The farmers participating in the Seed Production Programme incurred about Rs. 1200/ acre towards seed cost (cost of 30 kg seed), Rs. 1000/acre towards fertiliser cost and Rs. 200/acre towards insecticide cost. The certification charges amounted to Rs. 120/acre and Processing charges were Rs. 250/acre. The total cost of participating in the Seed production programme was thus around Rs 3200/- to Rs. 3500 per acre. The farmers reaped about 8 quintals per acre (20 quintals per hectare) for which they received Rs. 3300/qt. (Rs 1000/-per quintal was the subsidy component for participating in the scheme). Thus their net return from participation in Seed production programme was about around Rs 22000/- to Rs. 23000/- per acre under ideal conditions. The seed produce is then used as certified seed, which was made available to village farmers at lower rates as compared to the seeds of private seed companies. By purchasing these seeds the farmers were assured of germination and production as they had observed the same in the fields of those who participated in the scheme.

Overall farmers have switched over to Bt cotton in order to improve productivity and they can be more competitive in the global market. Heat stress and drought however reduced yield of most crops. Due to lack of sufficient rainfall, ground water was not being recharged. Allied activities such as dairy and poultry had limitations due to excessive heat, lack of water and fodder. Hence, farmers were reluctant to practise these activities.

- b) In Parbhani district, major crops cultivated are Cotton, Bajra, Maize and Rabi Jowar. Allied activities have not gained popularity. Though Dairy farming has great scope in the district, there are several limitations. Mostly *desi* varieties are available and hybrid ones are costly. There is lack of fodder and green and dry fodder is not given to the cattle in suitable proportions when required. The farmers were not satisfied with the price which they received for milk. Further, cooperative societies which are popular in many districts of the state were not available in the district for marketing milk. These factors have brought constraints in milk production in the district. Milk production in the district cannot even meet half the milk requirement and therefore milk is brought into the district from neighbouring districts of Ahmednagar and Jalgaon. A number of Self Help groups in the district for women are now being involved in promotion of dairy so as to encourage milk production.

Most of the farmers had complained about non cooperation and disbursement of credit to agriculture sector by the commercial banks.

Farmers complained of 8-10 hours load (electricity) shedding for farming and acute shortage of water which served as a major bottleneck in increasing productivity of crops.

Sweet orange and Mango are two important fruit crops planted in the district under EGS and NHM scheme. Farmers reported that the subsidy amount should be increased and pack house should be constructed at taluka place. There is also scope to promote agro-based industries which will help to generate rural non-farm income.

The Socio Economic Development Trust, Kerwadi, Palam and Women Economic Development Corporation, Parbhani branch, Parbhani is organising training for the women with the objective of empowering women and making them economically self sufficient. A large number of SHGs are formed in the districts and are making rapid progress with the help of bank finance. As women are greatly involved in agricultural activities throughout the year (in fact some of the agricultural operations like weeding, cotton picking, etc. are exclusively done by the women), training on various agriculture and allied activities would help in making agriculture and allied sector economically viable.

The district is providing extension services to farmers through mobile phones. From every village in the district 5 farmers receive messages on insecticides and pesticides to be sprayed and other cultivation practises. Timely information on extension services is disseminated to farmers which greatly reduces their cost of cultivation. Thus farmers receive timely and accurate guidance through mobile telephones. This information is also displayed at prominent places in the village.

- c) The Agro-Climatic regions were not indicated in the report, In our discussion with SRTMRI (TSI) Officers, we brought to their notice that it should be included.

However, during our discussion with Agriculture Officer, we learnt that the district falls within two agro-climatic zones. Six talukas or their major parts come under the Assured Rainfall Zone comprising of Jintur, Selu, Manwath, Pathri, Parbhani and Purna talukas. Three talukas, viz. Sonpeth, Gangakhed and Palam fall in the Moderate to Moderately High rainfall zone.

The district was divided into four Agro-Ecological Zones, based on the agro ecological situation prevailing in different parts of the district (as mentioned in SRAEP, Parbhani).

- SRTMRI (TSI) received the data tables 1-78 from DSAO, Parbhani.

b. Give suggestions for improving data sources:

-The data presented in report needed suitable editing and necessary correction. The data source and year of reference should be mentioned at appropriate places. The same was brought to the notice of SRTMRI (TSI) and DSAO, Parbhani.

ii. **Quantity and quality of data** satisfactory or not? If not, what more data was needed? How the quality of data can be improved?

-The data available was satisfactory. However, it was informed to them that growth rate of agriculture and allied sector for Xth Five Year Plan must be calculated so that it can be compared with the projected growth rate of XI th Plan. Further, the tables along with explanations should be incorporated in the report at appropriate places.

Parameters of data analysis –

i. SWOT analysis of LB/District done thoroughly or not? (It should be of the district and not the individual activities)-

-SWOT analysis is fairly satisfactory. However, it has to be more specific and reported with facts and figures.

ii. Block data to explain spatial disparities/variability of the district given or not?

- Most of the data has been presented block-wise (as per manual). However, there are certain gaps in reporting the data.

iii. Gaps for important variables worked out or not?-

- Talukawise yield gap analysis has been reported. However, there are certain gaps in reporting the data.

iv. Trends from the data collected for important variables like land use parameters, agro-based industry, production, productivity, population, population growth and migration, employment opportunities etc. taken into account or not?; -

- The data on Varietal Demonstration (Table 48), Animal Husbandry department (Table 59), Water Spread Area (Table 62), detailed Social Forestry Action Plan (Table 68), SSI units (Table 69), Handloom and Textiles (Table 73) were incomplete/not reported (Vol. III). Data in tables should be checked.

- v. Summary tables prepared or not for discussions to synthesize needs/ problems/ potentials in a participatory mode?

- The data on Varietal Demonstration (Table 48), Animal Husbandry department (Table 59), Water Spread Area (Table 62), detailed Social Forestry Action Plan (Table 68), SSI units (Table 69), Handloom and Textiles (Table 73) were incomplete/not reported (Vol. III). Data in tables should be checked.

- vi. Base maps and district profile given or not? Are these adequate?

-The maps like forest, livestock density by types, water logged areas, road density, market density, percent of houses electrified and School and PHCs , etc. are not presented as per manual.

5. Synthesis of needs, problems, and potentials

- a) The analysis of data collected in tables 1-78 needs more discussion. The SWOT analysis should be further strengthened.
 - b) We were informed that several informal meetings were held at village level with the members of *Krishi Vigyan Mandals* (a group of eleven progressive farmers per one thousand farmers) to understand and take into consideration the needs of the farming community. The suggestions and views were collected through *Krishi Dindi* and other such gatherings in the villages. However, there is no written record of the same.
 - c) There is scope to improve the analysis.

List of these needs / problems/potentials given or not?

– It has not been spelt out clearly in the report.

Has **prioritization** of needs been done or not? Give the list of prioritized needs.

- Prioritization has not been done. However, on discussion at village level, it was observed that the most pressing need of farmers was lack of irrigation facilities. Due to failure of monsoon and untimely rains, ground water was not recharged. About 1800 farm ponds were constructed in Parbhani under RKVY. There were cases when some ponds were dry as rainfall was negligible in some villages. Besides water, farmers complained of lack of timely availability of inputs especially fertilizers. Due to shortage of fertilizers at the appropriate time, farmers had to purchase it at higher than market prices. Further, the soil also lacked micro nutrients. Lack of micro nutrients had an adverse impact of yield and farmers suggested that subsidy for micro nutrients was a pressing need.

- There was no processing plant in the villages because of which farmers faced great hardships.

-Promotion of allied activities such as dairy had its own limitations. Lack of irrigation water, drought conditions and unavailability of fodder was a major constraint in promoting dairy. There was also 8-10 hours of load shedding for agriculture which served as a major constraint.

- Several farmers wanted to avail of subsidy under NHM and had prepared their proposals. However, the targets laid out had already been achieved and new targets had not been set. Hence farmers were not able to avail of subsidy.

- In case of crop failure farmers received compensation. But they were not satisfied with the amount of compensation as it depended in the yield of the previous years and they also complained about delay in payment by the bank. In case of cotton, the previous yield when non Bt varieties were cultivated was very low. However yield had increased substantially after the adoption of Bt cotton and hence compensation paid to the farmers by taking into consideration non Bt yield was meagre.. Farmers expressed dissatisfaction on this count.

-Farmers suggested that crop insurance scheme should be linked with the rainfall pattern.

-Contract farming through which farmers can get appropriate inputs and access to technology and also a ready market was not popular in Parbhani taluka.

-An innovative scheme on Training Programme for Women in Agriculture should be included in the plan. This will be useful because women are without any assets and also lack education and exposure. Such programmes would help to empower them.

6. Study of ongoing programmes in the area

Parameters –

- i. Were on-going programmes and schemes been studied or not?
 - SRTMRI (TSI) reported that a team of experts were evaluating the impact of on-going scheme and had discussion with progressive farmers. Mention has been made about on-going scheme and financial targets and achievements for X plan.
- ii. How many needs, problems, potentials and solution interventions have been addressed through on-going programmes/schemes?
 - Target and achievement of schemes of X five year plan was presented.
- iii. How many funds were available from on-going programmes? Were these converged to formulate C-DAP or not?
 - This was not clear from report.

7. Formulation of projects in C-DAP

Parameters –

- i. Were the projects and works identified on the basis of: a) Prioritized needs, b) benefits expected, c) expenditure involved, and d) availability of needed material or infrastructure taken into account
 - For the XI Five Year Plan, physical and financial targets were indicated in case of Agriculture and Allied sectors as per manual.
 - The report concluded that in the XI th Plan, the agriculture and allied sector would grow at the rate of 9.27 per cent per annum. The Gross Value of Output per capita per annum in rural areas would increase from Rs. 13541 to 21098/- (at constant prices) during XIth Plan Period. However gross value of output includes cost of cultivation and hence it may not give the accurate picture. For example, if cost of cultivation has sharply increased each year then the net income accruing to the farmers would be far less.

ii. Was the decision logistics in deciding projects and works improved by discussion with the planning committee or not? (This ensures participation at various levels of C-DAP preparation)

- As mentioned above, Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathawada Institute of Socio-Economic Research and National Integration (SRTMRI), Aurangabad was appointed by Government of Maharashtra as a Consultant (TSI) to prepare Comprehensive District Agriculture Plan of Aurangabad district. The SRTMRI engaged a team of experts, research consultants and research associates who were involved in preparation of CDAP.
- The Tables 1-78 were supplied to SRTMRI by District Superintendent Agriculture Officer (DSAO), Parbhani.
- The Officials of various departments, such as Agriculture, horticulture, Dairy, Animal Husbandry, Sericulture submitted proposals with the help of experts and research consultants and associates for innovative schemes.
- Department of Social Forestry, Department of Fisheries of Government of Maharashtra, Parbhani district did not submit any proposal for innovative schemes. The concerned officials have submitted the detailed proposal during our meeting with the team at DSAO office on September 24, 2009.

-As mentioned earlier, we were informed that several informal meetings were held at village level with the members of *Krishi Vigyan Mandals* (a group of eleven progressive farmers per one thousand farmers) to understand and take into consideration the needs of the farming community. The suggestions and views were collected through *Krishi Dindi* and such kind of gathering in the villages. However, there is no written record of same.

8. In a number of district plans so far received, the procedure followed (in the plan preparation) is not clear. As a result some of the issues will become difficult to review. Therefore, the planning units may be advised to include one chapter/section describing methodology of preparing C-DAPs with the following details.

- i) Sources of data – official documents, sample surveys, Rapid Rural Appraisal (RRA), Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA), case-study method or any other method followed

-Explained

- ii) Technical methodology followed in arriving at the cost estimates of the proposed projects in the plan or at least a reference to the respective DPR s

-Explained

- iii) Description of the consultative processes followed. Details of the procedure followed in village level, block level and district level consultations may be provided. A copy of the village and block level schedules canvassed, if any, may also be included.

-Explained

- iv) A scheme of convergence (functional and convergence) among the existing programs/schemes.

-Not explained

- v) Any other detail important to preparation of C-DAP

-The details on change in per capita per annum GVO in rural areas at the end of XI Five Year Plan is presented.

The report focussed that 9.27 percent growth rate in XI th Plan can be achieved by improving productivity of all crops. It also suggested that Self Help Groups for asset poor and assetless farmers must be promoted. These farmers must be given training as well as financial support in order to get empowerment. They must be in a position to provide agro services to the village community and contribute to the rejuvenation of agriculture.

(This will help the reader to know about the procedure followed and activities undertaken during preparation of C-DAP)

9. Programme delivery spelt out or not? A table showing Name of department, project/ works/ activities entrusted to each department and funds provided are shown in C-DAP or not?

- Details of innovative projects and their profiles, budget, executive agency, monitoring agency and outcome has been indicated.

10. Monitoring and evaluation mechanism suggested or not?

- Suggested.

11. Others

AERCs should also comment on awareness about this planning initiative of the Government among people, departments, administrators and politicians of the area.

- During the field visit, it was observed that farmers are aware of subsidies on Farm pond, micro-irrigation, vermin compost, National Horticulture Mission, EGS linked Horticulture Scheme, NREGS, National Food Security Mission, Seed Production Programme.
- An association for progressive farmers was formed as '*Krishi Vigyan Mandal* (a group of eleven farmers per 1000 farmers). Also for getting suggestion and disseminating the information, workshop was organised, pamphlets were pasted at important places in villages and information was sent through mobile short message service to five selected farmers in every village. These messages provided timely information to farmers on extension activities to be undertaken such as timely spraying of pesticides. This information was very useful to farmers and greatly reduced their cost of cultivation.
- The information leaflets/pamphlets on efficient fertiliser use, biological pest control methods, biodynamic agriculture, vermin-compost, NADEP compost, soil testing for higher production, cotton and soybean insect pest management, etc. were distributed to the farmers besides the training, workshop and mobile short message service by Agriculture Department, Parbhani.

In addition to the above, the AERCs may suggest inclusions of details which they may deem necessary for a review/monitoring/evaluation in future.

On going through the report, following observations were made:

General Comments:

After going through the Parbhani C-DAP report, the following comments/observations are made:

- The CDAP report should be arranged as per the format given in Manual towards preparation of C DAP (Chapter IV- Format for preparation of the C-DAP, pp. 30-41) by adding required information at appropriate places and by deleting unwanted information.
- All the data tables should be checked thoroughly and year of reference and source of information should be mentioned at appropriate place(s).
- The data presented not relevant to the report should be deleted.
- Page numbers should be in order and table number should be given as per Chapter plan (for example Chapter II...Table number should 2.1, 2.2.....)
- The supporting information and details of scheme proposal/project profiles, etc. may be put as Annexure.
- Tying/Printing errors should be corrected.

Preliminary:

1. Preface/Forward, List of tables, list of figures/graphs, list of Annexures should be included.
2. Executive Summary should contain Xth Five Year Plan growth rate and production targets for XIth Five Year Plan to achieve 9.27 per cent growth during 2007-2012.

Chapter I- Introduction:

1. Chapter should be more comprehensive rather than so long. Point 1.2.7 to 1.2.12 may be excluded.
2. Point No. 1.3.01 to 1.3.06 may be put an Annexure.
3. Point No. 1.04.01 to 1.04.11 may be put as Methodology of the Study.
4. Point No. 1.05.01 to 1.05.05 may be put in as Annexure or include in Methodology section.
5. Point No. 1.8.1 to 1.8.5 may be shifted to Preliminary section.

Chapter II- General Description of the District:

1. The Chapter plan should be followed as per Manual as mentioned above.
2. Thirteen maps presented on pages 23-35 should be put/relocate at appropriate places with map no. and its reference in text.
3. Agro-climatic Region map, land capability classification map, road and market density, and other maps as mentioned in manual should be added at appropriate places.
4. Tables and data should be checked thoroughly and carefully. Some of the table are not with table title (page 52) / table number (page39). Also table numbers are not in order (page 36, 37). Table should contain unit as headnote and footnote with details if any and source of data.
5. The figures based on data should be included in the chapter at appropriate places.
6. The information of Agro-climatic regions/Agro ecological regions is missing.
7. Table no. 8 (page 45) presenting weather data- no of rainy days should be put with district average, not as district total.
8. Intra district growth differential should be highlighted by considering all the growth parameters.

Chapter III- SWOT Analysis:

1. The SWOT analysis should be written with facts and figures. It should be made on the basis of realities. It should not be general.
2. Tying/Printing errors should be corrected.
3. Writing on Weakness should be more specific and it should be minimise in view of objective of CDAP.
4. The description on Low Medium High Growth talukas should be added.

Chapter IV- Development of Agriculture Sector:

1. Tying/Printing errors should be corrected.
2. Table 4.1, page 79 should be checked. It presents data for **Jalna** district.
3. Data on taluka-wise sources of irrigation, irrigation project (s) completed and in progress in district should be presented.
4. Major crop with varieties grown in the district be presented.
5. Table 4.3 totals should be checked (page 86).
6. Table 4.4 (page 87) presents growth rate obtained in frontline demo, please indicate period of same and location.
7. On page 100, please correct the table number mentioned in the text (Table 4.7 or 4.4).
8. Table 4.8 on Effect of irrigation on Crop Yield, third column should be corrected (it is vacant). The table title did not suit with data presented in table (page 91).
9. Table 4.7 presents that 15.0 % area under Cotton crop is irrigated, however, Table 4.14 presented main reason for yield gap in cotton is 94% area is rainfed, please correct.
10. Input Management should be presented with data on Seed Replacement Ratio, SRR Projection for XIth FYP, Fertiliser requirement, Plant protection requirement in the district.
11. On page 100, income analysis is presented (Table No. 6.18?????). Please correct table number and justify the estimation of per household income (2004-07) by taking constant share of no of holdings of cultivators (year 2000-01) as per their proportion in total land holding.
12. Tenth Five Year Plan growth rate should be presented (Table 4.34, page 128) in addition to 9 years growth rate.

Chapter V- Allied Agricultural Sector:

1. Please correct the table numbers (pages 142-147; 192-197, 210).
2. Major horticulture crops and varieties grown in the district should be added.
3. Tenth Five Year Plan growth rate should be presented (Table 1????, page 234 and 235)).
4. Project profile (page 148 to 153) may be put as Annexure.
5. Table 1 to 3 (page 192 to 194) should be presented as one table.
6. Fisheries development data and description is missing.
7. Social Forestry data and description is missing.
8. On page no 232, milk, meat and egg production of **Latur** district is presented. Also processing/storage/marketing gaps of Latur district (p 233), please correct.

Chapter VI- District Plan:

1. Data on MSP, Cost of Cultivation may be deleted (p 243).
2. Tenth Five Year Plan growth rate should be presented.

The mentioned points were brought to the notice of SRTMRI and DSAO, Parbhani during detailed discussions with them.
