

7. *Expenditure.*—The aggregate expenditure of the local boards chargeable to current income increased from Rs. 1,81,45,353 to Rs. 1,88,19,497. The principal variations under the main heads are explained below :—

(a) *Administration.*—The expenditure increased from Rs. 7,60,014 to Rs. 7,99,396. The increase occurred in all Divisions and was mainly due to the payment of increments to members of the establishments and greater expenditure on account of leave salaries, travelling allowances and the entertainment of additional establishment.

(b) *Education.*—The expenditure increased from Rs. 1,14,89,248 to Rs. 1,17,34,193. The increase occurred in all Divisions except the Southern Division and was mainly due to (i) larger expenditure on primary education, and (ii) payment of arrears of grants and other dues to school boards.

(c) *Medical.*—The expenditure increased from Rs. 12,58,635 to Rs. 13,25,474. The increase occurred in all Divisions except the Southern Division and was due to (i) the opening of new dispensaries and hospitals, (ii) expenditure on pay and travelling allowance of medical officers appointed on special duty in connection with epidemics and (iii) payment of increased grants or arrears to dispensaries, etc.

(d) *Civil Works.*—The expenditure increased from Rs. 38,64,510 to Rs. 41,09,004. The increase occurred in all Divisions except the Northern Division and was mainly due to increased expenditure on communications and buildings.

8. *Closing balances.*—The aggregate balances of all the local boards amounted to Rs. 66,77,934 as against Rs. 60,30,314 in the previous year. The closing balances of most of the district local boards were in excess of the prescribed minima. This was due to (i) the accumulation of balances of the district school boards and taluka local boards and other deposits and advances, (ii) the late recovery of local fund cess and (iii) non-completion of the budgetted works.

9. *Primary Education—Sind.*—In most of the Districts there was a slight increase in the number of schools as well as pupils but on the whole the progress of primary education was slow.

*Northern Division.*—In Kaira District the number of schools increased from 647 to 655 due to certain classes being turned into schools. The attendance of boys and girls also showed improvement. In the Panch Mahals there are still many villages with a population of more than 500 which have no schools but the Ashram of the Bhil Seva Mandal and the schools conducted by Christian missionaries supplement to some extent the efforts of the Board in spreading education among the backward and depressed classes. In the Surat District the District Local Board took up the construction of 5 new school buildings under the Sir P. T. Scheme while 100 "Sir P. T. Libraries" were opened at central places under the reorganized scheme. In the Thana District there are 12 schools specially intended for the scheduled classes. The District Local Board continued to maintain a boarding house at Khardi for the scheduled classes and another at Mokhada for boys belonging to the Aboriginal and Hill tribes. There are 42 schools in the District specially meant for these classes and the number of pupils in them is reported to have increased from 2,600 to 3,008. The Board has requested Government to help it towards opening some more schools for these classes and the matter is under consideration.

*Central Division.*—In all the Districts except West Khandesh there was an increase in the number of primary schools maintained by the district school boards. It is also satisfactory to note that the number of pupils increased in all Districts except in Ahmednagar where it decreased by 648. No difficulty was experienced in any District in admitting children belonging to the scheduled classes into primary schools nor was any disability imposed on them as regards seating arrangements. The experiment of amalgamating depressed class schools with the ordinary schools of the Board is working well in the Poona District. The double shift system introduced in a few schools in the East Khandesh District is reported to have been well received and the number of pupils in these schools is said to be fast increasing.

Due attention continued to be paid to the Agricultural Bias classes in the Ahmednagar and Nasik Districts. The boarding houses for Backward classes attached to the central schools in the Ahmednagar District continued to work well.

The Boy Scout movement continued to make headway in the Satara District. Good progress in scouting was also made in East Khandesh and Sholapur.

*Southern Division.*—Although there was an increase in the number of schools and pupils in some Districts, primary education showed no marked progress in the Division as a whole. In the Belgaum District the number of schools for the scheduled classes decreased by one; but there was an increase in the number of pupils from those classes attending the ordinary schools, clearly indicating that the deep-rooted social disabilities of these classes are gradually disappearing in that District. In the Bijapur District want of provision for an adequate number of school buildings was responsible for the non-expansion of primary education. It is hoped that the District Local Board will take up this question seriously as early as possible. The number of aided schools as well as pupils showed a fall in the Dharwar District and is attributed to the fact that admission to infant classes which was hitherto open throughout the year is now confined to a certain period. There was also a fall in the number of girls in primary schools in that District which is attributed to the abolition of the posts of call-women as a measure of retrenchment. The Ratnagiri District Local Board started two agricultural classes at Rajapur and Shirgaon and two weaving classes at Kankavli and Ratnagiri.

✓10. *Medical and Public Health—Sind.*—Only one new dispensary was opened in Sind, viz. at Nasirabad in Larkana District in pursuance of the Board's programme of providing a dispensary at every 10 miles in the densely populated area of the District. Two maternity homes, one at Guerelo in Dokri Taluka and the other at Khairpur Juso in Kambar Taluka were also opened by the same Board. The District Local Board, Sukkur, subsidized 2 more private practitioners; while the District Local Board, Hyderabad, spent Rs. 4,000 in subsidizing private practitioners with the object of providing medical aid in the remoter parts of the District. The District Local Board, Thar Parkar, has adopted a scheme of appointing 7 lady doctors—one in each of the 7 talukas in the Mirpurkhas and Nara Valley sub-divisions—to render medical aid to women and children in the outlying parts of the District. The District Local Board, Dadu, appointed a touring Medical Officer for a period of 4 months on anti-malarial duty. The Board also maintains a nurse and her services have been found useful in maternity cases.

Government endorse the Commissioner's action in drawing the attention of the district local boards in Sind to the vital necessity of providing for an expansion of medical relief in the form of new dispensaries to combat the increase of malaria. The working of the Lloyd Barrage has yielded to the boards a very substantial increase of income from local cess, thus making it possible for them to spend a greater portion of their income on medical relief.

*Northern Division.*—In addition to the grant-in-aid dispensaries maintained by the district local boards, the Ayurvedic dispensaries conducted by them in the Ahmedabad, Kaira and Thana Districts are reported to have worked satisfactorily. There were some cases of Cerebro-Spinal fever in the Ahmedabad City and suburbs and the Board made arrangements to give the necessary medical help. The Kaira District Local Board spent an amount of Rs. 2,486 on plague operations through a Medical Officer specially appointed by it and the Medical Officer in charge of the Virsad Dispensary. When cholera broke out in Kalol and Godhra Talukas in the Panch Mahals, the Board appointed a Medical Officer at Kalol, while the Government Medical Officer on malaria duty worked at Godhra. The Surat District was almost free from epidemics. The Board took prompt measures to check cholera as soon as it appeared. The Thana District Local Board opened anti-malarial dispensaries as an experimental measure at one or two centres in each taluka.

✓*Central Division.*—During the year under report a cholera epidemic broke out in all the Districts in the Division including the Bombay Suburban District.

Plague cases also occurred in Ahmednagar, Satara and Sholapur Districts.

There was small-pox in Sholapur, Nasik, Satara, Poona and West Khandesh Districts and one case of meningitis in Ahmednagar District. Prompt measures

were taken in all the Districts to combat these diseases which, with the exception of cholera, were soon brought under control.

During the year under report one allopathic dispensary was taken under the full control of the Board in the Poona District, 2 new allopathic dispensaries were opened in Satara District, 2 Ayurvedic dispensaries were opened in East Khandesh and 2 Ayurvedic dispensaries re-opened in Ahmednagar District.

In Sholapur the District Local Board has in furtherance of its scheme to provide medical relief to the rural areas opened 13 small dispensaries in addition to the existing 7 and placed them in charge of private medical practitioners who receive honoraria for their services. Government showed their appreciation of the Board's efforts by making a non-recurring grant of Rs. 5,000 towards the scheme. The Satara District Local Board also deserves credit for the services rendered by it to the rural public through its Ayurvedic dispensaries and medical relief centres.

*Southern Division.*—Plague appeared in almost all the talukas of the Dharwar District and in certain areas of Belgaum, Bijapur, Kanara and Ratnagiri. Cholera prevailed in a few villages of Belgaum District and in the Alikag Taluka of the Kolaba District. Small-pox affected most of the talukas in Kanara District. All the boards, however, took prompt and adequate measures to prevent the spread of these diseases, additional establishment being employed wherever necessary. The Belgaum and Dharwar boards also encouraged private practitioners to undertake plague inoculations by payment of honoraria but the total number of persons inoculated in these two Districts showed a marked fall which is ascribed to the fact that the epidemic was not so severe or widespread as in the previous year. The Belgaum board also tried other preventive measures such as Cyanogas fumigation, baiting with barium carbonate, etc. Malaria in a severe form appeared in parts of Sampgaon and Gokak Talukas in the Belgaum District but it was promptly checked by the appointment of a special medical officer on anti-malarial duty. The Dharwar District Local Board has extended medical facilities to interior villages through teachers trained in the treatment of malaria, first aid, etc., and the scheme is reported to be growing in popularity. The Kanara District Local Board has stopped the levy of hospital fees from out-door patients in dispensaries in commemoration of His late Majesty's Silver Jubilee.

11. *Veterinary Dispensaries—Sind.*—The number of veterinary dispensaries in Sind remained unchanged.

*Northern Division.*—There were 60 outbreaks of epizootic diseases in the Surat District involving 672 cases and 299 deaths. The District Local Board, however, took the necessary measures to check the diseases. Two travelling veterinary dispensaries were started in the Viramgam Taluka and Sanand Mahal of the Ahmedabad District.

*Central Division.*—The number of regular veterinary dispensaries in the Division remained the same as in the previous year but the District Local Board, Ahmednagar, gave an annual contribution of Rs. 300 to the private veterinary dispensary opened at Belapur Road.

*Southern Division.*—The Kanara District Local Board stopped the levy of hospital fees from out-door patients in veterinary dispensaries in commemoration of His late Majesty's Silver Jubilee.

12. *Civil Works.*—The following table shows the Government grants paid to the boards and the amounts actually spent by them from these grants and their own funds on local public works :—

*Sind.*—The District Local Boards of Hyderabad, Sukkur and Nawabshah had unspent balances from Government grants. In the case of the first two boards no reasons have been assigned for the saving but in the case of the Nawabshah board the balance was due to (a) the reservation of money for constructing roads leading to the railway station pending acquisition of the required land and (b) the late allotment of the grant.

*Northern Division.*—The District Local Board, Kaira, increased its mileage of metalled roads by 3 while the District Local Board, Broach, increased its total mileage by 12. The Sir Fredrick Sykes road from Varad to Panda in the Surat District for which Government had allotted a special grant of Rs. 5,000 in 1933-34 was completed and the additional cost of Rs. 2,372 was met by the Bardoli Taluka Local Board. Two new cattle pounds were constructed by the District Local Board, Panch Mahals.

*Central Division.*—The Nasik District Local Board failed to utilize the full one-third of the net proceeds of the irrigation cess on the improvement of communications in irrigated areas.

In Sholapur District the construction of portions of three important roads was completed during the year.

*Southern Division.*—The expenditure of the Belgaum District Local Board on original works decreased by about Rs. 14,000 on account of financial stringency. The Bijapur board could not spend a larger amount on communications as its income from tolls declined to the extent of Rs. 22,000 on account of reduction in the toll rates. The Dbarwar board fully utilised the balance of the previous years' grants amounting to Rs. 21,790. The Kanara board could not take up any extensive communication works for want of adequate funds.

13. *Village Water Supply.*—The following table shows the Government grants to the district local boards and the amounts spent by them from these grants and their own funds for the improvement of village water supply :—

*Sind.*—The Karachi, Hyderabad and Larkana District Local Boards had large unspent balances from Government grants. Although the District Local Board, Hyderabad, constructed 18 new wells during the year under report the demand for more new wells in that District is still on the increase.

*Northern, Central and Southern Divisions.*—Large unspent balances were allowed to accumulate by the majority of the boards in all the three Divisions showing that the boards do not arrange their programmes of works in a systematic manner.

14. *Standing Committees—Sind.*—All the local boards have appointed standing committees as required by section 36 (1) of the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923.

*Northern, Central and Southern Divisions.*—The District Local Board, Panch Mahals, and a few taluka local boards still failed to appoint standing committees as required by section 36 (1) of the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923.

15. *Village Panchayats and Village Sanitary Committees—Sind.*—In Sind there were no village panchayats. The number of sanitary committees decreased from 219 to 218.

*Northern Division.*—The number of village panchayats during the year under report fell from 55 to 53 while the number of sanitary committees remained the same, viz., 43. The work of all the sanitary committees was, however, of the stereotyped character.

Government made a grant of Rs. 2,900 for fostering the growth of village panchayats and this is reported to have acted as an impetus in establishing 30 new village panchayats since the close of the year.

*Central Division.*—The total number of village panchayats in the Division increased from 144 to 183. Two village benches have also been established in East Khandesh. The Government grant for fostering the growth of panchayats in this Division amounted to Rs. 5,700.

The Mundhwa Village Panchayat in the Poona District was dissolved by Government owing to serious irregularities in accounts.

The number of sanitary committees which function only in the Nasik, Poona, Satara and Bombay Suburban Districts remained the same, viz., 26.

*Southern Division.*—There was no increase in the number (61) of panchayats during the year. It is, however, gratifying to note that the village uplift movement is awakening interest among the people and as a result applications for the constitution of panchayats are now being received from almost all districts. Government made a grant of Rs. 2,000 for fostering the growth of panchayats in this Division. The Belgaum Board started a class in June last for training secretaries of village panchayats in their duties. The administration of some of the panchayats in Belgaum and most of the panchayats in Dharwar is reported to be still unsatisfactory.

Nine more sanitary committees were established in Bijapur District and one in Kanara raising the total for the Division from 53 to 63.

16. *Audit of Accounts—Sind.*—No serious irregularities came to notice during the year. Excess payments in a few cases have been recovered and a few of the minor irregularities pointed out by the Auditors have been or are being set right. A sub-overseer of a taluka local board was dismissed for crediting an amount of Rs. 58 sixteen days after its receipt.

*Northern Division.*—The audit notes again revealed the usual irregularities reported in the preceding year. Some of the serious irregularities are under investigation and they indicate that the executives of the local boards are not yet alive to their responsibilities and do not exercise adequate control over the staff.

*Central Division.*—The audit reports show a general improvement in administration and in the system of maintaining accounts. Among the common irregularities and defects pointed out were:—

(i) Non-production of completion certificates at the time of audit.

(ii) Failure to obtain the previous sanction of the Collector for expenditure as required by section 50 (o) of the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923 and of the Commissioner for journeys performed by members outside the jurisdiction of the board as required by section 77 of the Act and the rules framed under section 133 (d).

(iii) Non-enforcement of the penalty clause in contract bonds for non-completion of works by contractors within the stipulated time.

*Southern Division.*—The accounts of all the boards were audited during the year. No irregularities requiring special mention were noticed in the case of any board but it is reported that the boards generally were not prompt in the disposal of audit objections.

17. *General Remarks—Sind.*—As usual, the administration of the district local boards was more satisfactory than that of the taluka local boards. There is, however, still much scope for the extension of the activities of boards in the direction of roads improvement, better water supply and greater attention to problems of public health, rural medical relief and village uplift. The local boards in Sind cannot complain of financial stringency to the same extent as the boards in the Presidency proper since the income of most of them has increased in the shape of local cess due to extensive cultivation on the Barrage canals. The accumulation

of unspent balances from Government grants on account of village water supply shows that the boards do not exercise the necessary foresight in utilising their resources to the best advantage. Government hope that more attention will be paid by the boards to the appointment of Health Officers. At present, Larkana is the only district local board in Sind which employs such an officer.

*Northern, Central and Southern Divisions.*—The administration of the local boards was on the whole satisfactory. As in the case of Sind, the majority of the boards in the Presidency proper have on hand large balances out of the village water supply grants which could not be utilised during the year. As this indicates faulty budgetting and weakens the case of the district local boards for increased grants from Government it is hoped that the boards concerned will so arrange their programmes in future as to ensure full utilisation of the grants during the year.

The majority of the district local boards in the Presidency proper showed a keen interest in the village uplift scheme and their attitude in this respect has stimulated the growth of village panchayats and other activities for the improvement of conditions in the villages. In this connection the progress achieved by the District Local Board, Sholapur, especially in the matter of rural medical relief, is worthy of emulation by other district local boards in the Presidency.

The District Local Boards of Dharwar and Satara are the only two boards in the Presidency proper that have so far appointed Health Officers and Government hope that other district local boards whose financial position is sound will follow their example in the interests of public health in their areas.

Portions of the Dharwar and Belgaum Districts suffered from scarcity conditions during the year and it is to the credit of these boards that they readily started relief works and co-operated with Government to the fullest extent of their financial abilities in affording relief to the villagers in the affected areas.

With a few exceptions in the Northern Division, measures for the amelioration of the social disabilities of the scheduled classes are proving more and more successful as the result of the active co-operation of district local boards in implementing the orders of Government with regard to schools, dharamsalas, public wells, etc. In the Belgaum District nearly 50 per cent. of pupils from the scheduled classes attended ordinary schools.

18. Government note with satisfaction the remarks of the Commissioners and Collectors regarding the excellent work done by several Presidents, Vice-Presidents and Officers of district local boards.
