

**REPORT ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF DISTRICT LOCAL
BOARDS IN THE NORTHERN DIVISION
FOR THE YEAR 1939-40.**

Read—Letters from the Collectors in the Northern Division forwarding with their remarks Reports of the District Local Boards during the year 1939-40.

1. Number of Local Boards.

There was no change in the number of District Local Boards in the Division during the year under report.

2. Area and Population.

The area and population of the District Local Boards remained unchanged, viz. 13,719, square miles and 3,349,961 persons respectively.

3. Constitution.

There was no change in the constitution of the District Local Boards.

4. Elections.

There were no general elections during the year but there were bye-elections in all the District Local Boards except Thana for filling up the vacancies caused by the resignations by, or disqualifications of, members. In the Surat District however the vacancy occurred at the close of the year and the election was therefore held in May 1940.

5. Meetings.

The total number of meetings held by the Boards was 49 as against 63 in the previous year. The average percentage of attendance was 79.49 as against 83.71.

The number of meetings held by the Boards was not less than the number prescribed in section 35 (1) of the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923. The Kaira, Panch Mahals and Thana District Local Boards transacted urgent business by circulation of papers as required by section 41 of the Local Boards Act.

No meeting proved abortive for want of quorum.

In all 3 meetings were adjourned, 2 in Ahmedabad District and one in Kaira District, as the work on the agenda could not be finished on the same day. There was thus no case of adjournment, as referred to in Government Resolution, General Department, No. 1689/33 of May 7th, 1937.

6. Income.

The aggregate income of Local Boards in the Division (excluding opening balance and debt) decreased from Rs. 53,57,888 to Rs. 51,13,019. The principal variations under the main sources of revenue are explained below:—

(a) *Land Revenue*.—The receipts decreased from Rs. 68,785 to Rs. 47,185, i.e. by Rs. 21,600. The decrease was contributed to by all the District Local Boards except Panch Mahals and Broach. The main

reason for the decrease is said to be the amendment of section 75 of the Local Boards Act according to which the fees from quarries, sand kankar, which before formed part of the income of the Boards, are now credited in the first instance to the Provincial Revenue and Government afterwards pay a grant-in-aid on the actuals of the past three years.

(b) *Local Rates*.—The receipts decreased from Rs. 9,81,539 to Rs. 8,45,095. Decreases of Rs. 1,33,434 were recorded by Ahmedabad, Panch Mahals, Broach, Surat and Thana Districts. As against this decrease there was an increase of Rs. 46,365 in Kaira and Bombay Suburban District. The main causes for the decrease are that (1) in Ahmedabad on account of shortage of rainfall and consequent scarcity, the full amount of local fund cess could not be recovered, (2) There were no arrears of past years recovered in the year under report in Broach and (3) in Surat, the full local fund cess was not recovered owing to the late season. The increase is due to the recovery of arrears and greater collections of local fund cess during the year.

(c) *Police*.—There was an increase of Rs. 6,333 under this head. This was due to more receipts under the Cattle Trespass Act in Kaira, Panch Mahals, Surat and Thana. In Ahmedabad, there was a slight decrease owing to failure of crops.

(d) *Education*.—Receipts rose from Rs. 29,59,908 to Rs. 30,79,016, i.e. by Rs. 1,19,108. The increase was in evidence in Panch Mahals, Broach, Surat and Thana, and was due to larger Government grants for Primary Education. In Ahmedabad, Kaira and Bombay Suburban District there was a decrease. The decrease in Ahmedabad and Kaira was due to the adjustment during the year of excess grants received in the past year while in the case of the Bombay Suburban District the District Local Board paid less in advances to the School Board with the result that the income under this head was less.

(e) *Medical*.—Receipts under this head fell from Rs. 1,14,572 to Rs. 93,715, i.e. a decrease of Rs. 20,857 which is contributed to by all the districts in the Northern Division, except Surat and Thana. The main causes for the decrease are that less was received from hospital fees and from contributions from the public. In Broach alone there was a decrease of Rs. 12,880 and this is said to be due to the fact that the District Local Board grant, which was shown during the past year, being a mere book adjustment, has not been shown during the year under report. The Surat District, on the other hand, showed an increase of Rs. 3,053 which was due to higher receipts from hospital fees.

(f) *Miscellaneous*.—The receipts under this head fell by Rs. 1,95,422. The decrease is mainly in Ahmedabad where it was Rs. 2,01,825, and in the Bombay Suburban District. This is counterbalanced by an increase of receipts in Panch Mahals, Broach, Surat and Thana. The fall in receipts in Ahmedabad is due to less receipts under "Sale Proceeds of Investments" as a result of less securities and deposits held by the Board owing to the greater amount spent by the Board on Civil Works. In the Bombay Suburban District the decrease is due to no Postal Cash certificates being sold, as was done last year. The increase in receipts in Panch Mahals, Broach, Surat and Thana is due to sale of investments in Panch Mahals, adjustments from the savings of the income from the Road-Grading machinery on account of scarcity works and cash recovery in Broach, cash recovery in Surat and transfer of Rs. 4,592 from the Suspense Account to the Revenue head in Thana.

(g) *Civil Works*.—In the Divisional figures there is only an increase of Rs. 2,958 over the last year's figures but from the income of the individual boards it is noticed that there is a decrease of Rs. 78,081 and Rs. 12,227, respectively in Ahmedabad and Thana. This is counterbalanced by an increase in receipts in the remaining boards. The decrease in Ahmedabad and Thana is due to less expenditure from Government grants for village water supply and approach roads. In

Ahmedabad it is especially due to the Government order that no new works of water supply should be begun as a survey of the whole scheme was under the consideration of Government. The decrease in Thana is due to less grant for the pay of the Board's Engineer and less public contribution. The increase in the other districts is mainly due to larger Government grants for water supply and roads. The increase in the Bombay Suburban District is due to a greater demand for the Board's Boring Machines on hire and the larger income derived from the Gorai-Manori Ferry.

7. Expenditure.

The aggregate expenditure of the Local Boards chargeable to current income increased from Rs. 48,93,985 to Rs. 49,58,640. The increase or decrease under the main heads is explained below :—

(a) *Education*.—Expenditure increased from Rs. 30,94,798 to Rs. 31,31,704. Though the net increase in the Divisional figures is only Rs. 36,906, there were increases of Rs. 1,15,910 which was mainly in Panch Mahals, Surat and Thana. There was a decrease of Rs. 89,003 in Kaira and Bombay Suburban District. The increase of Rs. 62,793 in Surat was due to greater sums spent on primary and secondary schools and on Primary Schools of Municipalities which are not local authorities for the whole year as compared with the expenditure for 9 months during the preceding year. Panch Mahals shows an increase of Rs. 23,833 as the Primary Schools of Non-Local Authority Municipalities were handed over to the Board. In Thana on the other hand, the increase of Rs. 26,311 is attributed to larger payments being made to School Boards in consequence of more Government grants. The causes of decrease are that in Kaira the pension contribution to be paid on attendance allowance was discontinued, and in Bombay Suburban District during 1938-39 the Provident Fund balance of the School Board employees was transferred from the School Board account to a separate account.

(b) *Medical*.—Expenditure decreased from Rs. 3,12,703 to Rs. 3,02,650 and the decrease is mainly in Broach and Thana. The decrease in Broach is attributed to the fact that the amount required for the maintenance of the Board's dispensaries has not been shown under this head this year being a mere book-adjustment while this was done in the previous year. The decrease in Thana is due to the absence of any epidemic and reduction in the contribution by the Local Board to the Civil Hospital and its maternity ward.

(c) *Civil Works*.—Expenditure rose from Rs. 12,05,204 to Rs. 12,25,646 and this increase was mainly due to the scarcity conditions in the Panch Mahals, to the construction of the Boarding School at Godsamba by the Surat Board and to more amount spent on water supply works in Kaira; Ahmedabad and Thana, however, showed a decrease which was mainly due to the ban imposed by Government in October 1939 on the opening of new water supply works. The chief cause of the decrease in Thana was that during the previous year the Board had spent large sums on the purchase of a Road Roller and on the construction of maternity wards and these did not recur.

(d) *Famine*.—The District Local Board, Ahmedabad, incurred a sum of Rs. 7,743 on scarcity works in order to provide labour for the poor as there was scarcity of rain.

8. Closing Balances.

The aggregate closing balances of the Boards amounted to Rs. 27,93,276 as against Rs. 26,92,245 in the preceding year. The increase was shared by the Boards of Kaira, Panch Mahals, Broach and Surat. The closing balances of Ahmedabad, Thana and Bombay Suburban District, showed a decrease.

The closing balances are in excess of the prescribed minimum. This is chiefly due to the accumulation of balances of the School Boards.

9. Primary Education.

In accordance with the provisions of the Primary Education Act, Government took over the work of supervision by transferring the posts of Administrative Officers and Supervisors to the Educational Department. Smaller units of educational administration were abolished by vesting the control of schools of the Non-Local Authority Municipalities in the Local Board.

The number of schools increased by 269, all districts except Kaira sharing in this.

Incomplete school buildings at Sokhda (Taluka Matar), Vansoli (Taluka Mehmedabad) and Kunjarao (Taluka Anand) were completed in Kaira. Construction of new school buildings in Kaira District at Moraj, Pansora, Ratanpur and Lambhwel was begun.

In Panch Mahals 3 new school buildings were constructed, while in Broach a programme for erecting school buildings has been worked out.

In Surat 8 new buildings were constructed under the Sir Purushottamdas Thakordas Scheme, and 7 built by the village people were handed over to the Board. The Surat Board maintains 491 schools of which 310 are housed in the Board's own buildings. The construction of some buildings under the Sir P. T. Scheme is in progress.

In the Bombay Suburban District two new school buildings were constructed, one at Chembur and the other at Exsar. Government paid Rs. 35,000 towards the Cheap School Building Fund of the Bombay Suburban District.

There are two Agricultural Bias Classes in Kaira at Uttersanda and at Ras, and in Panch Mahals in the two central schools at Muvalia and Ambli.

The Shift System has been introduced into some schools in Panch Mahals. Owing to insufficient staff for Primary Education in Broach district the Board has also introduced the shift system there. This system is also found in some schools in Thana.

It is encouraging to see that Boards especially Broach and Thana take interest in physical training. The District Local Board, Broach, spent Rs. 2,443 for the purchase of apparatus for this purpose and has also decided to employ an Instructor. A Scout Training Camp was held by the Broach Board at Shukaltirth. From Thana also similar activities are reported.

The existing schools at Thamna, Navagam and Bodal in Kaira were converted into Basic Schools under the Wardha Scheme. Two such schools in Panch Mahals and two in Broach were also opened.

The two Central Schools at Muvalia (Taluka Dohad) and Ambli (Taluka Godhra) were continued. Free lodging and boarding are provided for the students. The school at Muvalia is meant for the Bhil and Naikda boys while the school at Ambli is for Dharalas only.

The Broach Board took vigorous action in order to give admission to Harijan boys in the Board's schools without any distinction. As a result of the objections raised by the public four schools had to be closed; two out of these four were subsequently re-opened as the village people agreed to the admission of Harijan boys into the school. The result is that in no school of the Broach Board is a distinction between Harijans and Caste Hindus observed.

In addition to the maintenance of primary schools some Boards took interest in providing libraries and reading rooms. The Ahmedabad Board started 100 Reading Rooms in villages which contributed Rs. 10 each as their quota; the School Board is now managing these Reading Rooms. The District Local Board, Broach, started 79 Reading Rooms. Surat has now 390 Sir Purushottamdas Thakordas libraries.

In order to spread Primary Education the Surat Board raised its local fund cess by 3 pies per rupee of Land Revenue. The Broach Board took a census of all school-going children and has submitted proposals for the introduction of compulsory primary education. Government sanction to the proposal is awaited.

10. Medical and Public Health.

The Ahmedabad Board continued the special malaria campaign as in the last year by distributing cheap Ayurvedic pills through the agency of its teachers and other staff.

There were stray cases of Cerebro-Spinal Meningitis in the suburbs of Ahmedabad City. The Medical Officer in charge of the Lord Harris Travelling Dispensary gave necessary medical help.

The Local Board, Kaira, took successful preventive measures against plague in Borsad Taluka as was done during last year. There were cases of small-pox but it was prevented from spreading by mass vaccination carried out by an extra staff specially engaged for the purpose.

Free treatment of eye-cases in the dispensaries at Alindra, Matar, Mahudha, Thasra and Ode was continued. The Thana Board closed the Ayurvedic Dispensary at Somta, and opened anti-malaria dispensaries at Manor, Gargaon and Sonala (Peta Vada). Cholera broke out in certain villages in Thana district. The Board spent Rs. 650 on preventing and checking the epidemic.

All the Boards are taking advantage of the Rural Medical Relief Scheme sanctioned in Government Resolution, General Department, No. 1433/33 (a), dated 21st April 1938. There are about 102 Centres for subsidised Medical Practitioners sanctioned by Government and these are in addition to the Board's dispensaries.

The Boards in the Division have begun to take advantage of the Government scheme for appointment of Nurses and Midwives in rural areas by appointing Nurses and Midwives in their dispensaries.

11. Veterinary Dispensaries.

The number of Veterinary Dispensaries in charge of the Boards remained the same, viz., 28. As there is no veterinary dispensary in Madvi Taluka and Pardi Mahal the Surat Board has opened two visiting centres, one at Rankuwa and the other at Paria.

There were no epidemics of cattle disease in the Division except in Surat where 43 outbreaks of epizootic diseases were reported with 449 cases and 201 deaths. Necessary preventive measures were taken by the Board.

12. Civil Works.

The following table shows the Government grants to Local Boards and the amounts spent by them from the grants and their own funds on local public works and Village Approach Roads.

The unspent balance of the grant for Village Approach Roads is to be refunded to Government.

13. Water Supply.

The following table shows the Government grants to Local Boards for improvement of village water supply and the amounts spent by them.

The very small expenditure from local funds is due to the grant being not conditional on the provision of a certain percentage from local funds. Besides in October 1939, Government issued orders for not taking up new works as Government had then in mind the making of a full survey of the needs of the people for potable water supply. This accounts for the large unspent balance. In consequence of Government orders referred to above, special Executive Engineers for the Gujarat, Konkan and Karnatak Zones were appointed for investigating all schemes. These officers have investigated the schemes which will be arranged in order of urgency and then these works will be financed from the Government grants.

14. Standing Committees.

All the Boards appointed Standing Committees. The Ahmedabad Board appointed 4 Sub-Divisional Works Committees for inspection of the Board's works already in progress and suggestion of works for inclusion in the budget. In Kaira, Broach and Bombay Suburban a Dispensary Committee for each Civil as well as Veterinary Dispensary was appointed. Works Committees were appointed in Panch Mahals, Thana and Bombay Suburban District. The Broach Board also appointed a Provident Fund Committee and a Joint Committee for the management of the Public Ferries at Furja and Undai-Village Panchayat Committees were formed in Broach, Thana and Bombay Suburban District. The Thana Board also appointed a Budget Committee.

15. Village Panchayats and Village Sanitary Committees.

The number of village panchayats remained unchanged at 121. Triennial elections were due to be held during the year but were postponed on account of the Village Panchayat Bill (now Act XVIII of 1939), then pending before the Legislatures. The chief feature of the Amendment Act XVIII of 1939 are that (1) the establishment of Village Panchayats in villages with a population of 2,000 or over is made compulsory, (2) levy of house tax by these Village Panchayats is obligatory, (3) Nomination on the Village Panchayats has been abolished i.e., all seats are made elective, (4) Representation of women is specially provided for on each Panchayat, and (5) Seats are reserved for Muslims, Harijans and Backward Tribes having regard to the population of such community, caste or tribe. In view of this provision it has been ordered that the reservation should be made on a population basis with the limitation that the number of unreserved seats shall not go below half the total number of elected seats. The terms of office of the Village Panchayats had to be extended to the maximum limit as on the day the Village Panchayat Amendment Act came into force their constitutions had not been determined. It became also necessary to enact the Village Panchayat Amendment Act (Act IV of 1940) to validate the continuance of such of the Village Panchayats as had their terms expired inspite of the maximum extensions permissible under the Act granted to them.

In accordance with these orders there will be 204 new Village Panchayats in the Division.

It remains to be seen how the obligatory provisions of the Act are to be enforced where the people refuse to have a Panchayat.

No new Village Panchayats were established during the year under report for the reasons stated above.

The Village Benches at Sinhuji and Traj in Kaira worked satisfactorily. In Broach there are 4 Village Benches which disposed of 15 civil suits and 22 criminal cases as against 26 civil suits and 28 criminal cases in the preceding year.

In view of the provisions of the Village Panchayat (Amendment) Act, 1939 (Act XVIII of 1939) that village panchayats are to be established in villages with a population of 2,000 or over, Village Sanitary Committees and Boards established under the Bombay Village Sanitation Act, 1889, will be abolished and village panchayats established in their place in villages where the population is 2,000 or over, Government have already issued orders that such sanitary committees should be abolished. As a result of these orders there will remain only five sanitary committees in the Division.

The existing village panchayats do not all levy taxes as taxation was not compulsory before the passing of the Village Panchayats Act XVIII of 1939. Under the new Act the levy of a House Tax is obligatory. It is hoped that the finances of village panchayats will be improved under the new Act (Act XVIII of 1939) and that they will be able to function properly.

16. Audit of Accounts.

The audit notes of the District Local Boards revealed the usual irregularities, viz., (1) Irregular payments of travelling allowance, (2) absence of and deviations from the sanctioned programme of works, (3) slackness of supervision over the execution of works, (4) keeping back receipts of collection of pound fees, and (5) payment of money without obtaining receipts from payees.

The financial position of the Boards in Panch Mahals and Thana, as is seen from the audit notes for 1938-39, has not been improved. The Broach Board is found unable to meet its expenditure from its normal income. The following are some of the main irregularities brought to notice.

As the appointment of the Engineer, District Local Board, Panch Mahals, had not been approved works estimated to cost over Rs. 30,000 had to be executed by the Public Works Department merely to avoid this, an estimate for Rs. 29,664 being just less than Rs. 30,000 was prepared for the Jhalod-Banswara Road and it was approved by the Superintending Engineer, Northern Circle. Subsequently estimates for six culverts on the same road were approved by the Board piecemeal. It is stated that out of these 6 culverts constructed in March three collapsed due to heavy and early rains. A committee has been appointed to investigate and its report is awaited.

The Local Board, Broach, set up a paper-making industry in order to teach the art of manufacturing paper. A grant from the Village Improvement Scheme was obtained. An expert was called from Wardha. A boarding house was opened and the Board spent Rs. 100 on utensils for the boarders. But the enterprise proved a failure and the factory had to be closed down under Government orders, there being insufficient raw material and no chance of the industry being self-supporting. The result is that the ratepayer's money amounting to Rs. 1,309 spent for the purpose has been wasted.

There was a case of misappropriation of Rs. 148-5-0 by a Mustering Karkun of the Panch Mahals Board, and a case of falsification of records by the Overseer and Mustering Karkun of the Broach Board. The Panch Mahals Board dismissed the Mustering Karkun while the Broach Board allowed both the Overseer and the Mustering Karkun to resign.

17. General Remarks.

The administration of the Boards was on the whole satisfactory, except in the case of Broach where the post of the Chief Officer was abolished without proper sanction and the Board persistently tried to do away with the post. In view of the increasing responsibility on the District Local Boards including the working of the Village Panchayats Act Government did not approve of the Board's action and the post of the Chief Officer has been continued. It would be better if the Ahmedabad Board appointed a Chief Officer.

The relations between the Boards and Government officials were on the whole cordial.

**REPORT ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF DISTRICT LOCAL
BOARDS IN THE CENTRAL DIVISION
FOR THE YEAR 1939-40.**

1. Number of Local Boards.

There was no change in the number of District Local Boards, i.e., 7 only.

2. Area and Population.

The area and population of the District Local Boards remained the same viz. 37,167 square miles and 6,059,798 persons respectively.

3. Constitution of the Boards.

The constitution of the Boards remained unchanged.

4. Elections.

No general elections were held during the year.

5. Meetings.

The total number of meetings held by the District Local Boards was 54 as against 63. The average percentage of attendance of the members at the meetings was 87.21 as against 83.27 in the preceding year.

Only one meeting of the Satara District Local Board proved abortive for want of quorum. The number of meetings adjourned for other reasons was 9 as against 16 during the previous year.

All the Boards held the requisite number of meetings prescribed by section 35 (1) of the Act.

There were no flagrant cases of adjournments of meetings as referred to in Government Resolution, General Department, No. 1689/33 dated May 7th, 1937.

6. Income.

The aggregate income of the District Local Boards (excluding the opening balances and debts) increased from Rs. 72,64,565 to Rs. 76,63,122. The important variations are explained below :—

(a) *Local Rates.*—The receipts increased from Rs. 17,99,808 to Rs. 19,20,304. The increase was contributed mainly by Ahmednagar, East Khandesh and West Khandesh districts, the figures of increase for the respective districts being Rs. 1,11,085, Rs. 88,621 and Rs. 17,765. This was partly absorbed by an aggregate decrease of Rs. 96,975 in Nasik, Poona, Satara and Sholapur districts. The heavy increase in Ahmednagar and East Khandesh was due to the collection of the major portion of the arrears of the local fund cess for the year 1938-39. In West Khandesh it was due to the realisation of the cess in full. The decrease in Nasik was due to a reduced realisation from the cess, and in Poona and Sholapur it was due to the suspension of the land revenue. The decrease in Satara was only nominal.

(b) *Interest*.—The income under this source decreased from Rs. 42,699 to Rs. 30,323. The decrease of Rs. 14,931 was shared by Ahmednagar, Poona, Satara and Sholapur. This was partly covered by an increase of Rs. 2,555 in East Khandesh and Nasik districts. The decrease of Rs. 10,953 in Ahmednagar was due to the fact that Government securities of the face value of Rs. 1,26,000 had to be encashed by sale at the market rate to meet the demand of the District School Board, for construction of and special repairs to the School buildings. The decrease and increase in other districts being nominal call for no remarks.

(c) *Education*.—The increase of Rs. 1,07,559 is accounted for as under :—

The increase was mainly due to the receipt of large Government grants for Primary Education and the receipt of share from Non-local authority municipalities. The decrease in Ahmednagar and West Khandesh was due to a reduction in the Government grant and local fund cess on education.

(d) *Miscellaneous*.—The increase of Rs. 90,393 was contributed by all districts except Nasik and Poona. The heavy increase in East Khandesh was due to the withdrawal of Rs. 1,05,000 from the fixed deposits in the Co-operative Credit Bank and income from the cut enforced on the pay of the Board's establishment.

(e) *Civil Works*.—Receipts increased from Rs. 6,99,854 to Rs. 7,91,459. For the increase of Rs. 1,91,982 Ahmednagar, East Khandesh, West Khandesh, Nasik and Satara were responsible. It was partly counterbalanced by the decrease of Rs. 1,00,377 in Poona and Sholapur districts.

7. Expenditure.

The aggregate expenditure of the Local Boards increased from Rs. 74,74,942 to Rs. 78,72,724. The increase or decrease under the main heads of expenditure is explained below :—

(a) *Administration*.—There was a decrease from Rs. 2,08,004 to Rs. 1,94,179. It occurred in Ahmednagar (2,319), East Khandesh (595), West Khandesh (6,881), Nasik (1,484) and Sholapur (6,141). Poona recorded an increase of Rs. 2,628 and Satara of Rs. 967. The decrease in Ahmednagar was due to reduced expenditure on travelling allowance. In West Khandesh it was due to the transfer of some clerical and menial establishment of the abolished Taluka Local Boards to Civil Works Department, the expenditure of which was debited to the head "Civil Works". In Nasik it was due to 10 per cent. cut in the establishment and in Sholapur to the combination of the posts of the Chief Officer and the Engineer. The increase in Poona was due to more expenditure on contingency and travelling allowance.

(b) *Police*.—The increase of Rs. 7,459 was shared by all the districts except Sholapur and the increase in each of them was proportionately small.

(c) *Education*.—The expenditure showed an increase from Rs. 52,42,366 to Rs. 53,39,529. This was contributed by all the District Local Boards except East Khandesh and Satara. It was mainly due to the expansion of Primary Education. In Poona the increase was due to

the payment of personal and duty pay to the teachers during the period of training and also due to the grants given to private schools started on voluntary basis.

(d) *Miscellaneous*.—The decrease of Rs. 26,532 was shared by all the districts except Poona. The decrease in West Khandesh, Nasik and Satara was comparatively small. In Ahmednagar it was due to the fact that as in the past year there were no cases of purchasing the lands of the Toll defaulters. In East Khandesh the decrease was due to the fact that last year the expenditure appeared to be increasing on account of the outstanding cheque of Rs. 15,000 for the transfer of balances from treasury to the Co-operative Credit Bank being not cashed on March 31st, 1937; this was not so during the year. In Sholapur it was attributed to the payment of small amount of grants to Village Panchayats on account of the suspension of the Land Revenue.

(e) *Civil Works*.—The expenditure rose from Rs. 13,53,442 to Rs. 16,41,882. Ahmednagar, East Khandesh, West Khandesh, Poona and Satara showed an increase of Rs. 47,296, Rs. 1,70,473, Rs. 11,371, Rs. 3,633 and Rs. 63,317 respectively while Nasik and Sholapur showed a decrease of Rs. 2,883 and Rs. 4,767 respectively. The districts which showed increases spent more on communications, buildings, water supply and establishment.

(f) *Famine Relief*.—There was increase of Rs. 12,035 and 21,496 respectively in Ahmednagar and East Khandesh districts due to the undertaking of scarcity works.

8. Closing Balances.

The aggregate closing balances of the boards amounted to Rs. 12,44,541 as against Rs. 16,06,099 in the preceding year. The following statement shows the closing balances of each District Local Board :—

The closing balances are considerably in excess of the statutory minimum in all districts.

9. Primary Education.

In Ahmednagar, East Khandesh, West Khandesh, Nasik, Poona and Sholapur districts the number of primary schools increased by 12, 5, 3, 39, 15 and 4 respectively while in Satara their number decreased by 4. The number of pupils increased and decreased in the several districts as shown below :—

The scheme formulated by Government for encouraging local authorities to construct school buildings was further liberalised by lowering the contribution of the Local Boards from equal to half. With this end in view Government appointed District Building Committees with the Educational Inspector as Chairman. 14 and 2 School buildings were constructed by Ahmednagar and West Khandesh District Local Boards respectively during the year.

A departure in education in the Ahmednagar and Sholapur districts was the starting of 2 basic schools at Dighol Peta Jamkhed and Miri in the Ahmednagar District and one at Pangri and one at Javali in the Sholapur District. Progress of these schools is being watched with interest.

Government approved of the proposal of the District Local Board, West Khandesh, for the formation of a Joint Committee to be appointed by the Dhulia Municipality and the District Local Board for the management of the King Edward Memorial Technical School, Dhulia, on the terms agreed upon by both the bodies. The working of this institution was on the whole satisfactory.

There was no trouble in any district regarding admission or seating of the depressed class children. The appointment of a Special Organiser in East Khandesh facilitated the increase in the number of pupils belonging to the Aboriginal Tribes and the Scheduled Classes.

All the Boards continue to take a practical interest in encouraging education among the intermediate and depressed classes by means of the grant of scholarships and other facilities.

The number of Agricultural Bias Classes remained the same as last year in all the districts, the number of pupils having slightly increased in all cases.

10. Medical and Public Health.

During the year cholera broke out in a mild form in the East Khandesh and West Khandesh districts. There were cases of small-pox in West Khandesh District and of plague in Satara and Sholapur districts. Prompt and sufficient measures were taken by the District Local Boards, East Khandesh and West Khandesh to combat the disease. In Sholapur however the Board failed to take immediate action against the spread of plague and the Director of Public Health had therefore to appoint special staff for the purpose. It took therefore six months for a vigorous anti-plague campaign to bring the epidemic under control.

In pursuance of the scheme outlined by Government to encourage private medical practitioners in villages for providing medical aid in rural areas, the District Local Boards opened subsidised medical centres as detailed below :—

The subsidised medical practitioners are affording medical relief free to the poor villagers at these centres.

11. Veterinary Dispensaries.

The number of the Veterinary Dispensaries maintained by the District Local Boards remained the same as that of the last year. The dispensaries were reported to have worked satisfactorily.

12. Civil Works.

The following statement shows the Government grants paid to the Boards during the year and the amounts spent from these grants and from the Boards' funds on local public works and village approach road works:—

It will be seen that the Boards did not utilise the amounts placed at their disposal by Government. In order to relieve scarcity conditions prevailing in the Sholapur district the District Local Board conducted 7 works on the lines of scarcity works.

13. Water Supply.

The following table shows the Government grants given during the year for the Village Water Supply and the amount spent by the Boards therefrom and from their own funds:—

Large amounts were sanctioned to the Boards from the grant for Special Village Water Supply but they could not take full advantage of the grants owing to the fact that the expenditure was restricted to works already in progress and a major portion of the grant was surrendered to Government to finance the scheme for Provincial Survey of village water supply works. It is to be hoped that this question of vital importance to the rural population will be systematically dealt with as a result of the survey undertaken last year.

14. Committees.

All the District Local Boards appointed Standing Committees. All the Boards except Ahmednagar had in addition Budget Committees. There were Civil Works Committees in Ahmednagar, Nasik, Poona, Satara and Sholapur, Dispensary Committees in Ahmednagar, East Khandesh and Satara. There were Veterinary Committees in Ahmednagar and East Khandesh. Village Panchayat Committees were appointed in Poona, West Khandesh and Satara and Sanitary Committees in Ahmednagar, Nasik, Poona and Satara.

15. Village Panchayats.

The number of the Village Panchayats remained the same as in last year except that in Poona two more Panchayats were established and 7 Village Panchayats ceased to function in the Sholapur district. In the Poona district 52 Village Panchayats are working and the remaining 26 Village Panchayats which have temporarily ceased to work will begin to function under the provisions of the new Act.

As observed in last year's report no material progress was made in the improvement of the financial position of the majority of the Panchayats. The main reason was the unwillingness of the panchayats to recover direct taxes, e.g. House tax by coercive measures with the result that they were in heavy arrears. With the scanty resources at their disposal, it is extremely difficult to get the panchayats to work although some efforts in that direction are made by the District Local Boards. It is however hoped that under the new Panchayats Act the compulsory levy of house tax and the independent position of the secretaries appointed by Government will accelerate the recovery of the Village Panchayats' dues and thereby improve the financial condition and general administration of these institutions. In accordance with the new Act, new panchayats are being constituted in villages having a population of 2,000 or more.

Sanitary Committees.

The number of the Sanitary Committees remained the same as last year. There are Sanitary Committees only in the districts of Nasik, Poona and Satara as shown in the statement No. V. Under the new Act, Sanitary Committees having a population of 2,000 or more will now be replaced by Village Panchayats.

16. Audit of Accounts.

There were no serious irregularities detected in audit requiring special mention.

17. (i) The Commissioner's remarks on the Administration of the Boards.

The point that calls most for remarks is again the financial position of these Boards. As this however is now the subject of Government consideration on the Kale Committee Report and the recommendations of a Conference of various Local Board Presidents, it is not proposed to go further into the matter.

It is satisfactory to note the improvement in the administration of the East Khandesh Local Board, which is now facing its duties with a more evident sense of responsibility. In Nasik, however, the administration has deteriorated, owing, chiefly, to the factiousness of the parties composing the Board. The situation became so bad that Government has been compelled to ask the Board to show cause why it should not be superseded. In Sholapur, too, the spirit of faction has had an adverse effect on the activities of the Board. There are signs now, however, that the Board is adopting a more courageous and responsible attitude towards the difficulties with which it is faced.

The administration of the other Boards is to be commended. The Board in West Khandesh showed a commendable keenness and once its efficiency which is still low is improved there is every reason to expect a continuing improvement in the conditions of the area in its charge. Ahmednagar has had another good year's administration. This Board has got excellent officers, and it has the further incomparable advantage that these officers are not being continually interfered with by the Local Board members in their day to day administration.

(ii) Provision of equal Facilities for Depressed Classes.

The Boards continued to provide equal facilities to all classes without any distinction of caste and creed in the use of schools, dispensaries, dharmashalas and public wells. The Boards took steps at a considerable cost to erect notice boards on the public wells declaring them to be open to people of all castes.

(iii) Any other Special Features of the year.

During the year the District Local Board, West Khandesh, continued its co-operation with the District Rural Development Board and sanctioned a grant of Rs. 500 for the Village Improvement Week which was celebrated with great success by the villagers and the Rural Development Board.

**REPORT ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF DISTRICT LOCAL
BOARDS IN THE SOUTHERN DIVISION
FOR THE YEAR 1939-40.**

1. Number of Local Boards.

No change.

2. Area and population.

No change.

3. Constitution.

The Belgaum, Bijapur, Kanara, Kolaba and Ratnagiri Boards were reconstituted with effect from 1st June 1939. Their new constitution is given in Statement No. I.

The salient features of the new constitutions are the elimination of nominated seats, an increase in strength, and the reservation of seats for women and important minorities.

4. Elections.

General elections were held in all districts except Dharwar. Appendix "A" contains the analysis of voting.

5. Meetings.

Forty-four meetings were held against 49 in the previous year: 8 were adjourned against 18; and none proved abortive.

All the Boards held the minimum number of meetings prescribed by section 35 (1) of the Act.

The average attendance rose from 77.35 to 89.1. Kolaba and Ratnagiri record the highest attendance.

Section 41 (1) of the Act was resorted to thrice by the Bijapur Board and once by the Kolaba Board.

6. Income.

The aggregate income, excluding opening balance and debt, fell from Rs. 53,25,832 to Rs. 49,27,894.

The important variations are:—

(a) *Land Revenue*.—The decrease is due to the non-receipt during the year by the Kolaba Board of Rs. 7,273 which was due to it.

(b) *Local rates*.—The increases in Belgaum (14,223), Dharwar (31,005), Kanara (4,481) and Ratnagiri (7,742) are set off by the decreases in Bijapur (2,86,486) and Kolaba (13,648). The increases at Dharwar and Kanara are accounted for by a good season and the collection of suspended arrears of cess. The increase in Belgaum is due partly to treasury adjustments after the close of the previous year and partly to fluctuations in receipts of cess on miscellaneous land revenue. Smooth working of the octroi system owing to the amendments in the law accounts for the increase at Ratnagiri. The collection during 1938-39 of accumulated suspended arrears of cess is the cause of the decrease at Bijapur. The decrease at Kolaba was due to some of the years' dues not being received by the end of the year.

(c) *Education*.—The decrease occurred in Bijapur (95,551), Dharwar (62,840), Kanara (12,757) and Ratnagiri (1,285). There was an increase of Rs. 76,274 in Belgaum and of Rs. 11,093 in Kolaba. The variations occur principally in the Government grants. The fall at Bijapur is further attributable to the receipt of interest on fixed deposits in 1938-39.

(d) *Medical*.—The variation is small.

(e) *Civil works*.—The decrease occurred mainly in Bijapur (90,925) and Dharwar (4,452) and is partly set off by increases in Belgaum (22,100), Kanara (2,152) and Kolaba (12,960). Special grants for scarcity works during 1938-39 were the cause of the decrease at Bijapur. Receipt of the arrears grant under the Motor Vehicles Tax Act by Belgaum, improvements in ferry receipts at Kanara and formal adjustments of the communications grant by Kolaba are the causes of the increase in these districts.

(f) *Industries*.—The fall in receipts occurred in fees from the verification of weights and measures which is made every alternate year.

7. Expenditure.

The aggregate expenditure chargeable to current income decreased from Rs. 51,14,960 to Rs. 49,75,129. The variations are given below:—

(a) *Administration*.—Expenditure increased from Rs. 1,64,846 to Rs. 1,70,372, the increase being contributed by—

In Dharwar there was a decrease of Rs. 2,066.

The main cause of the increases was additional expenditure on travelling allowance to members consequent on the enlarged constitutions. The decrease at Dharwar is attributed to savings in the pay of the establishment.

(b) *Education*.—The net decrease from Rs. 35,08,864 to Rs. 34,97,460 arises as below:—

The increase in Belgaum and Kolaba is due to an increase in the Government grant, and that in Kanara to the grant of personal pay to primary school teachers and the purchase of apparatus for physical training in schools. The payment of arrears of pay of teachers during 1938-39 mainly accounts for the decrease at Dharwar. The decrease in Bijapur was due to a decrease in the Government grant and exceptional payments in 1938-39.

(c) *Medical*.—The increase from Rs. 2,63,286 to Rs. 2,70,864 occurred in Bijapur (1,536), Dharwar (1,392), Kanara (2,319), Kolaba (599) and Ratnagiri (3,333). In Belgaum there was a decrease of Rs. 1,601.

The causes for the variations were :—

(1) Non-payment of dues by Belgaum for medicines supplied to dispensaries and of local fund grants to sanitary committees before the end of the year.

(2) The opening of more rural dispensaries and appointment of subsidised medical practitioners and midwives in Bijapur, Kanara and Kolaba ; and

(3) Increased epidemic charges in Kanara due to the outbreak of plague.

(d) *Civil works*.—The expenditure decreased from Rs. 10,09,480 to Rs. 8,78,052. In Kolaba and Ratnagiri there were increases of Rs. 11,612 and Rs. 11,304 respectively, but in Belgaum, Bijapur, Dharwar and Kanara, decreases of Rs. 35,255, Rs. 88,310, Rs. 19,459 and Rs. 11,320. The variation occurred in the expenditure on communications and water-supply.

8. Closing Balance.

The aggregate closing balance of the boards amounted to Rs. 17,90,607 against Rs. 19,50,850 in the previous year. The balances are in excess of the prescribed minimum.

9. Primary Education.

Belgaum.—The number of primary schools rose from 764 to 834 and of pupils from 56,592 to 61,819. There were 40 schools for the scheduled classes with 3,209 pupils. The Board provided the scheduled classes with 19 scholarships of the total value of Rs. 515.

There were 13 agricultural classes attached to primary schools attended by 384 pupils.

Physical training is imparted in almost all the schools. The board invested Rs. 5,203 for equipment and apparatus for physical training.

The shift system introduced in 131 one-teacher schools continue. Two "basic" schools have also been started.

Bijapur.—The number of schools was 771 against 735 in the previous year, and of pupils 44,567 against 41,081. Special attention is paid to the education of Muslims and the scheduled classes and there are 54 scholarships for the scheduled classes and 27 for Muslims. Eight agricultural bias classes are also maintained. Physical training and scouting are also attended to.

Dharwar.—There was no change in the number of schools but the number of pupils decreased from 53,503 to 50,365 in the schools in the local board area. The English classes attached to three primary schools continued.

Kanara.—Schools increased from 387 to 409 and students from 25,570 to 27,221. Scholarships awarded to Harijans and Muslims amounted to Rs. 1,179 and Rs. 141 respectively.

Kolaba.—Schools increased by 12 and pupils by 1,049. The four night classes for adult education started last year continued, though attendance dwindled.

Ratnagiri.—Sixteen new schools were opened and the number of pupils rose from 52,106 to 61,448. The under-staffed schools were reinforced by 60 additional assistants.

The Board took in hand the construction of school buildings at Devrukh, Sakharpa and Majagaon, where they were badly needed.

The School of Industry at Ratnagiri continued to give instruction in carpentry, smithy, mechanics and coir working. A weaving class was started at Kankaoli in Devgad taluka.

10. Medical and Public Health.

Plague broke out in 33 villages in Belgaum, 66 in Dharwar, 9 in Kanara and 17 in Bijapur, and cholera in 2 villages in Belgaum. Timely preventive measures stamped out the epidemics. Bijapur engaged a touring medical officer for preventive duties. The sanitary staff at Dharwar visited 709 villages for purposes of improvement in general sanitation and organizing anti-epidemic measures. Kolaba and Ratnagiri were free from any epidemic and their public health was satisfactory. The problem of malaria which is specially severe in Kanara and the adjoining areas of Dharwar and Belgaum, has in no way abated.

Rural medical centres are becoming popular. Dharwar continued to be the only board which employed a Health Officer.

11. Veterinary Dispensaries.

Epizootics broke out in three talukas in Belgaum but timely preventive measures checked their spread.

12. Civil Works.

The communications grant allotted to and the amounts spent by the boards from these grants and from their own funds are :—

The Belgaum board constructed new earth roads of the total length of 10 miles and 4 furlongs and converted 6 miles and 4 furlongs of unmetalled roads into metalled roads. Bijapur increased its road mileage to 390. Kolaba completed 8 new roads and one causeway.

13. Water Supply.

No grants-in-aid were paid to local boards for village water-supply. The expenditure of the boards on water-supply was :—

The year's Government grants for village water-supply were controlled by independent District Committees, the programmes of which were carried out through the agency of the local boards.

14. Standing and other Committees.

Standing committees were appointed by all the boards in accordance with section 36 (1) of the Act. Budget committees were appointed by Belgaum and Bijapur; veterinary dispensary and dispensary committees by Belgaum, Bijapur, Kanara and Kolaba; public health committees by Kanara and Ratnagiri and rules committees by Ratnagiri and Kolaba. There was also an industrial and agricultural committee in Ratnagiri, a village panchayat committee in Belgaum and a rural development committee in Kanara.

15. Village Panchayats and Village Sanitary Committees.

The number of village panchayats was the same as in the previous year. The working of the panchayats was not very satisfactory owing to inadequate finances and unwillingness to collect taxes.

The number of village sanitary committees was unchanged.

16. Audit of Accounts.

The accounts of all the district local boards for 1938-39 were audited. There were no serious irregularities requiring special mention.

17. General Remarks.

All boards are badly in need of increased resources but none of them took any step to secure them during the year. In the circumstances of the year this was excusable because the Kale Committee, which reported half way through the year, has made very far-reaching proposals for the improvement of local board revenue which cannot be implemented without a great deal of consideration.

18. Conclusion.

The year was one of unspectacular progress. The Commissioner inspected the offices of the Bijapur and Dharwar Boards and found them competently conducted. The Presidents and Vice-Presidents of the boards displayed much energy and devotion to the good of their districts.
