Subject:—*Recommendations of the Bombay Delimitation Advisory Committee regarding the delimitation of constituencies of the House of the People and the State Legislature.*

Sir,

We have the honour to forward herewith our recommendations regarding the delimitation of constituencies for (1) the House of the People, (2) the Bombay State Legislative Assembly and (3) the Bombay State Legislative Council.

2. The Committee were assisted in their labours by the material supplied by the State Government and the various suggestions received from the members of the public.

3. The procedure followed prior to the formulation of our final views was briefly as follows: The statistics and material required for the preparation of the detailed scheme of constituencies was first prepared by the Collectors of the Districts concerned. On receipt of the reports from the Collectors, the tentative scheme formulated by the State Government was published in the *Official Gazette* and copies were kept for inspection at all District and Taluka Headquarters. In order that public opinion might have the fullest opportunity of expressing itself, copies of the State Government proposals were also kept on sale at a nominal price of two annas. A number of suggestions were received in response to this. All these representations received from the members of the public were carefully considered by the Committee before formulating their final proposals.

4. It will thus be seen that the recommendations of the Committee contained in the statements attached to this letter are the outcome of deliberation, discussion and labour extending over a long period. Both officials as well as the members of the public had ample opportunity of expressing their views on the subject. The recommendations of the Committee are concisely stated in the succeeding paragraphs.

I. HOUSE OF THE PEOPLE.

5. *General Principles.*—Forty-five seats have been allotted in the House of the People to this State. A group of 7 constituencies of the State Legislative Assembly forms a constituency of the House of the People. In framing the constituencies for the House of the People, the Committee has taken care to see that the limits of population laid down in article 81 (b) of the Constitution have been strictly adhered to. In view of this constitutional provision, it has not been possible to maintain the territorial integrity of a District. However, contiguity, size of each proposed constituency, its physical features, means of transport available within it, administrative feasibility, possibilities of contact between candidates and voters, etc. have been taken into account in forming the constituencies. The seats reserved for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes have been distributed on the basis of their population in each District. Four seats each have been reserved in the House of the People for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in this State. The Committee has allotted these seats to the constituencies in which their concentration is the largest.

A statement showing the distribution of the 45 seats allotted to Bombay State in the House of the People and 315 seats in the State Legislative Assembly is appended to this letter. The reserved seats for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes are also indicated.

II. STATE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.

6. Three hundred and fifteen seats have been allotted to the State Legislative Assembly. Out of these 315 seats, 29 seats are to be reserved seats for the Scheduled Tribes and 27 for the Scheduled Castes. In forming the constituencies for the State Legislative Assembly, the Committee has tried to distribute the seats as equitably as possible, that is to say, the size of each constituency has been kept uniform as far as possible according to local circumstances. Special endeavour has been made to keep intact the administrative units of Taluka and Mahal. A departure from this rule has been made where, owing to the excess of the population, it has not been possible to adhere to the Taluka or Mahal unit. In such cases, the requisite number of villages have been taken away and included in the adjoining constituency. Apart from the population, other factors, such as, means of communication, geographical features and natural barriers like mountains, rivers running in between, etc. have been taken into consideration while delimiting the constituencies.

7. As observed in paragraph 6 above, there are 29 and 27 seats reserved for the Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes, respectively. One possible way of allocation of the reserved seats is that of selecting constituencies in which the number of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes is the largest in order of number, but in doing so it would happen that a particular District like Sholapur for instance with a total of

13 seats would get as many as 9 reserved seats for the Scheduled Castes : when as a matter of fact, the total number of Scheduled Caste voters in Sholapur District is only 1,02,331 out of 6,93,591 total voters. It will therefore be seen that a distribution according to Districts is more equitable, as Scheduled Castes are more or less evenly scattered throughout the State. With a view to distributing the reserved seats as equitably as possible throughout the State, the Committee decided to allot the reserved seats on the basis of the Districtwise population of the Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes.

III. STATE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

8. In all there are 72 seats in the State Legislative Council. Out of these 72 seats, —

(i) 24 members are to be elected by the members of the State Legislative Assembly ;

(ii) 12 members are to be nominated by the Governor ;

(iii) 24 members are to be elected by the members of the Municipalities, District Local Boards and Cantonment Boards ;

(iv) 6 members are to be elected by persons who have been at least three years graduates of a University in India or have been for at least three years in possession of qualification prescribed by or under any law made by Parliament as equivalent to that of a graduate of a University ;

(v) 6 members are to be elected by persons who have been for at least three years engaged in teaching in such educational institutions within the State, not lower in standard than that of a secondary school, as may be prescribed by or under any law made by Parliament.

9. There is no question of forming constituencies for (i) and (ii) in paragraph 8 above. As regards (iii), the following factors were taken into account by the Committee in distributing the 24 seats among the various local authorities in this State. Though the electorate is to consist of the members of these bodies, we thought that it would not be an equitable distribution if the 24 seats were allocated on the basis of the respective member strength of each local authority. For, there is no uniformity or definite principle on which the number of members has been fixed. It varies from place to place according to the exigencies of local conditions. A Municipality with a revenue of Rs. 9,700 only has 10 members, while the Municipal Corporation of Bombay with a revenue of nearly Rs. 8 crores has 135 members. Similarly, if revenue figures are taken as the basis, many smaller Municipalities would get no representation at all. For the same reasons, more or less, the Committee

did not adopt population alone as the basis. In the circumstances, we thought that it would be appropriate to take into consideration all the three factors mentioned above for the purpose of allocating 24 seats to different local authorities in the State. In accordance with this basis, the 24 seats have been distributed as shown in Annexure A to this letter.

10. *Graduates' Constituency.*—The Committee understands that until and unless Parliament has prescribed the qualification as equivalent to that of a graduate of a University, the State Government will not be in a position to prepare the electoral roll for the graduates' constituency. The Committee has, however, after taking into consideration all available data decided to allocate the 6 seats in the graduates' constituency as follows:—

Bombay City	.. 2 seats.
Ahmedabad and Poona Cities	.. 1 seat (by rotation).
Northern Division	.. 1 seat.
Central Division	.. 1 seat.
Southern Division	.. 1 seat.

11. *Teachers' Constituency.*—For the same reasons mentioned in paragraph 10 above, the State Government has not been able to prepare an electoral roll for the Teachers' Constituency. The Committee has decided to allocate the six seats in the Teachers' Constituency on the same lines as in the Graduates' Constituency, that is to say,

Bombay City	.. 2 seats.
Ahmedabad and Poona Cities	.. 1 seat (by rotation).
Northern Division	.. 1 seat.
Central Division	.. 1 seat.
Southern Division	.. 1 seat.

12. In the case of Ahmedabad and Poona Cities, where we have proposed seats by rotation in both the Graduates' and Teachers' Constituencies, the seats in either constituency should be given to these cities by turn, i.e., if Ahmedabad is given the Graduates' seat, Poona should get the seat in the Teachers' Constituency and *vice versa*.

13. Each House of the People Constituency is formed by combining 7 constituencies of the State Legislative Assembly. The names and extent of each constituency is shown in a separate statement. In the Districts of this State there are no well defined sub-divisions of Talukas or Mahals, and therefore it is necessary in cases where Talukas or Mahals are split up to give a list of villages included in each split Taluka or Mahal. The list showing the extent of each constituency, i.e., names of villages included in each constituency is also enclosed.

14. We cannot conclude this report without expressing our grateful thanks to Shri M. D. Bhat, I.C.S., Chief Secretary to Government, Shri M. R. Meher, I.C.S. (Retd.), Chief Electoral Officer, Shri B. K. Phadkar, Secretary of the Committee, and the members of the staff for the very valuable help they have rendered us in the preparation of this report. But for their earnest and untiring efforts, the Committee would not have been in a position to make the report in the stipulated time.
