AND FOREIGN TRADE BALANCES

1910-1923.

Vol. I. gives balances of international payments during the year 1922 for 13 countries with explanations on the methods used in compiling the estimates and notes on capital movements, trade balances, visible and invisible trade, etc. It contains also summarised tables of trade (by quantity and value) for post-war years up to the end of 1923 compared with 1913 for about 40 countries, together with trade tables of values calculated at 1913 prices (absolute and percentage figures) for 24 countries and percentage tables of trade by countries.

Vol. II. gives detailed trade tables of 42 countries for the years 1910-1922, distinguishing merchandise, gold bullion and specie and silver bullion and specie; also tables for 1912, 1913 and post-war years, by principal articles and by country, and tables by months for 1921 and 1922. The volume contains notes on the manner of compiling trade statistics in 33 countries.
