APPENDIX.

Notes to supplement, correct and enlarge the information contained in the A Volume, Gazetteer of the Seoni district.

The Police force of the District has been increased since 1st January 1911 to 66 Officers and 215 men in addition to three mounted constables, and the district now contains 13 station houses, outposts having been abolished in the re-allocation scheme. The station houses are : Seoni, Korai, Barghat, Keolari, Ghansore, Lakhnadon, Chhapara, Kanhiwara, Ugli, Dhanora, Dhuma, Kedarpur and Bandol.

Para. 156, page 159. General Administration—Police.

The contract distillery system has now extended to the whole of the district with the exception of a few jungly villages of Kedarpur tract, which are served by three outstills. The distillery at Seoni supplies liquor to Mandlā, Balaghat and Chhindwara and part of Bhandara district. It is worked by a steam engine. The number of liquor shops has decreased from 266 in 1906-1907 to 149 in 1911-12. The Revenue from Excise in this district in 1910-11 was Rs. 88,913, and thus the district was eleventh in the Province. The incidence of Revenue per head in 1911-12 came to be four annas eight pies per head.

Para. 149, page 155. Excise—Country liquor.

The number of opium shops remains unchanged ; there has been an increase of those in Ganja shops. The revenue from this source was Rs. 87,147 in 1911-12 or three annas eleven pies per head.

Para. 150 page 156. Opium and Ganja.

The Rimal tank has been constructed and commands 14 villages of Ugli tract. It is managed by the Irrigation Department, whose overseer stops here. Two Irrigation tanks, i.e., Usri in Ari tract and Khandasa in Korai tract were built by the Irrigation Department, but handed over to Patwaris for management. They command only two villages each.

A dispensary at Barghat has been started from April 1908.

Para. 160, page 161. Dispensaries, Barghat.

The Gondi Taluka has now by virtue of a special sanad come to Diwan Shujaat Ali Khan, son of Mohamad Ali Khan, his heirs and successors, subject, along with other conditions, to the payment of Takoli and cesses from time to time assessed by Government.

Para. 142, page 149. Revenue-free and quit-rent grants

Chhapara is also under the Mukaddam rules, and the annual receipts amount to about Rs. 500.
