## APPENDIX.

*Notes to supplement, correct and enlarge the information contained in the A Volume Gazetteer of the Buldana district.*

*Land Revenue.*—In this paragraph it is noted that mutation of names is not compulsory and hence it often happens that a Khatedar from motives, perhaps of sentiment, perhaps of sloth, prefers to keep his name on the Government registers long after he has parted with the land.

Para. 313, page 330.

Under the system of Land Records at present in force in Berar, a record is maintained of the "Registered Occupant" of each Survey No. all other rights being unrecorded with the exception that an attempt is now made to record the name only in the Crop Statement but not the status of the persons who actually cultivated the Survey No. This record is very inaccurate for, as said above, there is no legal obligation to report changes in the Registered Occupant and changes can only be effected by a regular mutation proceeding before a Revenue Officer; deaths, transfers and other changes are often not brought to notice, with the result that many registered occupants have no possession over or right in the Survey No. recorded in their names. The rights of all other persons whether sharers, mortgagees, or purchasers are not recorded at all.

In order to remedy all these defects, the work of Record of Rights has now been commenced in the Jalgaon taluq and elsewhere in other parts of Berar on the lines followed in the Bombay Presidency where the Rayatwari system of Land Revenue is similar to that in Berar with a few modifications to suit the local conditions of the province.

The lines on which the work will be done have been given in Part V of Resolution No. 11 of C. P. Administration Survey and Settlement Department, dated Nagpur, the 5th January 1912. The preparation of an initial Record of Rights will not, however, suffice to protect the rights of landholders and others having interest in land and with this view, a provision is made for the annual maintenance of the records by entrusting the work to the Patwaris and officers of the Land Records' staff.

In order to provide a legal basis for the preparation of the Record of Rights and its maintenance, an amendment to the Land Revenue Code of 1896 is proposed by adding a new chapter. The work of Record of Rights is proposed to be completed in three years.

*Land Revenue.*—In this paragraph it has been stated that in the Malkapur taluq the full enhancement ensuing from the revised rates was ordered to take effect only from the beginning of the sixteenth year.

Para. 315, page 357.

In compliance with the sanction of the Hon'ble the Chief Commissioner (conveyed in letter No. 377-XI-21-21, dated 2nd/4th July 1910), the full rates of the Revision Survey have been introduced in 201 villages of this taluq with effect from 1st August 1910.

*District, Sub-divisions and staff.*—The Court of the Small Cause Court Judge at Khamgaon has been abolished from 1st April 1912 and the Court of the Sub-Judge has been invested with the powers of a Small Cause Court judge. From the same date, a new Court of, Sub-Judge has been created at Malkapur having jurisdiction in the Malkapur taluq.

The Court of the Bench Magistrate at Nandura has been abolished and in its place, a Court of a Special Magistrate with 3rd Class powers has been established.

The sanctioned strength of the Police Force is 593. This figure includes a District Superintendent of Police, two Assistant Superintendents of Police, a Reserve Inspector, a Prosecuting Inspector, four Circle Inspectors, 33 Sub-Inspectors, 86 Head Constables and 465 Constables, of whom three are Camel Sowars. Out of the District Police 8 officers and 150 men constitute a Reserve.

Recruiting locally is attended with considerable difficulty, owing to the keen demand for labour, and the high wages paid for the same, about half the recruits obtained are from local sources, whereas the remaining half are from the United Provinces. The Force contains 374 Hindus, 169 Mahomedans, and four other castes. There are 22 Station-houses and 3 Patrol Post in the district. The Station-houses are situated at Buldana, Chikhli, Dhad, Amrapur, Andhera, Mehkar, Fattekherda, Janephal, Lonar, Kingaon Raja, Dewalgaon Raja, Malkapur, Dhamangaon, Borakhedi, Pimpalgaon Raja, Nandura, Jalgaon, Tamgaon, Khamgaon, Shegaon, Hewarkhed and Jalumb, and Patrol Posts at Ghatbori, Kingaon Jattoo, and Maharkhed.

*Village Sanitation.*—The Village Sanitation Act, Central Provinces, has now been made applicable to Berar (*vide C. P. Gazette Notification, No. 1001-1-B, dated 24-5-1910*) and the Act has been extended to the villages of Chikhli and Dewalghat in the Chikhli taluq, Mehkar, Lonar, and Janephal in the Mehkar taluq, Nandura in the Malkapur taluq, Jalgaon and Pimpalgaon Kale in the Jalgaon taluq and Jalumb and Matergaon Buzrug in the Khamgaon taluq. Village Sanitation Committees have been formed in these villages and satisfactory progress has already been attained in their work. The District Board advanced sufficient money to each of these Committees to enable them to start their work.

All the Provincial roads and buildings, except those in Khamgaon and Jalgaon taluqs, which have been transferred to the Buldana District Council for maintenance are in the charge of the Executive Engineer, West Berar Division, Akola, assisted by a Sub-Divisional Officer at Buldana. The district contains 180½ miles of Provincial Class I roads, of which 64 miles have been handed over to the District Council for maintenance. The water-supply for Buldana is obtained from the Satrabar tank and the Sogona well, and is satisfactory. The Khamgaon water-supply is obtained from the Januna tank, which was constructed in equal shares from the proceeds of One Anna Sutta tax on grain transaction and from a Government grant. This tank has failed many times during the last twenty years owing to a shrinkage in the rainfall, and plans for improving the water-supply are under investigation. The principal buildings are the District Court and offices, the District Jail, the Civil Court, the New Circuit House, the Old Circuit House (converted into an Anglo-Vernacular School) the Police offices and Reserved lines, the Civil Hospital, the Dak and Inspection Bungalows, and the Public Works Department Sub-Divisional Office.

*Dispensaries.*—Family Wards have now been provided at the Buldana Main and the Shegaon and Mehkar Branch Dispensaries for the reception and treatment of well-to-do persons. The Wards at Mehkar and Shegaon have been constructed from private subscriptions and the two Wards at Mehkar have been named after Mr. F. G. Sly, I.C.S., the Commissioner of Berar and Mrs. Currie, wife of the Deputy Commissioner of Buldana.

A new Operation Theatre has been constructed at the Buldana Dispensary. This is an up-to-date Theatre with marble flooring and separate rooms for the patients to be removed to after the operation and for the storage of surgical instruments. The Theatre has got a large stock of surgical instruments. It was built at a cost of Rs. 6,300, of which the District Board paid Rs. 2,300 and the balance of Rs. 4,000 was paid by three native gentlemen. A new Branch Dispensary is under construction at Dhad and will soon be opened to the public.

*Vaccination.*—The town of Malkapur has now been included under the Vaccination Act.

*Registration.*—The Registration Department was reorganized with effect from 1st November 1910.

The Sub-Office at Janephal was abolished from 15th October 1910 and the villages comprised in that Sub-district have been included in the Mehkar Sub-district.

There are now only 15 Registration offices in the Buldana district, including the office of the District Registrar.

The Rural Sub-Registrars at Borakhedi and Dewalgaon Raja have been appointed salaried Sub-Registrars with effect from 1st November 1910.

All Sub-Registrars are now paid partly by salaries and partly by commission. Sub-Registrars of II and IV Class offices are paid commission at the rate of five annas on each registration and those of I and III Class offices at the rate of three annas per document registered.
