Explanatory Notes to Part II-A Tables

1. The Part II tables are divided into two parts: the Part II-A tables and the Part II-B tables. While the Part II-B tables cover input-output data of individual sample farms, the present volume of Part II-A tables relates to data relating to the land utilization, cropping pattern, family size, number of workers, asset-composition etc. of individual sample farms. A basic outline of the study though discussed earlier in the report, is presented briefly in Section 2 below for ready reference.

2.1 The data relate to the Farm Management Study in Ahmednagar District, Maharashtra State, for the year 1967-68. The district was divided into four zones from which a sample of 150 farms was taken from 15 villages in the district, each village contributing 10 farms. These farms were selected from five size groups of holdings, common to all villages. The analysis, however, is made for 136 farms from 14 villages as data were inadequate for the remaining 14 farms. The distribution of these 136 farms over zones, villages and size groups is presented in Table 2.1(b) while Table 2.1(a) shows the distribution of villages over zones.

2.2 The holding size-group ranges from which the farms were selected from each village are as follows:

3. The data in these Part II-A tables are presented farmwise for each of the fourteen villages separately. Each of these tables starts with the farmer (or the farm) code number. A five digit code number is allotted to each farm. The first digit from the left is the zone number. The second digit denotes the village number in that zone, the third digit denotes the size group number, the fourth digit is for the number of farms in that size group (in that village) and the fifth digit indicates the serial number of farm in that size group. For example, code number 32521 indicates the farm is from the third zone and second village, belongs to the fifth size group which has two farms in all (in that village) of which this farm is the first one.

Table A-I : Size of farm and tenancy - This table indicates how the holding size (col. 5) has been arrived at. The farms were selected on the basis of holding size.

Table A-II : Land utilization - Farmwise information about the net sown area, net irrigated area, the gross cropped area and the gross irrigated area is presented in these tables.

Table A-III : Cropping pattern - Crops are divided into the kharif crops, rabi crops and long term crops. Seven

crops covering more than 93 per cent of the sample gross cropped area are covered separately and the rest are included under 'other kharif', 'other rabi' and 'fruit gardens and others'. Area under the sugarcane crop which was harvested during the year under consideration appears in col. 10. The sugarcane crop area that was included in the gross cropped area as the crop was there throughout the year but which was to be harvested in the rabi season of the next year (1968-69) is included in col. 11 under 'Sugarcane (standing)'. The irrigated and unirrigated area break-up of crops is also presented.

Table A-IV : Size of family, number of earners and number of permanent farm servants - The category of 'earners in the family' covers individuals who are generally engaged in earning activity. Children engaged in farm or non-farm work and hence are earning dependents are also considered. Adult males or females working very occasionally (in either farm or non-farm work) are not included in earners.

Table A-V : Value of operational assets pertaining to operational holding - This table contains 29 columns. Whenever possible, both quantity and value are given. Implements are divided into two broad categories, viz., major and minor and its further break-up into important items is also presented. Other constructions used in farm activity are not shown separately but are included in col. 27 under 'total value of operational assets including other construction'. Value of dwelling house and leased out land come under cols. 28 and 29 to complete the entire asset composition.

Table A-VI : Maintenance cost per pair of bullocks per annum - An important aspect to note about these tables is

that the accounts are based on the thirty-two weeks that were covered by the Cost Accounting method as the field work commenced in late October of 1967. The per annum values are based on this period. In case of some farms due to this limited period covered and because of the frequent changes in the bullock holding during the year the accounts were found to be inadequate and the estimates are based on other farms in the same villages. Number of bullocks mentioned in col. 15 is the one obtained at the beginning of the year.

Table A-VII : Information on annual farm servants on sample farms - In this table col. 1 indicates the serial number of a permanent farm servant on a given farm. Cols. 2 to 4 indicate the total amount paid for the year and its break-up into cash and kind payment. Cols. 5 to 9 indicate the per hour-day and the employed day rates that were obtained based on the 32 weeks period covered by the Cost Accounting method. Col. 10 indicates whether a farm servant was engaged in farm work or upkeep of animals or both.
