PREFACE TO FOURTH EDITION

THIS book has been revised once more, and the old title of *Guide to Political Economy* has been altered to bring it into line with modern nomenclature. The principal changes are in the chapter on Money, and are chiefly those necessitated by lapse of time, and by the abandonment of the Gold Standard in 1931. The theory of money remains the same; and so far as its relation to an effective gold standard is concerned, it would be unwise to assume that a departure from that standard is permanent. In other respects no changes from the Third Edition have been deemed to be necessary.
