FOREWORD

The Committee of the Indian Merchants' Chamber have arranged to publish a series of brochures on different questions affecting Labour, the fundamental object being to get all such questions properly studied by all those who have the interests of industries at heart. With the setting up of autonomous Governments in different Provinces, there has naturally set in a movement for ameliorating the condition of Labour and for a forward Social policy. It is desirable that all the pros and cons of different questions be set forth by people who have studied these questions from a comparative point of view, and it is hoped that this series will be useful in inducing a study of such questions.
