Divisional reviews on the above.

READ ALSO—

This Government's resolution, local self-government department No. 59-A—VIII, dated the 15th March 1921.

R E S O L U T I O N .

The divisional reviews were due on the 15th September 1921, but none of them were received punctually, the one for Berar being more than two months late. The delay is ascribed to the late submission of the district reports.

2. *Number of municipalities, their constitution and meetings.*—The number of municipalities has increased from 59 to 60 owing to the conversion of the Gondia notified area into a municipality with effect from the 1st April 1920. The Khapa and Kalmeshwar municipalities, which consisted entirely of nominated members, were given the right of election and re-constituted with a large majority of elected members. The policy of allowing municipal committees internal control over their affairs was steadily pursued, and the number of elected non-official Chairmen increased from 41 to 43. All the committees held the prescribed number of meetings except Pachmarhi, Mandla, Ellichpur Civil Station and Akola. Attendance at meetings was generally satisfactory except at Nagpur, Wardha, Hinganghat, Jubbulpore, Murwara and Mandla, where it was below 50 per cent. The average percentage of officials present at each meeting declined from 58 to 56, and that of non-officials from 63 to 61. The attention of official members should be drawn to the concluding remarks in paragraph 2 of last year's resolution regarding the necessity of regular attendance at municipal meetings.

3. *Elections.*—General triennial elections were held in some of the municipalities of the Nagpur division and there was keen competition almost everywhere. The right of electing members was extended to the Khapa and Kalmeshwar municipalities. Three vacancies at Akola and one each at Akot and Murtizapur remained unfilled as no candidates came forward.

4. *Income.*—The total municipal income, excluding extraordinary and debt heads, fell from Rs. 45,15,000 to Rs. 43,82,000, but excluding Government contributions which amounted to Rs. 4,34,000, the real municipal income was Rs. 39,48,000. The most noticeable decrease (*viz.*, from Rs. 3,99,000 to Rs. 2,54,000) occurred under the head "Miscellaneous"; the cause of this was the cessation of business in salt, cloth and kerosene oil initiated under special conditions by the municipal committees in the Nerbudda division during the previous year. The income of some municipalities decreased under the head "octroi" as the year was a *singhast* year, but on the whole the net receipts from octroi rose from Rs. 11,65,000 to Rs. 11,81,000, refunds amounting to Rs. 3,50,000 only against Rs. 4,83,000 in the previous year. The increase is mainly due to the revision of rates and also to the inclusion of new articles in the schedule of goods liable to octroi duty.

5. *Taxes other than octroi.*—The income from taxes other than octroi amounted to Rs. 15,46,000 against Rs. 14,72,000 in the previous year, the principal increase being under the tax on animals and vehicles (Rs. 7,000), tax on professions and trades (Rs. 18,000), water rate (Rs. 38,000), and bazar tax (Rs. 49,000). The increase in the tax on animals and vehicles was due to the collection of arrears at Nagpur and to the introduction of the tax for the first time at Umrer and Gondia. The increase under the tax on professions and trades was the result of the good cotton crop in Berar and to the revision of the assessment list at Shegaon, while the larger receipts under the last two heads were due to the revision of the rates of assessment. The tax on the registration of the sale of cattle produced only Rs. 32,000 against Rs. 58,000 in the previous year; there was throughout the year a semi-religious, semi-political movement to prevent the sale of cattle to butchers, which directly affected the receipts under this head. Income from the terminal tax also decreased from Rs. 2,73,000 to Rs. 2,60,000 as a result of the slackness of trade consequent on the failure of the crops. During the year terminal taxes were introduced at Dhamtari and Mandla and sanction was accorded to their introduction at Gondia, Shegaon and Malkapur. In Berar except at Akot, Akola, Malkapur, Murtizapur and Khamgaon, the collection of taxes was generally satisfactory. As a result of the warning given last year, the municipal committee, Khamgaon, have removed their Secretary and a further report on the position of the affairs of that municipality is now awaited.

6. *Income from Nazul and Special Acts.*—Realisations under special Acts were Rs. 1,87,000 as against Rs. 1,99,000 in the previous year. The decrease is noticeable under all the three sub-heads, namely, pounds Rs. 5,000, hackney carriages Rs. 3,000 and surplus cotton market receipts Rs. 4,000. The revenue derived from municipal property and powers apart from taxation fell from Rs. 7,73,000 to Rs. 7,49,000. The decrease is due partly to the unusual receipts by the Nagpur municipality last year on account of premia on the sale of plots in Craddock Town and partly to the relinquishment by the Khurai and Saugor municipalities of the management of their slaughter-houses resulting in a loss of slaughter-house fees.

7. *Contributions.*—Government contributions amounted to Rs. 4,34,000 against Rs. 4,92,000, of which a sum of Rs. 1,64,000 represents grants for sanitary purposes. Grants amounting to Rs. 47,000, Rs. 5,000, Rs. 10,000 and Rs. 5,000 were given to the Khandwa, Balaghat, Amraoti Camp and Buldana municipalities, to improve the water supply in these places. The Khandwa and Jubbulpore municipalities received Rs. 25,000 and Rs. 10,000 for drainage and plague relief measures respectively. Indirect expenditure on sanitation amounted to Rs. 10,000 which included expenditure on the training at Bombay of candidates for the posts of Sanitary Inspectors and the subsidy towards the entertainment of Health Officers and Sanitary Inspectors. The Nagpur municipal committee received Rs. 79,000 for the city drainage scheme, rat destruction operations, Pachpaoli extension, improvement of pay of vernacular school teachers and for the maintenance of factory schools. A grant of Rs. 39,000 was given to various municipalities to meet the cost of war and scarcity allowances to vernacular school teachers. Educational grants recurring and non-recurring rose from Rs. 1,81,000 to Rs. 2,08,000. The newly constituted Gondia municipality was given a special grant of Rs. 6,000 to meet its current expenditure.

8. *Loans.*—Loans amounting to Rs. 2,25,000 were advanced to the Nagpur Jubbulpore, Saugor, Amraoti Town, Amraoti Camp, Akola and Basim municipalities during the year; out of this Rs. 1,15,000 was given for the improvement of water supply, Rs. 50,000 for drainage and the balance of Rs. 60,000 for other improvement schemes. The loans outstanding at the close of the year amounted to Rs. 27,26,000, of which Nagpur was responsible for Rs. 14,58,000 and Jubbulpore for Rs. 2,76,000. The financial condition of the Harda municipality continued to be unsatisfactory and the committee's proposals to enhance the rates of the terminal tax could not be entertained as they contravened the standing orders on the subject. The Damoh municipal committee again failed

to pay the instalment of its water-works loan ; but steps have since been taken to improve the committee's financial position. The financial position of all other towns which have taken loans from Government is satisfactory.

9. *General financial results.*—The total opening balance was Rs. 17,40,000. This was in excess of the amount actually shown in the last year's accounts by Rs. 3,000 owing to certain adjustments made by the Accountant General after the close of the year in the accounts of the Ellichpur Civil Station municipality, and to the inclusion of the opening balance of the newly constituted Gondia municipality. Receipts amounted to Rs. 51,60,000 and expenditure to Rs. 55,19,000 leaving a closing balance of Rs. 13,81,000. The closing balances of all municipalities except Pauni, Deoli, Mandla, Damoh, Narsinghpur, Ellichpur City, Malkapur and Khamgaon, were in excess of the prescribed minimum. In most cases the large closing balances are due to the unspent balances of the government grants or sums earmarked for special objects.

10. *Water supply.*—The capital outlay on water supply rose from Rs. 81,000 to Rs. 1,59,000. The work of strengthening the dam of the Ambajari reservoir at Nagpur was finally completed during the year at a total cost of Rs. 2,20,238 against the sanctioned estimate of Rs. 2,20,827. The Wardha municipal committee received a grant of Rs. 2,578 for further investigation into the Panchdhara gravitation scheme. In Jubbulpore the water in the reservoir fell to a dangerously low level ; this was the result not wholly of the failure of the monsoon, but partly also of wasteful consumption; on the advice of the Sanitary Engineer the municipal committee have asked for the services of an officer of the Geological Survey to investigate the possibilities of supplementing the supply by tapping sub-soil water. Financial stringency has prevented the Bilaspur municipality from undertaking work on the water supply scheme. Proposals for the improvement of water works at Seoni and Harda are under consideration, and also schemes for Murwara, Narsinghpur, Gadarwara and Betul. Owing to the very deficient rainfall during the year almost all committees in Berar incurred large expenditure in improving and extending their sources of water supply. At Amraoti the pumping installations failed and arrangements had to be made for the supply of water from a private well. Fortunately the difficulties which the Amraoti Camp and City committees have had to encounter during the year under report have now disappeared and the supply for the next two years is assured. At Akola, the Kapsi tank held no water and pumping was continued from the Masod well. Owing to the abnormal expenditure on water works, the committees of Amraoti Town, Akola, Amraoti Camp and Basim were given loans from Government. The imposition of the water rate sanctioned at Akola continues to be in abeyance owing to the failure of the Kapsi tank.

Many of the municipal committees desire that their water-works which were hitherto managed by the Public Works Department on their behalf should be transferred to their charge. Government has now decided that municipal committees may, if they wish, take over the management of their own water-works ; orders have already been issued for the transfer of the Harda, Wardha and Buldana water-works from the charge of the Public Works Department to that of the municipalities concerned.

11. *Drainage.*—The capital outlay on drainage rose from Rs. 27,000 to Rs. 2,99,000. The Nagpur municipality spent Rs. 1,99,000 on underground and surface drainage works in progress. Arrangements have been made with Messrs Lane Brown and Hewlett to undertake the maintenance of the Nagpur drainage works for a period of five years with effect from the 1st April 1920. The necessary staff for the work has been employed by the municipality and is being trained by the firm. The Jubbulpore municipality spent Rs. 25,000 in laying out new surface drains in the town. An underground sewage scheme for the town has been prepared by the Municipal Engineer and is now being examined by the Sanitary Engineer. Materials are being collected for the construction of surface drains at Khandwa ; but it is doubtful whether the municipal committee will be able to afford to proceed with the scheme; similarly in Burhanpur and Bilaspur, it is impossible at present to undertake any drainage scheme.

12. Sanitary and Medical.—The expenditure on conservancy and sanitation rose from Rs. 8,74,000 to Rs. 9,91,000. The increase mainly represents the enhanced cost of establishment and of conservancy requisites. Both in Jubbulpore and Saugor female sub-assistant surgeons are employed to visit labour cases in the hope of reducing infant mortality which as pointed out in last year's resolution is very high. The Damoh municipality was unable to secure the services of a female sub-assistant surgeon for the same purpose. The expenditure on hospitals and dispensaries fell from Rs. 1,35,000 to Rs. 1,29,000. Similarly plague charges fell from Rs. 83,000 to Rs. 42,000. Seoni was the victim of severe outbreaks of plague and relapsing fever. Chhindwara also suffered from influenza and plague. Other towns in the province were not subjected to any epidemic in a severe form. Rules under the Central Provinces Prevention of Adulteration Act (C. P. Act II of 1919) were framed and a commencement was made by the extension of the Act to the municipality of Nagpur.

13. Education.—The expenditure on education rose from Rs. 6,72,000 to Rs. 7,62,000 owing to the construction of new school buildings and the revision of the pay of establishment. During the last three months of the year "national schools" were opened at some places and the attendance at the municipal schools suffered in consequence; secondary schools seem to have been more affected by the non-co-operation movement than primary schools where the attendance remained unchanged. It is satisfactory to note a still further improvement in the primary school for the backward classes at Burhanpur both in the enrolment of pupils and average attendance. A new feature in the year's reports is the decision of the Amraoti Town municipal committee to impart religious education in Anglo-vernacular schools as a tentative measure.

14. Notified Areas.—The number of notified areas was reduced from 10 to 9 owing to the conversion of the Gondia notified area into a municipality. The total income and expenditure of the notified areas fell from Rs. 1,62,000 and Rs. 1,54,000 to Rs. 1,20,000 and Rs. 1,10,000, respectively. The expenditure of the Sindi notified area rose by Rs. 5,900, the additional amount being mainly spent on the construction of an English middle school building. An Anglo-vernacular school was opened at Etawah from the funds contributed by the local residents. The income of the Itarsi notified area has increased from Rs. 24,000 to Rs. 34,000 owing to the realisation of war bonds of the value of Rs. 12,000. The large surplus balances of the Itarsi and Pipariya notified areas are earmarked for surface drainage and the extension of primary school buildings, respectively. The Itarsi notified area has employed a paid Secretary who is also a qualified sub-assistant surgeon and it is hoped that some progress will now be shown in the sanitation of the town.

15. General.—An important feature of this year has been the transfer of the local self-government department to the charge of the Minister under the Reformed Government. A standing committee to advise the Government in respect of matters arising in the department was appointed during the year. The new municipal bill was introduced into the Legislative Council after the close of the year and has been referred to a select committee.

16. Notice of Services.—The relations between the municipal committees and officers of Government were as satisfactory as could be expected in a year in which political feeling ran exceptionally high; it is impossible to ignore the fact that in certain municipalities members have allowed their political views to influence them in the performance of their municipal duties. The impropriety of this has frequently been pointed out by the Hon'ble Minister. It is the policy of Government to make municipalities as independent as possible; steps have already been taken to reach this goal, and any reasonable proposals to liberalize laws, rules and standing orders will be sympathetically considered. But Municipal Commissioners are elected to perform certain well defined duties in the interests of their townspeople, and exercise certain powers entrusted to them by Government for this purpose. It is essential that so long as laws, rules and standing orders are in force, they should be strictly observed and if municipal committees

are to continue to perform their functions, they must act harmoniously with Government. His Excellency the Governor hopes that the Hon'ble Minister's instructions in this respect will be scrupulously observed in future. The reports bring to notice the names of several gentlemen who have rendered good service on municipal committees, and the thanks of the local Government will be conveyed to them separately.

ORDER—Ordered that a copy of this resolution be submitted to the Government of India in the Department of Education and Health; that copies be forwarded to the Commissioners and Deputy Commissioners for information and guidance; and that it be translated and circulated (through Deputy Commissioners) for the information and guidance of all municipal members.

Ordered also, that the resolution be published in the Supplement to the *Central Provinces Gazette*.
