READ—

Report on the working of the Agricultural Banks in the State during the year 1916-17, received with letter No. 2460, dated 16th October 1917, from the Registrar of Co-operative Societies and Inspector of Agricultural Banks.

Order No. 4873-84—L. & C. 138-17-3, dated 22nd November 1917.

Recorded.

2. During the year under report, the Bank at Nanjangud went into voluntary liquidation and with the approval of Government transferred its surplus funds to the Srikanteswara Advaita Sabha, Nanjangud.

3. The two working institutions during the year, *viz.*, the Bank at Palahalli in the Seringapatam Taluk and that at Hongenahalli in the Malur Taluk, had an aggregate membership of 75 and a reserve fund of Rs. 9,466-10-8.

4. The number of banks in arrears was 11. The amount due at the beginning of the year was Rs. 45,869-7-10, out of which Rs. 6,398-11-0 were collected during the year, leaving a balance of Rs. 39,470-12-10 outstanding on the 30th June 1917.

5. Separate action is being taken to make arrangements for collection of arrears and for the utilisation of surplus funds of the Banks.

SIR,

I have the honor to submit the Annual Report on the working of the Agricultural Banks in the State for the year ending 30th June 1917.

2. The office of the Inspector of Agricultural Banks was held by Mr. M. A. Narayan Ayangar throughout the year.

3. The Report is, as usual, based upon the data supplied by the Agents of the Working Banks and by the District Treasury Officers of the several districts.

4. The five statements which are appended to this report show the volume of business done by the working institutions and the total recoveries effected from the several Agricultural Banks in the State up to the end of the year under report.

5. *Working Banks.*—The year opened with three Working Banks, *viz.*, those situated at Palahalli, Hongenahalli and Nanjangud. All these Banks have paid their dues to Government in full. The Bank at Nanjangud went into voluntary liquidation during the year and it resolved upon transferring its surplus amount to the Srikanteswara Adwaitha Sabha Fund and the Government have since sanctioned the utilization of the amount in the manner proposed. The number of Working Banks was therefore reduced to two at the end of the year. The Bank at Hongenahalli is contemplating to close its affairs finally and to transfer its surplus amount to the local Co-operative Society.

6. *Receipts and Disbursements.*—Statement No. 3 shows the volume of business done by the two Agricultural Banks at Palahalli and Hongenahalli during the year under report. The total receipts and disbursements were Rs. 7,486-11-10 and Rs. 7,319-8-7 as against Rs. 9,109-0-6 and Rs. 6,197-4-4, respectively, in the previous year. The closing balances of these banks including the deposit in Savings Bank was Rs. 717-3-3 and Rs. 13-13-5.

7. *Loans to members.*—A sum of Rs. 5,350-8-0 was issued as loans to members during the year. But most of these loans are really in the nature of renewals.

8. *Assets and Liabilities.*—Statement No. 4 shows the financial position of the two Working Banks as it stood on 30th June 1917. The excess of assets over liabilities or surplus amounts at the credit of these Banks amounted to Rs. 9,466-10-8 as against Rs. 8,684-14-0 last year.

9. *Repayment of Instalments.*—The table given below shows the total amount of loans still outstanding against the defunct Banks, the total repayments made by them till the end of the year and the balance of instalments yet remaining unadjusted.

11. From the above, it will be seen that the collection work continues to be unsatisfactory. A brief review of the work in each district in this respect is given below:—

In the Bangalore District, only a small sum of Rs. 46-8-0 was recovered from the Closepet Bank, leaving still a balance of Rs. 969-0-0 outstanding against it. The two Banks in the Devanhalli Taluk, *viz.*, Aradesahalli and Vadigenahalli Banks have not paid anything towards the loan due to Government. The balances outstanding against these two Banks are Rs. 6,902-0-0 and Rs. 6,433-4-3, respectively. Unless some very stringent measures are adopted by the District and Taluk authorities, the Banks will continue defaulting for an indefinite period.

In the Kolar District a sum of Rs. 1,557 was recovered from the Bank at Muduvatti. The Subbenahalli Bank has repaid only Rs. 127-0-2 towards principal. The Bank has yet to pay a balance of Rs. 4,002 to Government. It is hoped that the Taluk authorities will interest themselves in this behalf and see that the Banks finally close their accounts with the Government at least during the current year.

In the Mysore District, the loan account of the Sargur Bank in the Heggaddevankote Taluk was finally closed during the year. The Banks at Chamrajnagar, French Rocks and Mandya are still in heavy arrears and unless some heavy pressure is brought to bear on them, they will go on defaulting indefinitely.

On a special representation made by the Deputy Commissioner, Mysore District, the Government granted one year's time to the Chamrajnagar Bank (*vide* Government Order No. 4562-3—A. and I. 46-15-7, dated 11th March 1916) as the Bank gave an assurance that the full amount due to Government would be repaid before December 1916. It is a matter for regret that the Bank did not act up to its promise, as nothing was paid by it during the year, beyond a small sum of Rs. 165-9-3 towards interest. It is very necessary that the Taluk authorities should institute coercive measures against the defaulting members of the Bank.

Out of the 11 Banks in the Tumkur District, 10 have completely discharged their loans. The Bank at Rampura has yet to pay a small sum of Rs. 1-0-7, which, it is hoped, will be recovered in the current year.

All the Banks in the Shimoga and Chitaldrug Districts have paid their debts in full.

As regards the Kadur District, the loan account of the Sakrepatna Bank was finally closed and the other Bank at Aradikuppe paid towards principal a sum of Rs. 465-4-5.

From the above, it will be seen that out of the 59 Banks, 48 have paid the Government loan in full and that the accounts of 11 Banks still remain to be adjusted during the current year. It is trusted that the revenue authorities will take more vigorous steps and collect all the amounts due to Government. The names of the Banks which have paid up their dues are noted hereunder.—

13. As mentioned in the reports of the previous years, there are some surplus amounts remaining in the Treasury to the credit of the several wound-up Banks. Three Banks, *viz.*, Nanjangud, Kyatasandra and Santebennur held general meetings and passed the necessary resolutions for their formal winding-up and for the utilization of their reserves for objects of local public utility in strict accordance with the Articles of Association which have been approved by Government. In all, 7 Agricultural Banks have till now been formally wound-up.

14. The only work that remains to be done in the case of the defunct institutions is the recovery of the Government dues and the final winding-up of the Banks thereafter, and the utilization of the surplus amounts for some purpose of local public utility. The work of recovery is now being done by the taluk revenue authorities and Government have already directed in Order No. 4740—A. and I. 52-14-2, dated 8th May 1915, that the district and taluk authorities should interest themselves and induce the members to convene general meetings to resolve upon a constitutional winding-up of the Banks. A special circular letter has also been issued from this office to the Deputy Commissioners to take the required steps for the final liquidation of the Banks, as desired by Government. It is, however, a matter for regret that these have not produced the desired effect.

15. There being little or no work to be done by the Inspector of Agricultural Banks in regard to the defunct Banks, a note proposing the abolition of the appointment of the Inspector of Agricultural Banks was submitted by Mr. M. A. Narayan Ayyangar for discussion at the meeting of Deputy Commissioners and select Heads of Departments held in June last. As the question has not been disposed of, I am submitting a separate reference for the orders of Government.

16. In addition to the 35 Co-operative Societies started up to the end of June 1916, in places where Agricultural Banks existed, 5 more societies were started during the year under report in the marginally noted places. They had a membership of 4,190 and their total transactions during the year amounted to Rs. 6,84,859.
