PREFACE

The instructions contained in this Manual apply both to the Central Provinces and Berar, but where difference in land tenures requires different procedure in each part of the Province, this has been indicated. The forms have been numbered I to XVII for the Central Provinces and A to M for Berar, the Berar letter with the word Berar being added in brackets after the Central Provinces numeral in the text wherever a prescribed form has reference to both parts of the Province. Where only a single numeral or letter is mentioned in the text, no corresponding form for the other part of the Province is necessary. The account forms, nos. XVIII to XXVI, are identical for both the Central Provinces and Berar and apply equally to both. No separate corresponding letter is therefore given for these forms for Berar.
