Is hereby given, that persons desirous of entering into a contract for supplying hammocks, bedding, portable soap &c. to the Commissariat department at the presidency for all purposes for which such articles may be required, for the term of two years from the first day of June next, may, on application at this office from 10 A. M. till 5 P. M. daily (Sundays excepted) obtain a list of prices and such other information relating thereto as they may require.

Verbal offers for the contract will be received at this office at 2 o'clock P. M. on Saturday the 15th proximo, when persons will be required to bid a per centage below the prices exhibited in the abovementioned list, on the understanding that the articles to be supplied under the contract are to be of unexceptionable quality, and delivered to the indenting departments in good condition, free of all further expences, in such number or quantity as may from time to time be demanded, and that the same will be liable to examination and rejection by a committee of officers appointed on the part of government.

The contractor will be required to sign and seal a contract stipulating to the above effect, and that he will comply immediately with all emergent demands for the articles included in the list above adverted to, and others of less urgency within the period stated in the requisitions made upon him, and that in failure thereof, the articles or such others as may be required in lieu may be purchased at his risk and loss, and that in all such cases an advance of Rupees (30) thirty per cent upon the amount of expences incurred, or a fine of Rupees (50) fifty at the option of the executive officer, may be levied as liquidated damages for each and every such breach of contract as often as the same may occur; and that the contract may also in all such cases be put an end to on the part of the East India Company.

No person will be allowed to bid for the contract unless he previously deposits in this office the sum of Rupees 200 two hundred in cash, which will be forfeited in the event of delay, evasion or refusal to execute the necessary deed of contract; should his offer be accepted, he must be prepared to add thereto a further sum of Rupees 216 two hundred and sixteen in cash, making in all Rupees 416 four hundred and sixteen, and unexceptionable bonded security to the extent of Rupees 1667 sixteen hundred and sixty-seven, to be held by government as security for the due performance of his contract.

The annual outlay on account of the above contract is estimated at Rupees 8337 or thereabouts. All further particulars will be communicated at the time of bidding and no reason will be assigned for the rejection of any offer.

The following Act is passed by the Hon'ble the President of the Council of India in Council on the

10th April 1847, with the assent of the Right Honorable the Governor General of India, which has been read and recorded.

Ordered, that the Act be promulgated for general information.

ACT NO. IV. OF 1847.

An Act to authorize the Governor in Council of Fort St. George to appoint any Military Officer a Magistrate.

It is hereby enacted, that from and after the First day of May 1847, it shall be competent to the Governor in Council of Fort St. George to appoint any Military Officer in the service of the East India Company, a Magistrate or an Assistant Magistrate in one or more Zillahs, and to confer on any Assistant Magistrate, by a special order, any of the powers of a Magistrate, any Law or Regulation to the contrary notwithstanding.

The following Act is passed by the Hon'ble the President of the Council of India in Council on the 10th April 1847, with the assent of the Right Honorable the Governor General of India, which has been read and recorded.

Ordered, that the Act be promulgated for general information.

ACT NO. V. OF 1847.

An Act to facilitate the execution of the sentences of Courts established by the authority of the Governor General in Council for the administration of Criminal Justice in States or Territories administered by Officers acting under the authority of the East India Company.

I. It is hereby enacted, that within the Territories subject to the Government of the East India Company and without the local limits of the jurisdiction of Her Majesty's Courts of Judicature, the several Officers in charge of Jails shall be competent to give effect to any sentence that may be passed by any Court established or that may be

established by the authority of the Governor General of India in Council for the administration of Criminal Justice in States or Territories administered by Officers acting under the authority of the East India Company, although such States or Territories are not subject to the Government of any one of the Presidencies of Fort William in Bengal, Fort St. George or Bombay, or are not subject to the operation of the General Regulations.

II. And it is hereby enacted, that a warrant under the official Seal and Signature of the Officer or Officers exercising Criminal jurisdiction within such States or Territories as aforesaid shall be sufficient authority for holding any prisoner in confinement or for transmitting any prisoner for transportation beyond Sea, or for inflicting any other punishment prescribed therein.

III. And it is hereby enacted, that if any Officer in charge of a Jail shall entertain any doubt as to the legality of any warrant sent to him for execution under this Act, or as to the competency of the person or persons whose Official Seal and Signature may be affixed thereto to pass the sentence and issue such warrant, such Officer shall refer the matter to the Government to which he is subject, by whose order on the case such Officer and all other public Officers shall be guided as to the future disposal of the prisoner, and that pending any such reference, the prisoner shall be detained in custody in such manner and with such restrictions or mitigations as may be specified in the warrant.

IV. And it is hereby enacted, that the provisions of the existing Acts and Regulations, and all other rules in force for the treatment and security of prisoners confined in the said jails, shall apply and be of equal force and effect in the case of prisoners confined therein under this Act as in the case of other prisoners confined therein.
