ACT PASSED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF BOMBAY.

The following Act of the Governor of Bombay in Council received the assent of the Right Honorable the Governor on the 11th October 1867, and the assent of His Excellency the Governor General on the 25th October 1867, and is published for general information:—

BOMBAY.

Act No. V. of 1867.

An Act to amend the Schedule annexed to Act No. XII. of 1866 (Bombay).

WHEREAS certain persons are privileged by Section XV. of Act No. XII. of 1866 (Bombay) in respect of the execution of decrees passed against them, and it is expedient to extend the same privilege to certain

Preamble.

Ladies of rank in the Province of Sind; It is enacted as follows:—

I. The Schedule annexed to (Bombay) Act No. XII. of 1866 (to declare the constitution of Courts of Civil and Criminal Judicature in the Province of Sind) is repealed; and the Schedule annexed to this Act shall be taken to be and shall be the Schedule to which reference is made in Section XV. of the said Act No. XII. of 1866 (Bombay).
