Conybeare in 1879, the district of Pilibhit did not exist as a separate charge, and the area then formed part of Bareilly. This fact necessitated the compilation of a new volume, for which some material was available in the old Settlement Reports and the Bareilly Gazetteer and also in the report of the recent revision of assessment in the Bisalpur tahsil by Mr. J. C. Fergusson. I had further the advantage of notes prepared by Pandit Bhawani Datt, Deputy Collector, and much other information supplied by Mr. G. Whittle, who has rendered me additional assistance by reading the proofs.
