APPENDIX.

Note to supplement, correct and enlarge the information contained in the A Volume, Gazetteer of the Balaghat district.

A narrow gauge line from Balaghat to Katangi, 29 miles in length, has now been constructed and has been opened for traffic from 26th May 1913. It has a long siding running to Ramrama, which will tap the manganese mines there. The grain which now goes south by cart to Gondia and Tumsar will be carried by this line. Waraseoni and Katangi, which already have important markets, may be expected to develop rapidly.

A submerged bridge over the Wainganga river at Garraghat close to the Railway bridge is now under construction at an estimated cost of Rs. 56,407. At present the river can only be crossed by means of boats in the rainy season and early part of the winter, and by means of a temporary bridge during the rest of the year.

The new bridge, which is expected to be passable at all times, except for a few days of flood, will probably increase the importance of Balaghat as a market town.

The Wainganga canal is now under construction at an estimated cost of Rs. 43,32,354, with head-works at Dhuti. This canal is expected to irrigate annually 59,000 acres of autumn crops and 21,000 acres of spring crops and will protect agriculturists from the effects of short and irregular rainfall. On its completion a flood famine such as was experienced in the nineties will not be possible. A great extension of cultivation of sugarcane and of valuable garden crop is to be expected.

In the years 1909—11 the settlement of the Baihar Ryotwari villages was revised by the Deputy Commissioner acting as Settlement Officer. Including the Thekadari villages there were then 258 villages in the Ryotwari Estate.

The agricultural land was for the first time classified and rents were assessed on a basis of the comparative net profits of different classes of land.

The revenue of the estate was raised from Rs. 25,350 to Rs. 44,195, or by 74 per cent. This large enhancement was rendered possible only by the use of a system of progressive enhancements of revenue.

Excise:

Country Spirit.—The Sadar Distillery and outstill systems have now (1916) been completely abolished, and since 1911 the whole district has been under the Contract Supply system. Liquor is supplied at a fixed rate (at present $13\frac{1}{2}$ annas per proof gallon) by contractors at Seoni through warehouses at Balaghat and Baihar. Licences for the retail sale of liquor are sold annually by auction, and in addition to the auction fee, the licensees are required to pay the cost price and the Government duty which ranges from fifteen annas to Rs. 4-1-0 per proof gallon in different parts of the district.

Since 1907-08 the number of retail shops has been reduced from 268 to 119. Liquor is issued at two strengths, *vis.*, 25 and 60 degrees under proof, known as *dubara* and *rasi* respectively, but the latter and lower strength is by far the most in demand.

Opium.—The issue price of opium is now Rs. 35 per seer.

The number of retail shops is 34.

Ganja.—The number of retail shops is now 41.
