## PREFACE.

**T**his catalogue contains a list of only such goods as have been received for exhibition in the Commercial Museum. It should not therefore be regarded as by any means an exhaustive list of articles that are manufactured in India. The catalogue will be revised periodically, and samples that have not been received in time for the press will be included in the next edition which will be issued in April 1916.

It is necessary to emphasise the fact that the prices quoted by manufacturers are approximate and are subject to fluctuations of the market. Exhibitors are requested to advise the Director-General of Commercial Intelligence of any alterations in the printed quotations.

Samples of some of the principal qualities of goods which are largely imported into the Calcutta market are also exhibited in the Commercial Museum with a view to demonstrating the class of goods, with their respective prices, with which Indian manufacturers have to compete. These samples have been included in the catalogue, and it is intended that they should be supplemented and as far as possible kept up to date.

The co-operation of manufacturers and traders interested in Indian manufactures is requested, and useful suggestions to further the interests of the Commercial Museum will be welcomed.
