READ—

The Reports from the Commissioner in Sind and the Commissioners of Divisions on the administration of the Local Boards in the Bombay Presidency during the year 1905-1906.

RESOLUTION.—In the year under review the number of District and Taluka Local Boards (234) remained unchanged.

2. The area and population of the Boards in the Presidency proper remained unaltered. In Sind the inclusion of the area of the Mithi Municipality which was abolished during the year and the exclusion of the population within Jacobabad Municipal limits account for the variations in area and population.

3. Triennial elections were held in the Presidency proper in the districts of Poona, Kaira and Broach. In the last district the election of members was altogether uncontested. There was no change in the constitution of the Boards in the Southern Division and Sind.

4. In the Presidency proper 912 meetings were held during the year as against 847 in the previous year, 40 being adjourned for want of a quorum. The rule as regards half-yearly meetings was complied with by all District Local Boards in the Southern and Central Divisions, except that of Sátára. No information on this point has been furnished in respect of that district and the districts in the Northern Division. In Sind the presence of plague in Karáchi prevented the District Local Board from holding two meetings during the year. In the Northern Division the prescribed number of four meetings was not held by seven Taluka Boards; but it is explained that the actual number of meetings held was found sufficient for the transaction of business. In the Southern Division four Taluka Boards failed to hold the prescribed number of meetings. The Commissioner has taken measures to ensure the future observance of standing orders. In the Northern Division and Sind the provisions of section 34 of the District Municipal Act were made use of whenever necessary by circulation of papers among the members. There was no improvement in the average attendance of members in the Presidency proper; and in Sind a falling off was noticeable in the Lárkána and Upper Sind Frontier Districts.

5. The total income of the Boards increased from Rs. 43,84,296 in the previous year to Rs. 56,85,096 in the year under review.

The following statement compares the receipts under the principal heads of revenue with those of the preceding year:—

The principal variations are explained below.

6. *Provincial Rates.*—The net increase under this head amounts to Rs. 2,65,713 and is shared in by all Divisions except the Southern. In the Northern and Central Divisions the increase is generally ascribed to the large

recovery of arrears suspended on account of the poor season in the preceding year. In Sind the increase is due to a general extension of cultivation consequent on a favourable inundation. In the Southern Division there was a decrease of Rs. 1,47,382 which occurred in all districts, notably in Belgaum, Bijápur and Dhárwár where famine conditions prevailed during the year and necessitated large suspensions and remissions of Land Revenue.

7. *Police*.—The increase of Rs. 5,334 under this head is due to large realizations under the Cattle Trespass Act in the districts of Belgaum and Bijápur in the Southern Division and in all the districts of the Northern Division except Ahmedabad. In Sind there was an increase of Rs. 1,301, which is attributed to closer supervision over existing pounds and the opening of new ones, and to the fact that a large number of cattle were brought down from Khelat into the Upper Sind Frontier District for grazing.

8. *Education*.—In the Southern and Northern Divisions there was a large increase in the receipts from school fees, which was due mainly to the opening of new Local Board Schools and the larger attendance of pupils consequent on the gradual abatement of plague. In the Central Division there was an increase of Rs. 11,878 under this head, more than half of which occurred in the Khándesh District and is attributed to larger receipts from School fees and to local popular contributions. The same reasons account for the increase of Rs. 2,301 in Sind.

9. *Scientific and other minor Departments*.—The decline under this head in the Northern Division is nominal and is accounted for by the fact that the figures of the preceding year were swelled by the inclusion for the first time of the Veterinary Dispensary Funds in the Local Fund Accounts. In Sind the revenue decreased by about Rs. 1,400 owing to smaller receipts from botanical gardens, which suffered from the severe frost last winter.

10. *Miscellaneous*.—Under this head there was an increase of Rs. 3,304, shared in by all Divisions including Sind. The items included under it are of a fluctuating nature and call for no remarks.

11. *Civil Works*.—The income under this head is mainly derived from (a) tolls on roads and ferries and (b) popular contributions. As regards (a) the net increase of Rs. 14,494 in the Central Division was due to larger toll-receipts in the Khándesh, Násik and Sátára Districts. The increase (Rs. 10,921) was largest in the first mentioned district and is ascribed to heavier imports of cotton from the neighbouring Native States. In Ahmednagar and Poona there were considerable decreases, in the former due to less competition among bidders on account of successive bad seasons, and in the latter partly to outstandings remaining to be recovered from the toll-farmers. In the Southern Division there was a net decrease of about Rs. 1,000, which is attributed to the fact that owing to the unfavourable character of the previous season smaller bids were received for the farms in the districts of Bijápur, Dhárwár and Ratnágiri. In the Northern Division the increase of Rs. 18,711 is due to the enhancement of toll-receipts in the districts of Kaira, Broach, Surat and Thána caused by a favourable season. In the last-named district the revenue was also increased by the recovery of the instalment of Rs. 3,184, which was outstanding at the close of the previous year. In Sind the increase was due to larger receipts from the sale of trees in the Lárkána District and of lac and babul pods in the Hyderabad District. The large decrease noticeable in the Sukkur District is due to the fact that the previous year's figures were swelled by the sale receipts (Rs. 9,900) of two old ferry steamers. In popular contributions there was an increase of Rs. 4,725 in the Southern Division, large sums having been received in the districts of Kánara and Belgaum for the improvement of roads and water-supply. Similar contributions account also for the increases noticeable in the Northern Division and Sind.

12. Contributions from Provincial to Local increased by Rs. 9,59,566. This large increase is shared in by all Divisions and is due chiefly to the special grants given by Government towards the cost of primary education and for the improvement of communications and village water-supply. The Ahmedabad District Board received a grant of Rs. 3,333 for additions and alterations to the Veterinary Hospital, Ahmedabad, and the Dhárwár Board received Rs. 4,177

for the construction of a Veterinary Dispensary at Dhárwár. The districts of Ahmedabad, Kaira, Surat and Thána also received from Government grants aggregating Rs. 15,100 for certain roads which have been provincialised. In the last-named district Rs. 9,000 were received in excess of last year's receipts from quarrying fees.

13. *Debt.*—The decrease of Rs. 1,386 in the Central Division was confined to the Khándesh and Násik Districts only and is ascribed in general to fewer sales of promissory notes belonging to Dispensary Funds having taken place during the year.

14. The incidence of income per head of population increased from 6 annas 2 pies to 6 annas 9 pies and that of taxation from 2 annas 2 pies to 3 annas 1 pie.

15. The total expenditure of the Boards amounted to Rs. 54,11,328 as against Rs. 46,89,024 in the previous year, showing an increase of Rs. 7,22,304. The following statement shows the distribution of the expenditure under the various heads as compared with that of the previous year :—

The important variations in the above figures are noted below.

16. *Administration.*—The small fluctuations under this head do not need special mention.

17. *Education.*—Under this head there was an increase of nearly Rs. 1,23,000 which is shared in by all Divisions. The cause of increase is the utilization of the enhanced grants made by Government in furtherance of primary education. Many new schools were opened and the teaching staff was strengthened and improved in almost all districts. The Fly-shuttle Loom Class at Bijápur referred to in the last year's report was closed in the year under review as it did not seem to progress satisfactorily. It is under contemplation to make it over to the proposed Municipal Technical School there. The four carpentry classes attached to primary schools in the Bijápur District are reported to be making steady progress. Some information should have been given as regards the state of the six carpentry classes in the Belgaum District. In Kánara two carpentry classes were opened for the first time at Bankikodla and Ankola. Government agree with the Commissioner that Mr. Panse has done a service to the school-going youth of the above-ghát talukas of Kánara by arranging for a free distribution of quinine through the school-masters to boys suffering from malaria which is endemic there.

18. *Medical.*—The increase of Rs. 13,473 under this head was general in all Divisions. In the Central Division the increase of Rs. 4,160 was contributed to by the Khándesh, Násik, Poona and Sátára Districts and was due to increased expenditure on medicines, vaccination and Local Board Dispensary establishments. In the Northern Division nearly one-half of the excess of Rs. 3,418 was contributed to by the Panch Maháls, in which district there was an increased expenditure on account of contingencies, including medicines. In Sind the increase is accounted for partly by the contribution by the Karáchi Board towards

the cost of a lady doctor for the Jaffer Fadoo Dispensary in Karáchi, and partly by the increased expenditure on the Mithi Dispensary. The rise under sanitation charges in Sind is due to lighting, conservancy establishment and clearance of jungles in the Lárkána and Upper Sind Frontier Districts.

19. *Scientific and other minor Departments.*—There was an increase of Rs. 1,879 in the Northern Division due principally to the raising of the annual grant towards the cost of the Horse-show at Ahmedabad from Rs. 500 to Rs. 1,000, the increase in the number of Government stallions located in that District and the improvement in the Veterinary establishments in the Kaira and Thána Districts. In Sind the increase of Rs. 6,590 under the head is due to the maintenance of gardens and garden establishments generally throughout the province.

20. *Stationery and Printing.*—Under this head there was a decrease of nearly Rs. 9,000, which was specially noticeable in the Central and Southern Divisions, and was principally due to the fact that no printing work in connection with Local Boards elections was necessary during the year under review.

21. *Miscellaneous.*—The Násik District Board had to refund in the preceding year the unspent balance of the grant from Provincial to Local Funds for the improvement of ghát communications. The absence of such a transaction during the year under review accounts for the decrease of Rs. 4,661 in the Central Division. The excess of Rs. 573 in the Northern Division was the result in a great measure of an increase of Rs. 2,554 in Broach and a decrease of Rs. 1,316 in the Panch Maháls. The fluctuation in Broach is explained by the grant of larger donations for charitable purposes and that in the Panch Máhals by the fact that last year two new fire engines costing Rs. 1,358 were purchased, whereas in the period under review no such expenditure was incurred. In the Southern Division the increase (Rs. 2,003) is chiefly observable in Bijápur and was apparently due to refunds of popular contributions for works which could not be carried out by the Board.

22. *Civil Works.*—Owing to the liberal grants made by Government this head shows a net increase of about Rs. 5,51,000, which was distributed more or less equally over all the Divisions including Sind. The aggregate charge represents 54 per cent. of the total expenditure of the Boards as against 50 per cent. in the preceding year. The following statement compares the charges under the various sub-heads with those of the preceding year :—

As usual the largest expenditure was incurred on communications. In the Northern Division the increased outlay amounted to nearly one lakh and was most opportune in view of the damage done to existing roads in the Gujarát Districts by the heavy rains in 1905. Among the roads in Gujarát which absorbed large amounts from the Government grant may be mentioned the Mátar-Cambay road in the Kaira District (Rs. 15,500), the Broach-Jambusar road in the Broach District (Rs. 14,600), and the Ichhápur-Suváli road in the Surat District (Rs. 11,200). The Thána District Boards utilised the greater

portion of their share of the Government grant on forest roads, but they were otherwise in a position to spend Rs. 53,200 on roads of general utility, the chief among these being the Gokhiwa-Vajreshwar road and the Bhynder-Káshi Mira road. In the Southern Division the greater part (64 per cent.) of the outlay on Civil Works was devoted to the construction and maintenance of roads. In the Central Division 27 new roads were constructed, and in Sind the number and mileage of the roads constructed was 15 and 81 respectively.

In the Northern Division the bulk of the increase of Rs. 17,964 under "Original Buildings" is to be found in the Surat District where Rs. 13,756 were spent in excess of the previous year's amount.

The expenditure on water-works and water-supply also shows an increase of Rs. 1,15,138. In the Southern Division there was a rise of Rs. 34,530, which is distributed between all the districts. Large amounts were spent in Bijápur (Rs. 25,392) and Dhárwár (Rs. 31,603), where the expenditure was doubly useful in that it improved the water-supply and provided labour to the needy in a year of famine. In the Northern Division and Sind there was an increase on this account in all districts, except Ahmedabad in the former and Upper Sind Frontier in the latter. The total amount spent on water-supply in the Central Division was Rs. 1,26,858.

In the Central and Northern Divisions and in Sind, new school-houses, dispensaries, Dharamshálas, wells, tanks, and inspection bungalows were constructed.

The amounts expended on public works carried out by the Local Boards Establishments was Rs. 13,77,650 against Rs. 11,70,746; while the amount expended on works executed through the agency of the Public Works Department was Rs. 15,11,362 against Rs. 11,68,372 in the preceding year.

23. *Contributions.*—There was an increase of nearly Rs. 41,000 under this head in all Divisions, of which the Northern Division alone is responsible for about Rs. 32,000 and the Central Division for about Rs. 5,500. In Thána, Rs. 16,000 were contributed by the District Local Board for the construction of forest roads, and in Kaira extra contributions amounting in the aggregate to Rs. 15,758 were made for public works. In the Sholápur District the increase was due to the payment of the first instalment of Local Fund contribution towards the Victoria Memorial Market and also to a special contribution towards the construction of a Veterinary Dispensary at Sholápur. The increased expenditure in Násik was due to larger contributions being made towards Military Public Works; in Ahmednagar to Rs. 2,114 being transferred to Provincial Funds towards Cháwdi construction in excess of the sum so transferred in the preceding year; and in Poona to the contribution of Rs. 1,500 to the furnishing fund of the Sassoon General Hospital.

24. *Debt.*—In the Southern Division the total expenditure of Rs. 9,772 under "debt and interest on debt" represents the payment by the Dhárwár Board of the half yearly instalments in liquidation of the debt contracted in 1895.

25. The closing balances of the Board in the Presidency amounted to Rs. 20,97,019 against Rs. 18,43,788 in the preceding year. The increase has taken place in the whole Presidency, including Sind. In all districts except Belgaum, Bijápur, Dhárwár, Ahmednagar, Sátára and Sholápur, the balances are much in excess of the prescribed minima. The large balances in the Kaira and Broach Districts are due to the recoveries at the close of the year of considerable arrears of the previous year. As in the previous year, there was again a heavy accumulation in Khándesh; but steps are being taken to reduce it. In the other districts also, measures have been or are being taken to utilise the balances. The Commissioner, Southern Division, should be requested to communicate to the Collector of Kolába the remarks made in paragraph 28 of his report, if that has not already been done. The balances of Dhárwár, Ahmednagar, Sholápur and Sátára fell considerably short of their prescribed minima. The balances in Ahmednagar and Sholápur were adversely affected by large expenditure and still more by an unfavourable season, which reduced the

receipts from the one anna cess. The balance in Sātāra, however, shows considerable improvement over that of the previous year, which is due to the special grant received from Government.

26. The administration of the Local Boards has on the whole been satisfactory. The year under report was fairly prosperous and although in some districts owing to an unfavourable season the receipts from the one-anna cess were reduced, the Boards were enabled with the grants made by Government to adopt measures for the extension of primary education and to undertake several much-needed improvements in the means of communication and in water-supply. The provincialization of some of the roads in the Presidency proper will, it is hoped, give a substantial relief to the Boards concerned and enable them to open up new and important roads. The district officers complain that the non-official members are generally apathetic and that the brunt of the Board's work falls upon the officials. Government trust that Village Work Committees have been constituted in all districts on the lines indicated in Government Resolution No. 2870, dated the 19th May 1898.

27. Copies of this Resolution should be submitted to the Secretary of State and the Government of India, and should be forwarded to all Commissioners and Collectors and other Officers and Departments as usual.
