NORTH-WEST FRONTIER AGENCY.

Correspondence with Government, 1840-1845.

- 1. The records of which this is a Press List are contained in Books 83—91, 126—136 and 149—169. The receipts and issues are filed separately in the books enumerated, but in the Press List they have been combined and arranged chronologically.
- 2. In April 1840 Mr. G. Clerk, Political Agent, Ambála, was appointed, in addition to his other duties, to the charge of the relations of the British Government with that of Lahore in succession to Lieutenant-Colonel Sir C. M. Wade transferred to Indore. It was arranged that in matters relating to the affairs of the Punjab and the Court of Lahore Mr. Clerk was to correspond direct with the Government of India, while the control of the Sikh Principalities cis Sutlej was vested in the Government of the North-Western Provinces instead of the Agent, Governor-General, Delhi. Mr. Clerk's official designation was Agent, Governor-General, for the Affairs of the Punjab and later Agent, Governor-General, North-West Frontier.
- 3. In October 1842 the control within the Protected and Lapsed Sikh States and over the Subáthu Agency was transferred from the Agent to the Lieutenant-Governor, North-Western Provinces, Delhi, to the Agent, Governor-General, North-West Frontier. It was arranged that the whole Province formed out of the escheated Sikh States should be divided into the districts of Ambála, and Ludhiána including Ferozepore, and being incorporated with the Hill States under the Subáthu Agency should be treated as one jurisdiction, being presided over by a Sub-Commissioner subordinate to the Agent, Governor-General.
- 4. Mr. Clerk was appointed Envoy to the Court of Lahore in October 1842 and held that office until June 1843, when as Sir G. R. Clerk, K.C.B., he was appointed Lieutenant-Governor of the North-Western Provinces. The office of Envoy to the Court of Lahore ceased on Sir G. Clerk's transfer, and Mr. H. H. Greathed, an Assistant in the North-West Frontier Agency, conducted the duties of Agent to the Governor-General, North-West Frontier, from the 12th to the 21st of June 1843, on which date he was relieved by Lieutenant-Colonel A. F. Richmond, C.B. Colonel Richmond was in turn relieved on the 1st November 1844 by Major G. Broadfoot, C.B., who held charge until he was killed in December 1845 at the battle of Ferozeshah.
