### Prefatory Note.

THE years 1864—1868 contained in this volume, are full of interest to the student. The Punjab Government develops from a simple and highly centralized organism into one of many and complicated functions. In the earlier volume we have seen the commencement of this. In the present volume the process is carried further. It is a process which never ceases as it is closely associated with the life and growth of the State. Our own generation has seen many new innovations and sub-divisions in this connection and the end is not yet. The new departures, which are now regularly established as part of our official system, and which date from this period, are the following:—

The Registrar of Joint Stock Companies is first heard of in 1867 and is in full activity in the summer of 1868.

The Chemical Examiner begins his labours in 1867 when a very exhaustive analysis of the potable water in the various stations was undertaken.

Another department of Public Health to be initiated was Sanitation; Dr. DeRenzy, the first Sanitary Commissioner being appointed in 1868. The newly organized Medical School produced its first batch of licenciates during this period.

Municipalities spring up all over the Province during this period as do Dispensaries: the latter at a very rapid rate.

On January 10th, 1868 the first Punjab Census was taken, elaborate preparation for it having occupied the whole of 1867.

The Public Works Department was comparatively new as a separate institution, but it was already necessary to differentiate its functions, and the Irrigation Branch became a separate unit in 1867.

To 1868 belongs the initiation of a Gazetteer for the Punjab, Messrs. L. Griffin and Baden Powell being put on special duty for the purpose in that year.

In the same year we get the first attempt to preserve ancient monuments, as the various district officers are ordered to report on any such with a view to their proper repair and preservation.

In 1867 the financial year was changed to its present duration and made to end on March 31st.

To turn to matters outside the province. In 1863 the Punjab sent a wedding present on the occasion of the marriage of the Prince and Princess of Wales. In 1867 the province took an active interest in the Paris Exhibition of that year—the last great pageant of the doomed Second Empire. In the same year there was brisk recruiting of muleteers and followers for the Abyssinian War.

Finally, in 1868 an attempt to assassinate the Duke of Edinburgh in Australia gave the province an opportunity of demonstrating its loyalty by an address to Queen Victoria.
