OF

ACTS PASSED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF INDIA IN COUNCIL, IN THE YEAR 1865.

- Act No. I. An Act to authorize the extension of certain Acts and Regulations to Territories not subject to the General Regulations.
- II. to provide for the maintenance of the Rural Police in the Territories under the government of the Lieutenant-Governor of the North-Western Provinces and elsewhere.
- III. relating to the rights and liabilities of Common Carriers.
- IV. to exempt the estates of deceased Officers and Soldiers delivered over to the Administrator General of Bengal, Madras, or Bombay, from the operation of the twenty-sixth Section of Act No. VIII of 1855.
- V. to provide for the solemnization of Marriages in India of persons professing the Christian Religion.
- VI. to continue Act No. XXXI of 1860 (relating to the manufacture, importation, and sale of Arms and Ammunition, and for regulating the right to keep and use the same, and to give power of disarming in certain cases).
- VII. to give effect to Rules for the management and preservation of Government Forests.
- VIII. to make valid the imprisonment of certain persons arrested under the process of the High Court of Judicature at Fort William in Bengal, in the exercise of its ordinary original Civil jurisdiction.
- IX. to amend Act No. XVI of 1864 (to provide for the Registration of Assurances),
- X. to amend and define the Law of Intestate and Testamentary Succession in British India.
- XI. to consolidate and amend the Law relating to Courts of Small Causes beyond the local limits of the ordinary original Civil jurisdiction of the High Courts of Judicature.
- XII. to amend the Law relating to the custody of prisoners within the local limits of the original jurisdiction of Her Majesty's High Court of Judicature at Fort William in Bengal.
- XIII. to amend the procedure of Her Majesty's High Courts of Judicature in the exercise of their original Criminal jurisdiction, and to provide for the exercise of such jurisdiction at places other than the Presidency Towns.

- Act No. XIV. An Act to define the jurisdiction of the Courts of Civil Judicature in the Central Provinces.
- XV. to define and amend the Law relating to Marriage and Divorce among the Parsees.
 - XVI. to remove doubts as to the jurisdiction of the Revenue Courts in the Province of Oude in suits relating to land, and to enlarge the period of limitation in such suits.
 - XVII. ✓ to amend certain Acts relating to the duties of Customs on goods imported and exported by Sea.
 - XVIII. ✓ to amend Act No. X of 1862 (to consolidate and amend the Law relating to Stamp Duties);
 - XIX. to define the jurisdiction of the Courts of Judicature of the Punjab and its Dependencies.
 - XX. to amend the Law relating to Pleaders and Mookhtárs.
 - XXI. to define and amend the Law relating to Intestate Succession among the Parsees.
 - XXII. to amend Act No. XVIII of 1864 (to provide for the appointment of a Municipal Committee for the City of Lucknow).
 - XXIII. to amend the constitution of the Chief Court of Judicature in the Punjab and its Dependencies.
 - XXIV. to give effect to certain Warrants of Attorney and Cognovits.
 - XXV. to amend the Law relating to the duties of Customs on goods imported and exported by Sea.
 - XXVI. to amend Act XXIX of 1861 (to consolidate and amend the Articles of War for the government of the Native Officers and Soldiers in Her Majesty's Indian Army).
 - XXVII. to make temporary provision for the decision of Civil Appeals in the Districts within the Lieutenant-Governorship of the Punjab.
 - XXVIII. to provide for the more speedy liquidation of Insolvent Traders' Estates in Bombay.
 - XXIX. to amend the Pleaders, Mookhtárs, and Revenue Agents' Act, 1865.
 - XXX. to define and sanction the rates which the Madras Irrigation and Canal Company is authorized to charge for the supply of water for purposes other than that of Irrigation.
