**TITLES**

**ACTS PASSED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF INDIA IN COUNCIL,**  
IN THE YEAR 1864.

Act No.	I.	An Act to bring the Jagheers of Poorwah and Khuddee, in the District of Banda, under the operation of the General Regulations.
—	II.	to provide for the administration of Civil and Criminal Justice at Aden.
—	III.	to give the Government certain powers with respect to Foreigners.
—	IV.	to give validity to certain proceedings of the Court of Small Causes of Kurrachee.
—	V.	to give validity to the extension of the Code of Civil Procedure to the Province of Scinde from the first day of January 1862.
—	VI.	to authorize the punishment of whipping in certain cases.
—	VII.	for regulating the importation and manufacture of alimentary Salt in the Territories administered by the Chief Commissioner of the Central Provinces.
—	VIII.	to enable the "Comptoir D'Escompte of Paris" to sue and be sued in the name of the Chief Manager of the Indian Agencies of the said Company.
—	IX.	to repeal Act VIII of 1861 (for the levy of Port-dues in the Port of Amherst).
—	X.	to extend Act XXI of 1856 (to consolidate and amend the Law relating to the Abkaree Revenue in the Presidency of Fort William in Bengal).
—	XI.	to repeal the Laws relating to the Offices of Hindoo and Mahomedan Law Officers, and to the Offices of Cazeer-ool-Cozaat and of Cazeer; and to abolish the former Offices.
—	XII.	to give further effect to the provisions of Act IV of 1863 (to give effect to certain provisions of a Treaty between His Excellency the Earl of Elgin and Kincardine, Viceroy and Governor-General of India, and His Majesty the King of Burmah).
—	XIII.	to consolidate and amend the Laws relating to the Emigration of Native Laborers.

- Act No. XIV. to give validity to certain acts and proceedings of the Joint Judge of the Konkan.
- XV. ✓ to amend Act VIII of 1851 (for enabling Government to levy Tolls on Public Roads and Bridges).
- XVI. to provide for the Registration of Assurances.
- XVII. to constitute an Office of Official Trustee.
- XVIII. to provide for the appointment of a Municipal Committee for the City of Lucknow.
- XIX. to remove certain tracts of Country in the District of Mirzapore from the jurisdiction of the local Courts.
- XX. for making better provision for the care of the persons and property of Minors in the Presidency of Bombay.
- XXI. for the extension of the jurisdiction of the Magistrates of Police in Calcutta.
- XXII. to make provision for the administration of Military Cantonments.
- XXIII. ✓ to amend the law relating to the Customs Duties on goods imported by Sea.
- XXIV. relating to the administration of certain Districts under the Government of the Lieutenant-Governor of the North-Western Provinces.
- XXV. to provide further for the solemnization of Marriages in India of persons professing the Christian Religion.
- XXVI. to extend the jurisdiction of the Courts of Small Causes at Calcutta, Madras, and Bombay, and to provide for the appointment of an increased number of Judges of those Courts.
- XXVII. to substitute certain declarations for the oaths of qualification taken by Justices of the Peace.
- XXVIII. ✓ to provide for the extension of Act XXI of 1856 and amend the law relating to the Abkaree (Presidency of Fort William in Bengal) to the control of the Lieutenant-Governor of the Pr.
