PREFACE.

Towards the end of January, 1930, the Triplicane Urban Co-operative Society, Ltd., celebrated its Silver Jubilee both at the Headquarters as well as at the several Branches. A very interesting and varied programme had been drawn up by the Jubilee Celebration Committee and it was carried out with great success. At one of their first meetings the Celebration Committee unanimously resolved to publish a Souvenir Volume in commemoration of the unique event and the present publication is the outcome of that resolution.
