PREFACE.

In Volume II of the series of studies on *Wages, Cost of Living and National Income in Sweden 1860—1930* are published the results of the investigations into *Wages in Sweden 1860—1930*, carried on at the Institute for Social Sciences in the University of Stockholm. The volume is published in two parts of which Part Two is contained in the present publication.

The general method of cooperation in producing the studies included in this series has already been explained in the preface to Part One. Among the authors of Volume II Mr Svenilsson is responsible for the final shape and content of the present publication. Chapter XIV forms a rearrangement of a volume on wages and working conditions in municipal works in Sweden 1865—1930 published by me in Swedish (*Kommunalarbetarnas löner i Sverige 1865—1930*, Stockholm 1933, 344 pages). The text and tables on agriculture in the period 1860—1914 (Chapters XVI—XVIII and parts of Chapters XXI and XXVII) have been prepared by Mr Bengt Helger; Chapters XIX—XXVII, with the above exceptions, by Mr Svenilsson. Miss Maj Ahlberg has seen the book through the press.
