PREFACE.





On many occasions the lack of a general survey of the position of the Northern Countries in World Economy was felt. Subsequently, the Delegations established an Editorial Committee to prepare such a survey, and as a result of their work this book is now published.

The present publication deals not only with the common economic problems of the Countries of the North and with cooperation between them; it is also in itself a manifestation of the spirit of co-operation among the Northern Nations.
