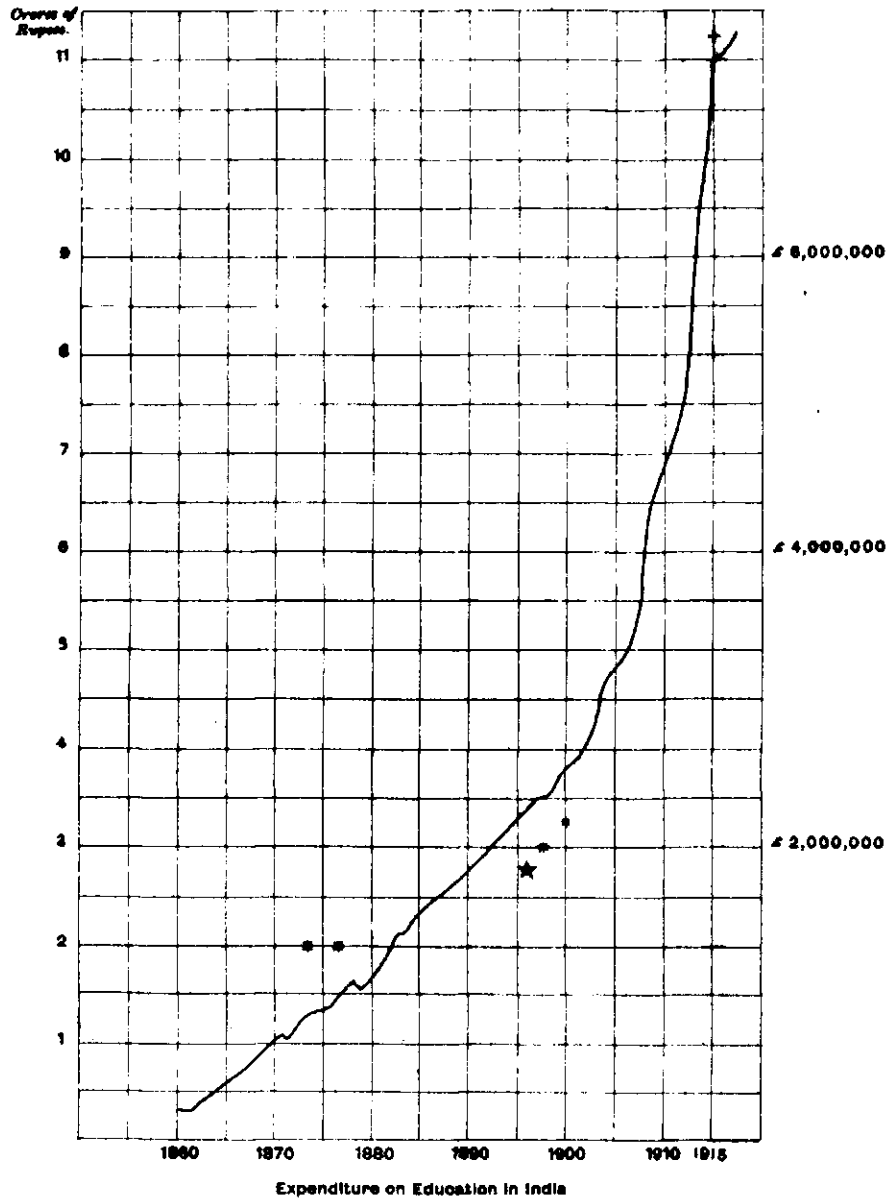

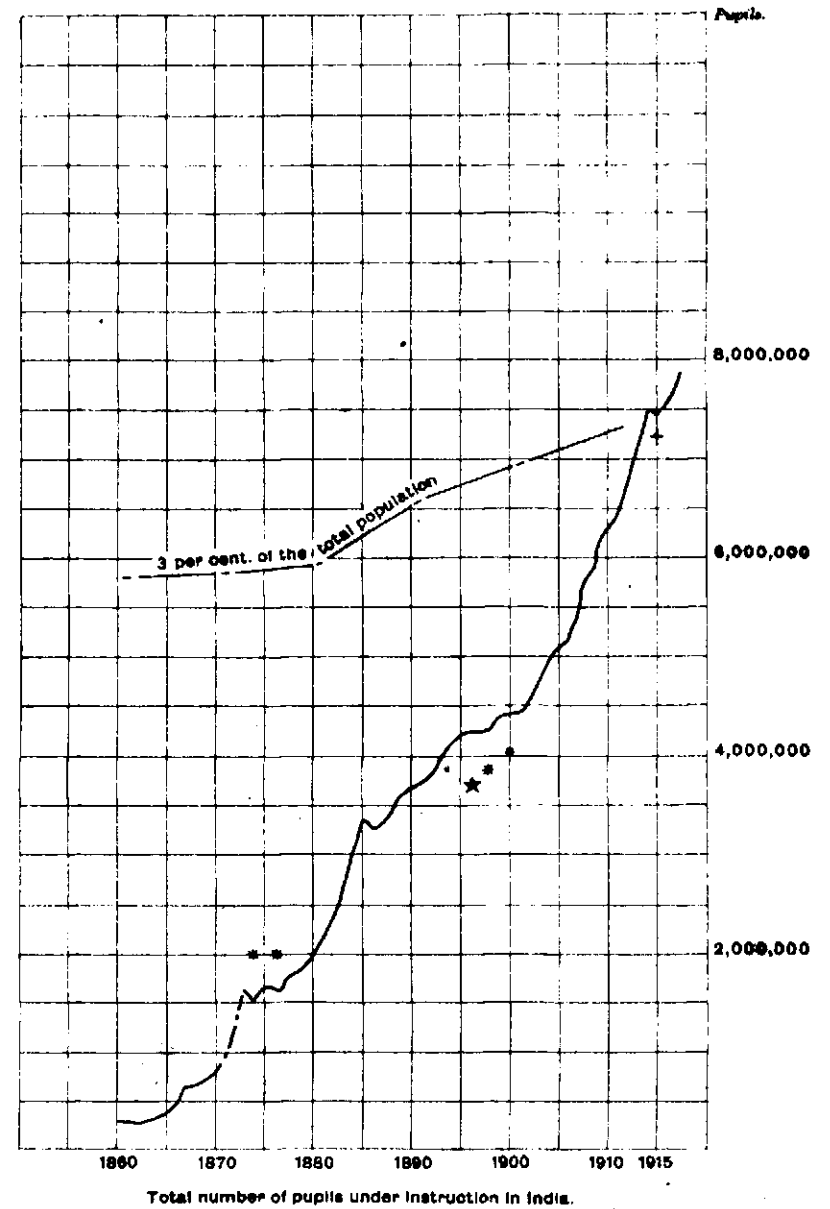
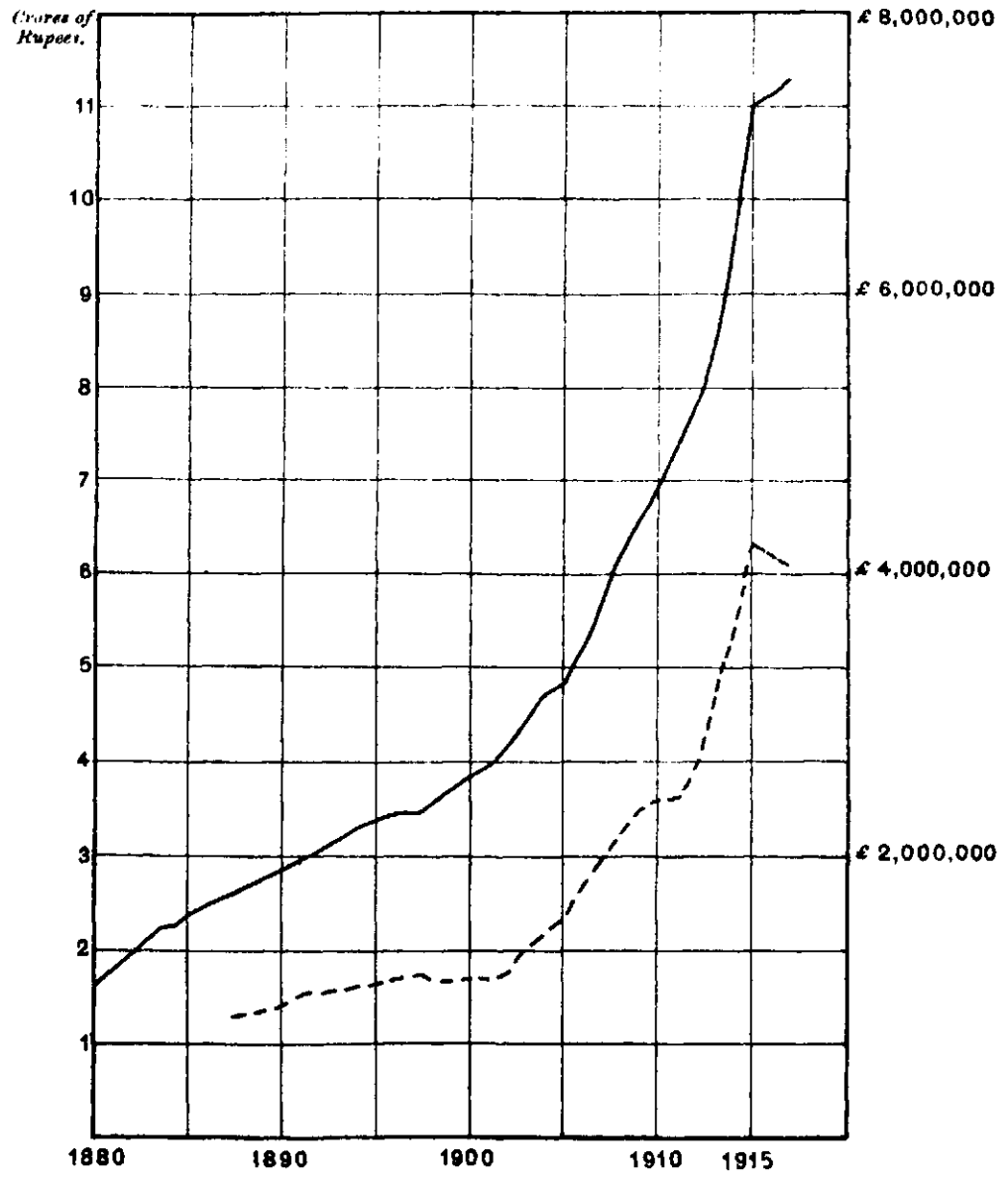


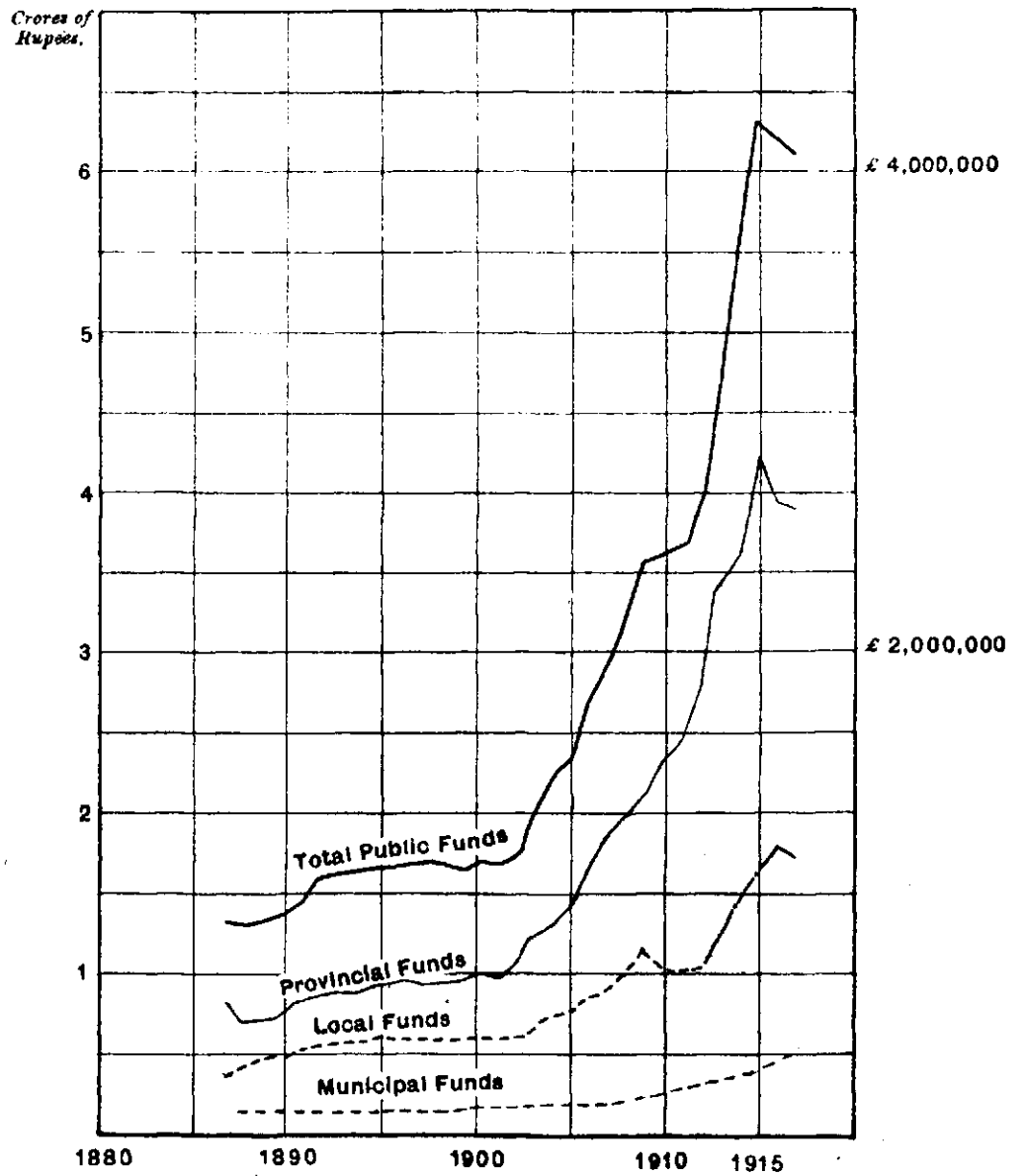

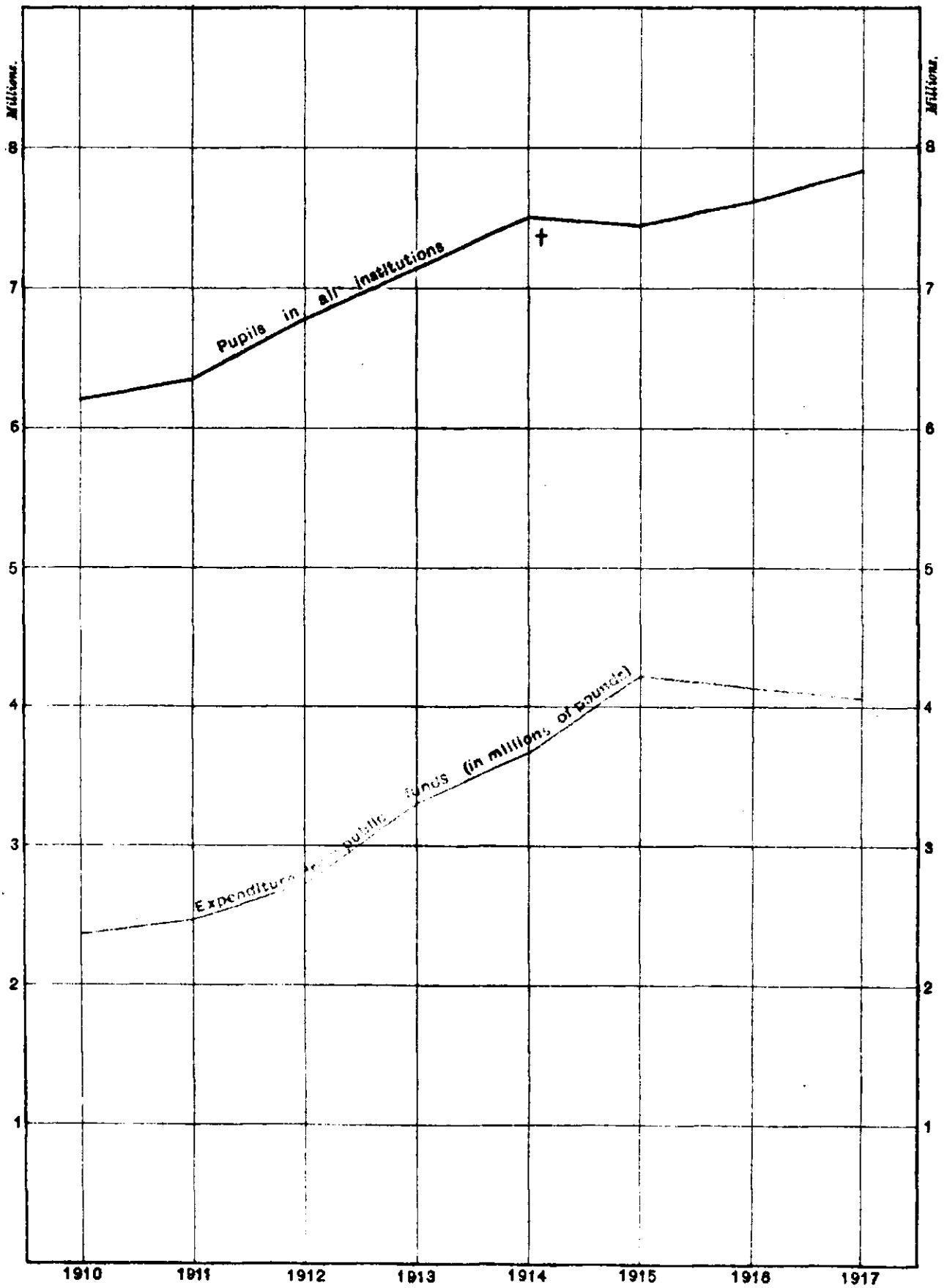
From Public Funds.....
