I have the honour to submit the annual report on the working of Joint Stock Companies for the year ending the 31st March 1917 together with the prescribed statements therefor. As usual the report also deals with Societies. registered under the Provident Insurance Societies Act, V of 1912, and the Societies Registration Act, XXI of 1860.

I.—THE INDIAN COMPANIES ACT, 1913.

- The year opened with 558 working Companies—540 limited by shares and 18 by guarantee; 34 new Companies limited by shares were registered; two Companies limited by shares, of which one was struck off the register last year and the other wound up by the Court, were restored under the orders of the Court to the list, while 25 Companies limited by shares ceased to carry on business, being either wound up or removed from the register. There were accordingly 569 working Companies at the close of the year-551 limited by shares and 18 by guarantee.
- 3. No Company limited by guarantee has been registered or has gone into liquidation during the year.

Companies registered.

- 4. Of the 36 Companies referred to above, 13 were private Companies, compared with 5 out of 20 new Companies registered in the previous year. indicating that the public are beginning to realize the advantages of private Companies.

The number of Companies registered shows a distinct advance on the two preceding years, but as observed in the reports for the two preceding years, the increase is likely to be small until the return of normal conditions.

- 6. In the case of Shri Krishna Agency Company, Limited, it was struck off the register last year under the provisions of section 217 of the Act, but, on the application of a creditor, the District Judge, Ahmedabad, ordered its restoration. The Court, however, shortly afterwards made an order for winding up.
- 7. The Bamboo Paper Pulp Syndicate, Limited, was floated with the object of manufacturing paper from bamboo pulp, a new industry as far as Joint Stock Companies are concerned in the Presidency.
- 8. During the year a Turkish subject, who was to be the owner of most of the shares, wished to register an Insurance Company with a capital of Rs. 15 lakhs but this was refused.

Companies. that have ceased to exist.

- 9. Of the 25 Companies that ceased to exist during the period under report, 4 were wound up by the Court, 17 went into voluntary liquidation and 4 were removed from the register under section 247 of the Act.
- 10. The 4 Companies compulsorily wound up consisted of 2 Banks and 2 Trading concerns.
- Assurance Company by name "The New Bombay Presidency Assurance Society, Limited." It was registered on 11th February 1910 but could not raise the funds to make the requisite deposit with the Comptroller of Currency under the provisions of section 4 of the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act, VI of 1912. Practically it ceased to carry on business in December 1912. Its affairs were in an unsatisfactory condition and the policy-holders complained about the management. The documents to be filed were not received punctually. All the directors resigned, and the only director, who could be held liable, after being called upon to. show cause why proceedings should not be aken against him, absconded and could not be traced.
- 12. The Krishna Company, Limited, referred to in paragraph 21 of my last report is in voluntary liquidation, and another Society also mentioned in paragraph 21 of my last report, the Bharat Sarkar Company, Limited, was struck off the register under section 247 of the Indian Companies Act, 1913.
- 13. The Hindu Social Reform Association of Hyderabad (Sind) and the Surat Nemchand Melapchand Nursing Association, which were registered under section 26 of the Indian Companies Act, experienced much difficulty in

complying with the provisions of section 144, which require qualified auditors to be appointed, and applied to Government to revoke the licenses which had been granted by Government Order, Revenue Department, No. 6210 dated 21st June 1916, and Government Order, Revenue Department, No. 7554 dated 2nd August 1916. It was proposed, at the time of such applications, that the Associations should be converted into Societies on fulfilling the requirements of section 18 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, but no steps have as yet been taken by them. They are therefore in the meantime being treated as ordinary limited concerns as laid down in section 26 (4) of the Indian Companies Act, 1913.

14. Of the Companies that were in the course of being wound up on or before 31st March 1916, 6 were dissolved by the Court, 18 were fully wound up by the liquidators and 1 was struck off the registers in pursuance of Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No. 2713 dated 24th April 1903, and section 247 of the Act.

Alterations in Capital.

- 15. One hundred and three Companies increased their capital during the year. The aggregate increase in the authorized, subscribed and paid up capitals amounted to Rs. 1,34,93,500, Rs. 96,96,375 and Rs. 1,20,19,581, respectively, as against an increase of Rs. 23,97,000 in authorized, Rs. 1,22,00,760 in subscribed and Rs. 2,03,80,389 in paid up capital in the previous year.
- 16. Only 26 Companies decreased their capital during the year. The total reductions in the authorized, subscribed and paid up capitals amounted to Rs. 3,70,500, Rs. 41,56,125 and Rs. 14,64,915, respectively, against reductions by Rs. 18,25,250 in authorized, Rs. 41,07,875 in subscribed and Rs. 22,31,015 in paid up capital in the preceding year.

Alteration in the number of Members.

18. There is no change in the number of members in the case of Companies limited by guarantee.

Private Companies.

19. Of the 551 Companies limited by shares and working at the close of the year, 26 are private Companies, 24 Companies being originally registered as such and three being converted from public Companies. In the year under review the Bechardas Spinning and Weaving Company, Limited, was converted from a private into a public Company under section 154 of the Act. A list of these is separately given in Appendix A in pursuance of the instructions from the Director of Statistics.

Change of Name.

20. Changes in the names of two Companies were sanctioned by Government Orders, Revenue Department, No. 4081 dated 14th April 1916, and No. 2145 dated 22nd February 1917, viz., "The Sind Gazette Press, Limited," to the "Daily Gazette Press, Limited," and the "Western India Match Manufacturing Company, Limited," to the "Pioneer Alkali Works, Limited."

Branch Registers.

21. No Company availed itself of the provisions of section 41 of the Act.

Appointment of Inspectors.

23. During the year under report two Inspectors were appointed to investigate certain matters under section 138 in respect of the affairs of the "Igatpuri Railway Co-operative Society, Limited," and the "Indian and Peninsular Steam Navigation Company, Limited." The Inspectors' reports have not as yet been received in this office.

Registration of Mortgages.

23. The provisions of the Act so far as registrations are concerned are duly complied with either by the Companies themselves or their creditors, but memoranda of satisfaction under section 121 are only rarely received at this office, which means that the register of mortgages maintained at this office is very inaccurate.

Auditors.

- 24. Since the establishment of the Auditors Council under the Bombay Auditors Certificates Rules, 1914, Government has granted to three persons permanent unrestricted certificates and to one person a temporary unrestricted certificate. There are also 30 permanent restricted and 20 temporary restricted certificate-holders. Some of the smaller concerns in the mofussil experience great difficulty in paying the charges of qualified auditors, who have to go from Bombay or some other centre to audit their accounts.
- 25. A number of Companies were found to be still unaware of the provisions of section 144 (3) and consequently 16 applications for the appointment of auditors were disposed of by Government under section 144 (4) of the Act.

Publication of Form G.

26. The publication of the statement in Form G, Schedule III of the Act, required by section 136 of the Act, was properly effected by all the Banking and Insurance Companies, whose offices in the mofussil were visited by the Assistant Registrars and in Bombay by my head clerk.

Foreign Companies.

27. During the year 8 Companies filed the documents required by section 277 of the Act (see Appendix B annexed). Of the 204 Foreign Companies on the register of this office on the 1st April 1916, only three ceased to have places of business in the Presidency (see Appendix C). Accordingly there were 209 working Companies at the close of the year.

Filing of Returns.

- 29. There has been a slow but distinct improvement in filing of returns by Companies, the worst offenders being the small mofussil Companies whose correspondence is conducted in the vernacular. The policy of endeavouring to instruct these Companies in the requirements of the Act by means of circulars and letters has been continued with fair success, but it is my intention, now that the Act has been in force for three years, to adopt more stringent measures in respect of those Companies who have already received warnings and who continue to neglect the requirements of the Act.
- 29. On the whole, however, I am satisfied that, in the case of the majority of Companies, efforts have been made to comply with the requirements of the Act, and there has been a distinct improvement in respect of Companies operating in Bombay City.
- 30. The printing and sale by Government of prescribed forms is a great aid to Companies and to this office.

- 31. Of the 9 Societies that were on the register on the 31st March 1916, two have been wound up and one removed from the register. Only two new Societies were registered during the year. The complete list may be classified as under:—

^{37.} The sale of forms is a new item altogether, and it is hoped that the scheme will lead to uniformity and will gradually do away with the difficulty experienced at this office in storing returns drawn up in different sizes and forms and often on the flimsiest of paper. The printing and sale of the forms is a distinct aid to the public.

38. The decrease under several heads in the table given in paragraph 36 is due to the reduction of the fee from Rs. 5 to Rs. 3 by the Government of India Notification No. 6161-26 dated the 22nd July 1916, under section 249. The fees under item (1) will gradually fall away, since there are very few new certificates now being issued to auditors.

39. The expenditure purely against this office amounted to Rs. 24,736-11-5 as against Rs. 27,152-3-5 in the previous year.

- 40. The increase under establishment is due to the progressive salaries sanctioned by Government Resolution, Financial Department, No. 3440 dated 26th August 1914, and that under rent is due to the fact that the rent for 12 complete months was paid during the year. The decrease under salary to the Registrar and travelling allowance are due to the fact that no arrears of salary were payable to the Registrar as was the case in the previous year and there was less necessity for travelling in the year. The other items of increase or decrease are of no importance.
- 41. The remunerative allowance and travelling allowance drawn by the Registrar as Controller of Hostile Trading Concerns and Custodian of Enemy Property are not included in item I (a), paragraph 39, as they are chargeable to enemy funds. A moiety of the account for electricity is also excluded from item II (g), as it is to be debited to the enemy account as per Government Order, Revenue Department, No. 3697 dated 24th March 1917.
- 42. The general work of the office in quantity was much the same as in the preceding year, and I have to record my satisfaction with the work of my staff, but I may observe that I experience the greatest difficulty in securing efficient peons, since the Government scale of pay appears to be very considerably lower than that of the average commercial houses and the best men do not apply for vacancies. The question is a troublesome one for this office, where so much work has to be done by the peons in carrying documents to Companies' offices, and inefficient messengers mean much waste of time.
