Sir,

I have the honour to submit the Annual Administration Report, on the working of Joint Stock Companies, for the year ending 31st March 1919. The prescribed returns showing the statistics of public and private companies separately are appended hereto. The report also deals with societies and companies registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, and the Provident Insurance Societies Act, 1912, and the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act, 1912.

2. Mr. P. S. Mellor, B.A., J.P., had charge of the office during the year under review, up to the 11th February, 1919, when I took charge.

3. Thirty-three companies were registered during the year as compared with 80 in the previous year. One company, "Ahmedabad Fine Spinning and Weaving Company, Limited," which was in voluntary liquidation, was revived by the Court, and restored to the list of working companies. An Association by the name of "Ranchorlal and Victoria Jubilee Dispensaries Society" which was from 1895, the date of its registration under section 26 of the Indian Companies Act, 1882, treated as a society under the Societies Registration Act, has been transferred to the list of companies, Limited by Guarantee.

The falling off in the registration of Public Companies is due to the introduction of the Indian Companies Restriction Act, 1918. The increase under "private companies" shows the tendency of the public to take advantage of floating companies of that class.

5. Forty-two companies limited by shares, (40 public and 2 private) ceased to carry on business and were removed from the register, as compared with thirty-two in the previous year. Of these 42 companies, five were wound up by orders of Courts, seven went into voluntary liquidation, and 26 were removed from the register under section 47 of the Act, and three were taken into liquidation and dissolved during the year. One company, "Wiecher Kaiser and Levy, Limited," a German concern, was completely wound up by the Controller, Hostile Trading Concerns, Karachi.

6. Of the companies that were in course of liquidation, on or before 31st March, 1918, six were dissolved by courts, and sixteen were completely wound up by liquidators.

7. At the close of the year, 583 companies were working, as compared with 590 in the preceding year. Of these 583, 19 were limited by guarantee, with 12,670 members, exclusive of unlimited number of members in the case of four companies. The remainder were Share Capital Companies, the details whereof are given below in tabular form as they stood on the closing days of the years 1917-18 and 1918-19 :—

It is apparent from the above that though the number of public Companies was reduced, the total registered and working capital was considerably increased, in spite of the Restriction Act. Private companies show a good advance in all respects.

8. The following two companies changed their names with the approval of Government :—

Mackenzies Saw Mills, Limited, to Mackenzies, Limited.

Hormasji Ardesir S. Gokuldas and Company, Limited, to Ruby Mills, Limited.

9. One hundred and thirty-seven existing companies increased their authorised, subscribed, and paid up capitals by Rs. 8,42,00,250, Rs. 15,65,48,640, and Rs. 5,55,03,569, respectively, as compared with increases of Rs. 2,40,77,500, Rs. 1,67,30,010, and Rs. 1,79,31,290, respectively, in the previous year.

10. Nine companies reduced their capital during the year. The aggregate reduction in authorised, subscribed, and paid up capital is Rs. 92,41,000, Rs. 45,67,890, Rs. 7,72,242, respectively, as compared with decrease of Rs. 5,29,250, Rs. 69,91,235, and Rs. 12,91,249, respectively, in the preceding year.

11. The Bombay Electric Supply and Tramway Company, Limited, has maintained a Branch Register, in accordance with section 41 of the Act.

12. Sixty-nine companies took advantage of section 109, and mortgaged or charged their properties to the extent of Rs. 6,00,52,500, including

Debenture Mortgages for Rs. 54,09,000. Six Memoranda of Satisfaction were registered under section 120.

13. Form G was exhibited by the companies referred to in section 136 in their offices which were inspected by the Assistant Registrars in mofussil, and the Head Clerk, in Bombay.

14. On the first April 1919 the number of persons holding Government Auditors Certificates was 53, as against 54 in the year preceding.

In six cases the terms for which the certificates were granted expired during the year, of which one was extended into Permanent Restricted Certificate, and subsequently changed into Permanent Unrestricted Certificate; one was extended into Permanent Unrestricted Certificate, and 4 were renewed for a further period of two years. Five Permanent Restricted Certificates were exchanged for Permanent Unrestricted Certificates. During the year one Provisional Restricted Certificate was granted, and one holder of a Permanent Restricted Certificate died.

15. Eight new Foreign Companies incorporated outside British India, established their places of business and filed their papers in this office, under section 277. One company "Rylands and Sons (Colonial), Limited, omitted to be shown in the report for 1915-16, is now included in the list. One company ceased to keep a place of business. Lists of these companies are given in Appendix A.

The decrease under items 1 and 7 is due to the cause explained in paragraph 4.

The increase under items 8, 9, 13 to 15 cannot be attributed to any special cause. The increases and decreases under several heads can only be attributed to fluctuations.

Prosecutions.

21. The prosecutions instituted last year had the effect of improving the manner in which documents were presented for filing in this office. There were a number of applications for an extension of time for either holding Annual General Meetings, or filing returns. They were dealt with in the same manner, as was done last year.

22. Out of ten cases remained to be disposed of at the close of the last year, nine persons were discharged, and one was fined.

23. During the year, a liquidator was proceeded against, for neglecting to file returns, and was punished with a fine of Rs. 250. There is one case pending in the Ahmedabad Magistrate Court,

Financial Results.

24. During the year the revenue from fees amounted to Rs. 23,200-9-6, against Rs. 29,861-4-3 during the previous year. The table below exhibits the receipts, classified under different heads, as contrasted with the figures in the preceding year.
